





1. MISSION

- a. Basic Mission. 1st Marines (-) (Rein) opcupies and defends assigned sector of the Danang Area to protect and defend the Danang vital areas in sector; conducts unilateral search and destroy operations within assigned sector; conduct combat/reconnaissance patrols and ambushes throughout assigned sector of the Danang Area; be prepared to conduct counterattacks to restore the integrity of the assigned sector of the Danang Area.
- b. Purpose of this Estimate. To summarize available information on the enemy, weather and terrain that could affect the mission of this command.
- the first of the first state of 2. CHARACTERISTICS OF THE AREA OF OPERATIONS

a. Weather

(1) General

- (a) The climate of the Republic of Vietnam is monsoonal in nature, and is characterized by two major seasons, the southwest monsoon (May to October) and the northeast monsoon (November to May). Due to the differences in exposure and elevation, there are variances in the climatic elements throughout the country. For the purpose of this estimate the climate and weather as discussed pertains only to the Danang Area.
- (b) The climate in the vicinity of Danang Area is classed as humid to excessively wet and the temperature is tropical in nature.

- (2) <u>Temperatures</u>. Daning has a high surface temperature the year round. The mean annual temperature is approximately 80 degrees Fahrenheit with a maximum high of 110°F and minimum low of 50°F. The general meteorological assumption in this area is that temperature decreases at an approximate rate of 3.3 degrees for every 1,000 feet increase in altitude.
- (3) <u>Humidity</u>. A rather high relative humidity generally prevails in the area creating conditions favorable for mildew, corrosion, and decay of susceptible items. The annual variation is slight, maximum humidity averages 90 percent (November and December) and the average low humidity is 80 percent (July).
- (4) Precipitation. The Danang area receives most of its rainfall (averages 85 inches) from September through December. Most of the precipitation in this area occurs in the form of showers and thunderstorms. Occasionally hailstones have been reported during thunderstorms with stones up to 2 inches in diameter.
- (5) Clouds. Over the Danang area the autumn transition and the northeast monsoon are the cloudiest, however, the mean annual cloud cover is approximately 60 percent. A special weather phenomenon called the CRACHIN (a period of widespread fog and drizzle or light rain) affects the Danang area. It is characterized by ceilings from 300 to 1,000 feet with visibility of less than two miles. The CRACHIN appears in October and disappears in April. The CRACHIN usually lasts from two to five days but has been known to last for twenty-two consecutive days.
- (6) <u>Visibility</u>. On the whole the Danang area has good visibility except during periods of CRACHIN.
- b. TWORAIN. Shores are predominantly sandy; coastal terrain consists of rice paddies, cultivated fields and unproductive sand plains. The 1st Marines AOR is laced with streams running NW and SE and numerous marshy areas. An unuseable meter-gage railroad is located six to ten miles inland, highway #1 is located four to wix miles inland and highway #14 runn east to west along the southern portion of the 1st Marines AOR.
- c. HYDROGRAPHY. The beaches along the 1st Marines AOR are predominantly sandy. The mean daily tides range from 2 to 6 feet. From October through April, currents flow south and southwest and are strongest from December through February when average speeds of up to 3 knots are recorded. By May currents are reversed and flow north and northwest.
 - d. POLITICS. See reference (b) and Special Intelligence Reports.
- e. ECONOMICS. The majority of the population within the 1st Marines AOR derive their livelihood from agriculture and fishing. The average peasant holding is about 5 acres with the majority of the land under rice paddy cultivation. The most important animals are cattle, water buffalo and swine. Ducks are also grown by most farmers for eating as well as marketing. Commercial fishing operations are for the most part family enterprises.

- 3. ENEMY SITULTION (See reference (b) and current Intelligence Summaries and Situation Reports).
- a. <u>Composition</u>. Viet Cong military forces in South Vietnam are organized into four broad categories; Main Force Units, Local Force Units, Militia Units and Regular North Vietnamese Forces (NVA).
- (1) Main Force Units (MF) are directly subordinate to the Central Office South Vietnam (COSVN) or to a Military Region (MR). Main Force Units are the best trained and equipped of the three irregular type forces.
- (2) Local Forces (LF) are those directly subordinate to a district or province.
 - (3) Militia Units (MU) are subordinate to a village or hamlet.
- (4) The regular armed forces of North Vietnam (NVA) are those forces from North Vietnam who have infiltrated into South Vietnam. The NVA forces are equipped with modern conventional weapons of Chicom and Soviet origin, as well as considerable quantities of older Japanese, German, 'rench and U. S. armament. These forces are the most experienced and effective fighting force native to Southeast Asia.
 - b. Strength and Dispositions.

