NARRATIVE SUMMARY1. GENERAL OVERVIEW OF ALL ACTIVITIES

a. The majority of fire missions fired by this battery were against bunker complexes in the southern half of the DMZ. During the month of October, the howitzers of this battery fired 51 observed missions and 35 unobserved missions, expending 1099 rounds of shell HE.

b. During the latter half of the month the battery displaced from QUANG TRI to QUANG NAM Province, Republic of Viet-Nam. The battery was reestablished at LA BAOY, QUANG NAM Province on 27 October 1968.

a. General support, 3rd Marine Division, 1-24 October.

b. (1) Battery (-): General support, 3d Marine Division, 25-26 October.

(2) "B" Platoon: Reinforcing, 3d Battalion, 11th Marines, 25-26 October.

c. (1) Battery (-): Reinforcing, 3d Battalion, 11th Marines, 27-31 October.

(2) "A" Platoon: Reinforcing, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines, 27-31 October.

7. LOGISTICS

a. Major problems during the period are concerned with the relocation of the Battery with consequent reestablishment of liaison with support facilities, positioning of supplies, and transportation of battery material to the new positions. Due to the onset of the monsoon season and road conditions in QUANG NAM Province, this has been a slow process. The logistics picture should improve considerably during the coming month.

b. Construction of SEA Huts, bunkers and gun pads is needed at LZ BAIDY, LZ ROSS and AN HOA. This construction has been programmed.

8. COMMUNICATIONS-ELECTRONICS. No significant problems.

9. EQUIPMENT. Several problems have been experienced with three howitzers which have been in service over two years, and are in need of replacement. Provision for repair parts at the forward ISA's in this area (LZ BAIDY and AN HOA) would be a definite asset.

10. CIVIC ACTION. The Battery Corpsmen conducted 2 MEDCAPS, treating 68 Vietnamese Nationals in Northern ICTZ.

11. PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION. The battery joined 27 enlisted, and dropped 29 enlisted. The Operating Percentage (of manning level) of Officers is 100%; Enlisted 111%. Transfer of mail was accomplished without major complications. The changeover in administrative procedures is being accomplished with only minor complications due to delay in receipt of directives.

12. TRAINING. Unit/Section Training, COATIP, Personal Response and GMS Training continued up to the time of the Battery's displacement. MOS Training continued throughout the month.

2. 11 October 1969

"B" Platoon displaced from CON THIEN (A-4) to DONG HA and subsequently embarked at DONG HA on 12 October enroute to DA NANG. This platoon arrived at DA NANG on 13 October and moved to the Northern Artillery Cantonment thereat.

3. 19 October 1969

"C" Platoon displaced from GIO LINH (A-2) to DONG HA.

4. 20 October 1969

"A" Platoon displaced from ELLIOTT COMBAT BASE to DONG HA. As of 201013H October, the Battery "stood down" from operations in the 3d Marine Division area of operations and continued preparations for redeployment with the 1st Marine Division.

5. 25 October 1969

"B" Platoon moved to LZ ROSS in QUANG NAM Province and assumed the mission of reinforcing the fires of the 3d Battalion, 11th Marines.

6. 26 October 1969

The Battery Headquarters, "A" and "C" Platoons embarked at DONG HA enroute to DA NANG.

7. 27 October 1969

OFCOM of the battery was passed to the 11th Marines. The Battery Headquarters and "C" Platoon debarked at DA NANG and moved to LZ BALDY in QUANG NAM Province. The Battery Command Post was established at LZ BALDY at 271615H October. "A" Platoon debarked and moved to Hill 34 at DA NANG. "C" Platoon assumed the mission of reinforcing the fire of the 3d Battalion, 11th Marines.
