SUMMARY OF EVENTS

1. 1Apr66. VC attempted probe of Battalion perimeter at BT531083. VC withdrew when fired on by defending forces. Results of friendly fire were unknown.
2. 5Apr66. Headquarters Battalion provided an honor guard for the Commanding General of the 2nd Infantry Division, RVN on his arrival at the Chu Lai Combat Base to present personal decorations to members of the 1st Marine Division from the Republic of Vietnam.
3. 5Apr66. In anticipation of local political repercussions stemming from current RVN political crisis, Headquarters Battalion organized and placed on standby a 35 man platoon for possible riot control in villages adjacent to the Chu Lai Combat Base.
4. 7Apr66. Headquarters Battalion riot control platoon was removed from a standby status as the RVN political crisis subsided.
5. 10Apr66. Construction Platoon, Radio Relay Company, 7th Communication Battalion arrived from CONUS and disembarked at Chu Lai. Strength 2 officers and 77 enlisted, attached to Headquarters Battalion for operational and administrative control.
6. 12Apr66. A detachment of four photographers and one officer with 24 enlisted men from Military Police Company was attached to 7th Marines for Operation Nevada.
7. 15Apr66. The 3rd ITT was attached to Headquarters Battalion for administrative control.
8. 17Apr66. Headquarters Battalion detachment attached to 7th Marines for Operation Nevada reverted to Battalion control. PFC C. D. MINCEMOYER, photographer attached to 7th Marines, was the only member of the detachment receiving a wound during the operation.
9. 19Apr66. Headquarters Battalion established a special services office and library in the 1st Marine Division Command Post area.
10. 21Apr66. A detachment of 4 photographers and one officer with 23 enlisted men from Military Police Company was attached to 7th Marines for Operation Hot Spring.
11. 23Apr66. Detachment from Headquarters Battalion attached to 7th Marines for Operation Hot Spring reverted to Battalion control. No casualties.
12. 25Apr66. Major J. D. JONES assumed duties as Executive Officer of Headquarters Battalion. Major G. HUBBARD transferred to Chu Lai Defense Command.
13. 25Apr66. 1st IT and 9th ITT joined Headquarters Battalion for administrative control.

14. 25Apr66. Color guard from Headquarters Battalion escorted 1st Marine Division Colors to Quang Ngai to participate in an awards ceremony.

15. 26Apr66. Headquarters Battalion held an awards ceremony on the division parade field. Major General Fields presented decorations to personnel of Headquarters Battalion.
