



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


DIAGRAM OF ENEMY BASE CAMP AREA FOUND BY

5. SYNOPSIS: PATROL COVERED A PERIOD OF 96 HOURS WITH 3 SIGHTINGS TOTALLING 5 VC/NVA AND 2 CONTACTS. RESULTS: 1 VC/NVA KIA, 1 IWC. NO SUPPORTING ARMS WERE UTILIZED. INSERT HLZ WAS PREPARED BY 1 FLIGHT OF FIXED WING AIRCRAFT.

6. OBSERVATION OF THE ENEMY AND TERRAIN:

a. ENEMY: 280930H, VIC AT 891292, PATROL FOUND 6 1'x1'x15' FINISHED TIMBERS NEAR A TRAIL. TIMBERS WERE WITHIN 300 METERS DISTANCE ALONG THE TRAIL. 281145H, VIC AT 886294, PATROL FOUND 7 BUNKERS 8'x15'x5' DEEP. THE ROOFS WERE MADE OF THATCH THAT APPEARED TO BE BURNT OFF. SMALL 2' DIAMETER AND 3' DEEP TUNNELS WITH 2"-4" POLES AS SUPPORTS WERE CUT INTO THE BOTTOMS OF THE BUNKERS. ALSO FOUND WERE 10 FOXHOLES SCATTERED THROUGHOUT THE BUNKERED AREAS. PATROL FOUND 1 PIECE OF WEB GEAR SHAPED IN A TRIANGLE WITH A LEATHER STRAP AND BUCKLE. ONE SIDE OF THE OBJECT OPENED AND THE OBJECT APPEARED TO BE A HOLSTER. PATROL FOUND 25-30 RR SHELLS NEARBY AT A CLEARED AREA. POSSIBLY A US LZ.

291100H, VIC AT 866300, PATROL OBSERVED 1 VC/NVA MOVING NORTH-EAST ON A TRAIL. EN WAS WEARING GREEN TROUSERS, THE SHIRT WAS UNOBSERVABLE, AND A PACK. ENEMY SUDDENLY TURNED AND MOVED BACK THE WAY HE CAME. 15 MINUTES LATER ANOTHER ENEMY MOVED DOWN THE TRAIL. THIS VC/NVA WORE KHAKI TROUSERS AND CARRIED A POSSIBLE DPM MG. PATROL INITIATED CONTACT. EN APPEARED TO ~~BE~~ HIT BUT THE BODY COULD NOT BE OBSERVED. RESULTS: UNKNOWN

291400H, VIC AT 865299, PATROL FOUND 1 GRAVE. GRAVE WAS DECORATED WITH ROCK FOR HEADSTONE, STICKS FOR RAILINGS AROUND IT AND A LIVE BUSH IN THE CENTER. BODY WAS BADLY DECOMPOSED AND WAS DRESSED IN BLACK PJ'S. PATROL ALSO FOUND AN UNIDENTIFIED DOCUMENT 15 METERS AWAY FROM THE GRAVE (FORWARDED TO G-2)

291500H, VIC AT 864297, PATROL FOUND A BALL MADE OF RICE AND CORN ON A TRAIL. FOOD WAS FRESHLY MADE.

291515H, VIC AT 864298, PATROL FOUND A BASE CAMP. 12 CAVES WERE OBSERVED. THE AVERAGE SIZE OF THESE CAVES WERE 2' IN DIAMETER, 4'-6' DEEP WITH A PERPENDICULAR TUNNEL AT THE END. THAT TUNNEL WAS 4'-6' IN LENGTH. CAVES WERE IN SEES OF TWO. SOME OF THE CAVES HAD BAMBOO AND PALMS INSIDE FOR BEDDING. PATROL ALSO SAW 20 BUNKERS, WHICH WERE THE SAME IN SIZE AND CONSTRUCTION AS THOSE PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED. SOME OF THESE HAD SMALL TUNNELS IN THEM ALSO.

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6. OBSERVATION OF THE ENEMY AND TERRAIN (cont)

a. ENEMY, THREE HOLES WITH BRANCHES AND LEAF COVERINGS WERE USED FOR LATRINES. TWO BUNKERS HAD A 10" DIAMETER TUNNEL BETWEEN THEM (SEE DIAGRAM) 300915J, VIC AT 857296, PATROL FOUND TWO GRAVES. GRAVES WERE DECORATED IN A MANNER SIMILAR TO THE FIRST ONE. BODIES WERE DRESSED IN 1 SET OF BLACK PJ'S AND ONE SET OF KHAKIS. LOGS WERE USED TO SUPPORT THE GRAVES ON THE DOWNHILL SLOPE. 1 GRAVE HAD A HOLE DUG UNDER IT ON THE SLOPE EXACTLY THE SAME SIZE AS THE GRAVES. THE HOLE CUT UNDER THE BODY WAS 2' DEEP AND THE HOLE CUT UNDER IT WAS AT ABOUT 4 FT UNDER THE BODY. THE DIRT HAD BEEN PUT BACK IN THE CUT.

301535H, VIC AT 857296, PATROL OBSERVED 2 VC/NVA MOVING SOUTH-WEST ON A TRAIL. 1 EN WORE KHAKIS, A CARTRIDGE BELT AND CARRIED A RIFLE. THE OTHER EN WORE TIGER STRIPE UTILITIES, A PACK AND A BELT WITH TWO CANTEENS. THE EN MOVED TO NEAR THE PATROL'S POSITION AND THEN MOVED QUICKLY AWAY THE WAY THEY HAD COME.

301645H, VIC AT 857296, PATROL OBSERVED 1 VC/NVA MOVING SOUTH-WEST ON A TRAIL. EN MOVED CAUTIOUSLY WITH HIS RIFLE AT THE READY. EN WORE A KHAKI SHIRT, GREEN SHORTS A LEATHER BELT AND CARRIED AN AK-47. EN ALSO HAD ONE CHICOM GRENADE. PATROL INITIATED CONTACT. RESULTS: 1 VC/NVA KIA, 1 WNC. THERE WAS POSSIBLY MORE THAN ONE ENEMY DUE TO INCONSISTANCIES IN THE PATROL'S ACCOUNT OF THE ACTION.

b. TERRAIN WAS VERY STEEP WITH A CANOPY OF 100 FEET. SECONDARY GROWTH WAS 6' HIGH CONSISTING OF SCRUB, VINES, WHICH WERE NOT VERY THICK. MOVEMENT WAS MODERATE AT THE RATE OF 100 METERS PER HOUR FOR A RECON PATROL. WATER WAS SCARCE.



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PATROL ROUTE OVERLAY




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BASE CAMP AREA DIAGRAM
