PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of December, 1966, substantial progress in training and civic action highlighted events for Headquarters Battalion. For example, seven officers and 230 enlisted attended the Battalion Orientation and Indoc-trination Presentation and three officers and 611 enlisted completed the mod-ified familiarization/test firing of individual and crew-served weapons. Civic action activities for two local hamlets are contained in PART II to this chronology.

119 men made use of the Battalion's scheduled one day R&R trips to China Beach.

Communication Company provided personnel and equipment in support of various operations and assignments, to include:

- a. Seven men to III MAF Communications Center.
- b. Three men to 1st Tank Battalion Radio Relay.
- c. Five men in support of 2/5's communications.
- d. Two men in support of Radar Beacon Teams.
- e. Three men in support of the DaNang Control Radio Relay.

On 24-25 December, in a response to a crash of an airliner just south of the DaNang airfield, this organization dispatched approximately 80 troops and Civic Action personnel, the Battalion Medical Officer, and various pieces of motor transport to the aid in recovery and security requirements.