QUANG NAM PROVINCE

Militia Units (MU) (Irregulars)

Normally a platoon sized unit is subordinate to each village and a squad assigned to each hamlet. In Quang Nam (P) there are 149 villages (V) and 481 hamlets (H). Approximate strength of Militia Units in the prevince is 3200.

c. Arms and Armament. The VC supply of weapons and ammunition in Quang Nam (P) has been accumulated from several sources. World War II weapons infiltrated primarily from North Vietnam, captured weapons, and locally produced weapons.

The exact quantities of weapons and ammunition infiltrated from North Vietnam are unknown, it is evident that significant quantities of Communist Bloc weapons and Chicom copies of these weapons have been infiltrated into Quang Nam together with the required ammunition.

Crew served weapons have been introduced in sufficient quantity so that 81/82mm mortars are now found in the confirmed battalians within Quang Nam (P). 75mm recoilless rifles are believed to be in most main force battalians. This has enabled the VC to make considerable progress in distributing lighter weapons, such as the 60mm mortar and the 75mm RR, down to Company level within MF units.

Classification Capabilities.

(1) To continue his buildup of strength in Quang Nam (P) by limited drafting of South Vietnamese and continuing to introduce NVA elements into the province.

- (2) Attack any target in the province with forces listed in paragraph b. above. This represents the maximum effort the VC could bring to bear on any target with forces committed in Quang Nam Province.
- (3) Reinforce his forces within Quang Nam with forces from Quang Tin (P) (See reference (b)).
- (4) With forces available continue to conduct small and occasional large scale attacks, terrorism, assassinations, sabotage, propaganda, population and resources control, and extension of the clandestine infrastructure, while preparing for large scale warfare, to destroy the remaining vestiges of confidence of the population in the GVN and to extend VC control.
 - (5) Restrict or completely deny the use of the LOCs through interiction and sabotage.

e. Analysis of enemy capabilities.

- (1) The enemy has the capability of replacing his losses or increasing his force, at an accelerated rate by infiltration of NVA and forced recruiting. Such strength increases could again reverse the ratio in favor of the VC.
- (2) Enemy forces committed in the Quang Nam area number eleven battalions (one of which is unidentified). There are eight LF companys in the province, a Sapper company and a transportation battalion which is located along the main infiltration corridor with the mission of manning infiltration stations along the route.
- (3) NVA forces located in northern Quang Tin (P), two regiments and no MF regiment, has the capability of moving into Quang Nam (P) if they are inclined to do so.
- (4) As amply demonstrated, the enemy has been implementing the capabilities described in § (4) and (5) for some time. As a consequence of these actions, the economics and military resources of the GVN have been severely strained. Increased VC pressure has also resulted in a steady deteriation of the security situation in the province.
- (5) The continued freedom on the part of the VC to interdict and sabotage routes of communication at night will eventually result in isolation of GVN forces and centers of influence from access to the rest of the population. VC terrorism, subversion, and psychological warfare activities applied to the population are destroying public confidence in the GVN and will result in further isolation of the GVN unless reduced.

f. Enemy vulnerabilities.

- (1) When the VC are operating away from their base areas they are dependent on the local population for food supplies and porter transportation. Heliance on these resources restricts movement of heavy weapons and large amounts of ammunition. The many varieties of VC weapons complicates their logistics because of the different types of small arms ammunition and repair parts.
- (2) VC forces, when concentrated, are vulnerable to air attacks, and to counterattacks by friendly forces. The VC are also vulnerable to friendly artillery. VC base areas are vulnerable to air attack.
- (3) VC forces are vulnorable to the use of chemical agents by friendly air and ground forces, to include defoilation efforts and food crop destruction.
 - (4) The VC are vulnerable to sustained combat and aggressive pursuit.

g. Conclusions.

(1) Based upon the analysis, the capabilities of the enemy most dangerous to our assigned mission are summarized in order of probability of adoption.

Capability 1

Continue the present tactics employing enemy forces presently available. This action is characterized by small scale attacks, terrorism, assassination, sabotage, propaganda, absolute population control, and repositioning of forces in preparation for higher level of military operations. Occasional large scale attacks, coupled with ambushes of friendly reaction forces where there is a good assurance of success.

Capability 2

Concurrently with Capability 1, completely close all LOCs and launch a series of attacks in an attempt to destroy the remaining vestiges of GVN control outside of USMC influence.

Capability 3

Conduct isolated large scale attacks against districts or the province capitol, utilizing forces to ambush reaction force's routes of approach and likely LZs.

Capability 4

Unilaterally cease fire or standdown of activity so as to remove the excuse for further US buildup and bombing of North Vietnam.

(2) Except for capability 4, no one capability will be adopted to the complete exclusion of any other since it is a principle of VC strategy to adapt their tactics to circumstances existing at a given time.
