NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. TRAINING

a. Two officers and 79 enlisted Marines attended Orientation & Indoctrination classes.

b. 11 Marines attended formal schools in the month of January.

2. COMMAND POST SECURITY

a. A total of 31 daylight security patrols were conducted around the Division Command Post.

b. A total of 25 night security patrols were conducted around the Division Command Post.

3. CIVIC ACTION

a. MedCaps were held twice a week during the month. The MedCap personnel treated 525 people. DentCap treated 17.

b. Approximately 300 gift packets were distributed to the children in the hamlet HOA MY.

c. The battalion CAO attended a TET party at the HOA MY hamlet Chief's home on 31 Jan.

4. PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS. During January, the 244th PsyOpsCo showed one movie to approximately 300 people in the hamlet of HOA MY and 100 small red balls were distributed in support of the CHIEU HOI program.


