SUMMARY OF EVENTS

The initial stages of this period were marked by the preparation of designated individuals and detachments for deployment with RLT-1.

On 20 July, Sub-Unit 2, Headquarters Company, Headquarters Battalion was activated.

Command changes were effected on 16 July, as Colonel P. M. MORIARTY was relieved by Lieutenant Colonel NEIL DIMOND, and again on 3 August, when Colonel J. P. TREADWELL relieved Lieutenant Colonel DIMOND, who then became the Battalion Executive Officer.

The Commanding Officer, First Force Reconnaissance Company departed on 4 August with a twelve man detachment for duty with III Marine Amphibious Force in VIETNAM.

One hundred enlisted personnel were transferred to RLT-1, and on 6 August, detachments of Disbursing, Military Police and a Radio Relay Team were assigned to RLT-1.

Headquarters Battalion stepped up preparations for deployment, as an integral part of the EASTPAC MAB, with receipt of Commanding General, First Marine Division Movement Order, 9 August.

Sub-Unit 2 received a new Officer-in-Charge and all non-deployables were transferred to this unit.

The Battalion Commander led an advance party to OKINAWA, departing CONUS on 15 August by C-130 aircraft. In company with the Division Commander, this advance group arrived on OKINAWA, 19 August and began preparations to receive the main body. Headquarters were established at Camp Courtney.

During the period 21-23 August, embarkation of Headquarters Battalion personnel, equipment and supplies was accomplished at San Diego and Long Beach. Ships of Amphibious Squadron FIVE provided the lift; these were: USS PAUL REVERE (APA-248), USS SKAGIT (AKA-105) and the USS MONTROSE (APA-212). TAK vessels, PRESIDENT HARDING and AMERICAN FALCON, comprised the follow-up shipping.

The main body sailed from San Diego and Long Beach on 23 August; arrived and debarked at White Beach and Naha Port, 11-12 September. Headquarters Company, Service Company and Military Police Company were assigned to Camp Courtney, with Communication Company, Postal and Motor Transport Sections going to Camp Hauge.

An immediate training program was instituted to orient the individual Marine for service in VIETNAM. Emphasis was placed on Land Mines, Booby Traps, Hand Grenades, Civic Action, Physical Conditioning and the firing of organic weapons, in addition to regular requalification firing. Quotas were established and as many personnel as possible attended the Army Vietnamese Language School and The Counter guerrilla Warfare Course the latter being conducted in the Northern Training Area.

On 9 October, Administrative and operational control of First Force Reconnaissance Company was shifted to III Marine Amphibious Force. On 18 October one officer and 35 men of that unit were ordered to DANANG VIETNAM. The remaining detachment was assigned to the administrative/operational control of Headquarters Battalion. Shortly, this detachment was shifted to Camp Schwab under control of First Reconnaissance Battalion.

Detachments were organized, prepared and assigned to deploying BLP's 1/3, 3/1, and 2/3. These detachments were Disbursing, Postal, Photo and Radio Relay Teams.

Staff Visits to a possible future deployment site, CHULAI VIETNAM, were

scheduled and carried out monthly.

The period closed on much the same note as it began, with the Battalion stepping up the tempo of preparation of personnel, equipment and supplies for the impending deployment.

SUMMARY OF EVENTS

1. 10Jan66. BLT 2/5 departed from Pearl for WESTPAC. Headquarters Battalion personnel in support: Postal detachment - 3; Disbursing detachment - 4.
2. 12Jan66. Eleven officers and nineteen enlisted from division headquarters departed by air for Chu Lai to augment 3rdMarDiv ADC Group.
3. 14Jan66. RLT-5 and supporting units embarked at LongBeach/SanDiego and sailed for Okinawa via Pearl. Headquarters Battalion personnel in support: 1st CI Team, 2 officers, 6 enlisted; Two Postal Detachments, 6 enlisted; One Disbursing Detachment, 1 officer, 4 enlisted.
4. 26-27Jan66. Division Command Post construction party deployed to Chu Lai. Officer-in-Charge: Colonel J. P. TREADWELL. Advance party departed 26-27Jan66.
5. 27Jan66. Colonel J. P. TREADWELL reported on TAD orders to RLT-1, III MAF. Lieutenant Colonel NEIL DILOND assumed command of Headquarters Battalion as the Acting Commanding Officer.
6. 5Feb66. Headquarters Battalion detachments in support of RLT-5 revert to Opcon/Adcon of Headquarters Battalion. Units arrived aboard USS Merrick (AKA 97) and USS Talladega (APA 208).
7. 7Feb66. Headquarters Battalion along with 11th Marines and 2ndBn, 5th Marines donated 303 pints of blood for use in the Republic of Viet Nam.
8. 11Feb66. Sub-Unit 2, Headquarters Company, Hq Bn, departed CONUS for WESTPAC.
9. 13Feb66. Bigadier General W. A. STILES and party of 10 other officers, 12 enlisted Marines, and 2 Corpsmen, advance party of 1stMarDiv (Rear), departed from Camp Pendleton by air for Okinawa, stopping at Hq, FMFPac enroute.
10. 16Feb66. Brig. Gen. W. A. STILES and party arrive MCAF Futenma, Okinawa on or about 1248L.
11. 21Feb66. Communication Company Marines cited by mayor of Agena for blood donations to an elderly Okinawan.
12. 23Feb66. Hq Bn Special Services Officer received 40 Krulak kits for use in Chu Lai area.
13. The battalion is in the process of preparing for deployment to RVN. Detachments and personnel joined are as shown on individual company summaries of personnel exchange.
14. Training program continues to emphasize small unit tactics against the Viet Cong and includes indoctrination of personnel with background material on Viet Nam.
15. 28Feb66. Detachment First Dental Company chopped from First Service Battalion to Opcon/Adcon Headquarters Battalion, 1st Marine Division (Rein), FMF and redesignated as First Dental Company.

16. 28Feb66. Honor Guard for Chinese Commandant of Marine Corps, Republic of China. Honors held at 0815 for Lieutenant General YU Mao-Chang.
