1. 1 September 1966. A barber shop was opened in the Headquarters Battalion area.
2. 2 September 1966. Major R. G. RICE, USMC, was assigned duties as Executive Officer, Headquarters Battalion.
Sand bag shelters in the Officers' Country and the SNCO billeting area were completed.
Second Lieutenant J. CORCORAN, USMC, was assigned duties as Commanding Officer, 2nd Special Security Communication Team.
3. 5 September 1966. A detachment composed of the following was attached to 5th Marine for operation "NAPA": Communications Company, one officer and nine enlisted; Military Police Company, one officer and 11 enlisted; Headquarters Company, ISO, four enlisted; Service Company, Photo, six enlisted.
The Vietnamese people living in the hamlet of Thanh Long (GC 530085) in the village of Ky Ha completed renovation of their one classroom school. This project was completed under the Self-Help program sponsored by the Civic Action Section of Headquarters Battalion.
CWO-4 H. H. HENSON, USMC, was assigned duties as Headquarters Battalion Motor Transport Officer, vice Captain J. W. MITCHELL, USMC.
4. 8 September 1966. A detachment composed of the following was attached to 7th Marines for operation "FRESNO": Communications Company, two officers and six enlisted; Military Police Company, one officer and six enlisted; Headquarters Company, ISO, two enlisted; Service Company, Photo, two enlisted; Motor Transport, one enlisted.
5. 9 September 1966. A graduation ceremony was held in Xuan Trung hamlet terminating the English class sponsored by this Headquarters. Those students graduating totaled nine and were returned to high school in Tam Ky.
Second Lieutenant G. T. JONES, USMC was assigned duties as Assistant Adjutant, Headquarters Battalion.
6. 10 September 1966. Captain T. D. REESE, USMC, was assigned duties as Commanding Officer, Service Company, vice Captain E. S. P. PUAA, USMC.
7. 14 September 1966. The First Marine Division Band departed Chu Lai, Republic of Vietnam, for a tour of the Far East.
8. 15 September 1966. Headquarters Battalion detachments (ITEM #3) returned to operational control of units of Headquarters Battalion.
9. 17 September 1966. A detachment composed of the following was attached to 5th Marines for operation "GOLDEN FLEECE": Communications Company, two officers and six enlisted; Military Police Company, one officer and six enlisted; Headquarters Company, ISO, five enlisted; Service Company, Photo one officer and five enlisted; Motor Transport, one enlisted.

Headquarters Battalion detachments (ITEM #4) returned to operational control of units of Headquarters Battalion.

10. 19 September 1966. Captain W. F. FLATO, USMC, was assigned duties as Headquarters Battalion Adjutant, vice Second Lieutenant L. H. BRIDGES, USMC. Second Lieutenant L. H. BRIDGES, USMC, was reassigned duties as Headquarters Battalion, Assistant Adjutant.

11. 25 September 1966. Headquarters Battalion Civil Affairs Officer medically evacuated one Vietnamese male from Ky Ha Village to Quang Ngai Hospital for treatment.

12. 27 September 1966. Headquarters Battalion detachments (ITEM #9) returned to operational control of units of Headquarters Battalion.

13. 28 September 1966. Headquarters Battalion provided three military 6x6 trucks to transport 200 Vietnamese school children marking the opening of Mid-Autumn Festival in Ky Ha Village. Those attending the opening were Majors J. S. READY and J. T. SMITH, Assistant G-5's, Captain R. D. SORTINO, and Civil Affairs NCO, SSgt S. P. HOLTRY. Approximately 200 school kits were given to the Headmaster of Ky Ha school along with a number of shower shoes to be given to the students. Photo coverage was provided by 1st Marine Division Photo Section accompanied by an ISO representative.

14. 29 September 1966. A detachment composed of the following was attached to 7th Marines for operation "MONTEREY": Service Company, Photo, two enlisted; Communications Company, two enlisted.

Captain R. D. SORTINO, SSgt S. HOLTRY, CAG-NCO, accompanied by Major James S. READY, Ass't G-5, delivered candy, cookies, ice cream and kool-aid to the schools at Sam Hai and Xuan Trung for approximately 500 children participating in the celebration of the Mid-Autumn Festival in Ky Ha Village. Additionally, apples, cookies and toys were donated to us, for distribution, by the 1st Shore Party CAO. Photo coverage was provided by 1st Marine Division Photo Section accompanied by an ISO representative.

Approximately 150 toys and candy were given, by this organization, to the CAC unit operating in the Ky Ha Village for a similar affair to be conducted for the PF orphans and children not fortunate enough to be participants in the planned school activities.

Colonel W. A. LEITNER, Major James S. READY, Assistant G-5 and Captain R. D. SORTINO, attended ceremonies terminating the Mid-Autumn Festival at Sam Hai and Xuan Trung schools. At each ceremony a warm expression of gratitude was extended to the Marines by the Vietnamese people for helping to make the past two days happy and memorable for both the children and the Vietnamese people. The above noted officers were asked to participate in the awards ceremony whereupon, at the conclusion, Colonel LEITNER expressed his thanks to the Vietnamese people and congratulated them on their successful and meaningful festival.

Mr. Paul HANH, Professional golfer, from Cape Coral, Florida, who is presently on an Armed Forces entertainment tour in Vietnam was escorted to the site of the Mid-Autumn Festival at Sam Hai school where he demonstrated a few trick shots to the Vietnamese children and GAO unit. The children were awed by his demonstration and thoroughly enjoyed it.

15. 30 September 1966. Headquarters Battalion detachments (ITEM #12) returned to operational control of units of Headquarters Battalion.

Captain J. FRY, USMC, Combat Artist, visited Ky Ha Village to take photographs and make sketches of the Vietnamese hamlets and the GAO unit.

Captain V. L. ANDERSON, DC, USN, Force Dental Officer, FMFPAC, visited this command. Captain K. L. MORGAN, DC, USN, Force Dental Officer, III MAF, and Captain C. E. KAILER, DC, USN, Commanding Officer, 11th Dental Company accompanied Captain ANDERSON on a tour of 1st Dental Company facilities in the Chu Lai area. They were escorted by Captain P. C. CONGLIS, DC, USN.

Narrative Summary: During the period 1-30 September 1966, Headquarters Battalion Operation Order 3-66 was published.

In addition, two officers and nine enlisted men participated in "SWIFT" boat training of 22 hour duration and 34 enlisted men attended a one day course of instruction in Land Mine Warfare, Demolition and Booby Trap School, conducted by 1st Engineer Battalion.

A practice "Alert" was held on 9 September 1966, designed to familiarize all hands with the requirements necessary for adequate defense of the Sub-Sector III area.
