NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- 1. From 1 Mevember to 30 Movember 1967, the First Plateen was located at the Cempany CP grid (AT 995723), perferming the mission of General Support. On 17 Nevember 1967, the second section moved to Hill 47 OP grid (AT 974703). Although in General Support of the 11th Marines, this section has a priority mission of direct fire into the rocket belt in a counter rocket capacity. On 27 Nevember 1967, tracter 12 was deadlined to FSR for a warped turnet ring.
- 2. The 2nd Plateon remained at the mouth of the Cua Viet River grid (YD 348698) perferming its mission of General Support Reinfercing for the 12th Marine Regiment, with priority of fires to 1stAmTracBn.
- 3. From 1 November to 30 November 1967, the 1st section of the 3rd Platoon was located at 3rd 8" Battery, 11th Marines grid (AT 921799). From 1 November to 15 November 1967, the remainder of the 3rd Platoon was located at the Company CP grid (AT 995723). On 15 November 1967, the 3rd Platoon, minus the first section, moved from the Company CP to the 2rd Battalion, 11th Marines CP grid (AT 984675). They were assigned the mission of General Support Reinforcing.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

a. Due to the rotation of 48% of its total strength, the First Armored Amphibian Company has been engaged in a rebuilding and retraining program during the month of November. A rapid influx of personnel quickly enabled the organization to attain a Cl personnel readiness rating. Cl personnel readiness relates only to everall on board manning level strength. The unit is seriously short of SNCOs, Sgts and corporals MOS 1831. A comparison of MOS 1831 T/O, M/L and O/H strength is reflected below:

The substitution of other skills in lieu of MOS 1831, i.e., O811, 1833, has been of major assistance in our current strength, however, the shortage of qualified SNOOs and Sgts is a critical problem and is not likely to improve. One GySgt Plt Sgt is hospitalized now and will be noneffective for perhaps one month. Another GySgt rotates 22Feb68. The remaining GySgt 1831 will probably become the Company Gysgt in lieu of the Msgt 1831 whom we rate but do not have on board. A possible solution to the SNCO problem would be assigning SNCOs with an additional MOS 1831.

- b. This Company requires a Maintenance Officer, MOS 2010 in order to maintain its current state of combat readiness. The Company will experience a less of approximately 25% of its on board strength during May and June 1968. This loss will include the Company Commander and Company Executive and Fire Direction Officers. During November 1968 approximately 40% of the unit will rotate. Unless staggered RTDs are established for the unit, the same unwarrented personnel loss experienced during October 1967 will occur twice during 1968.
- e. While the high rate of extensions of overseas tours has, in the past. maintained a measure of continuity in the Company, this rate may be expected to decline as the unit continues to fail to be employed in its amphibious and mobile artillery role. Below are listed the significant personnel occurrences during the months

2. TRAINING. Due to the large turnover of personnel, the Company embarked on a concentrated training program during the first two weeks of Movember. The training was programmed primarily towards familiarizing the new personnel on firing battery procedures, to include indirect and direct fire, safety and occupation of a new position. This was accomplished by conducting live direct fire exercises and three RSOPs, two of which included live firing. Upon completion of the training cycle, the Company again proceeded on its planned program of GMST and on the job training.

On 14 November 1967, the Company received its issue of M-16 rifles. Refresher instructions were on nomenclature, care and cleaning, weapons safety and functioning. All personnel have fired their weapons for battle sights. In addition, familiarization firing of individual and orew served weapons has been incorporated into the monthly training schedule on a bimonthly basis. Officers and Staff School has continued on a weekly basis.

- 3. <u>LOGISTICS</u>. This unit is awaiting arrival of LVTEl suspension components to effect conversion of the current LVTP5Al suspension system.
- 4. OPERATIONS. This unit has not participated in a named operation since Operation VICTOR 11-13 Sep67, in which one section took part.
