1. TRAINING

- a. 102 Marines attended the Orientation and Indoctrination classes.
- b. 12 Marines attended formal schools in the month of April 1968.

2. COMMAND POST SECURITY

- a. A total of 29 daylight security patrols were conducted around the Division Command Post.
- b. No night security patrols were conducted around the Division Command Post.

- a. A total of nine MedCaps and five DentCaps were conducted during this period treating 875 and 72 persons respectfully, in the Hamlet of Hoa My.
- b. The Hamlet continued providing two girls to aid the MedCap/DentCap Teams on the Hamlet's self-help health program.
- c. The Civic Action Team completed the following: (Civic Action Efforts) delivered dunnage for the school restroom, delivered cement for the construction of wells; and completed a bulletin board for the market place. The Hamlet has finished the following projects with materials supplied by the Civic Action Team: Building of 3 doors and 3 shutters for the dispensary, and the building of 18 benches and a table for the Hamlet Chiefs Office. During the first week of April, a four day training course for the Hamlet's Self-Defense Force was conducted.
- d. One dental officer and one dental technician are assigned duties in Civic Action. Other dental officers accompany the units they support on their Civic Action visits. Procedures have been initiated to hire two additional Vietnamese girls for training as dental assistants. The company's Civic Action included the rendering of dental treatment in the following hamlets and villages during April: Hoa Cung, Hoa Vang, San Hoa, Nai Hien Dong, Hoa My, Tin Lahn School, Thoc Ghan, So Ha and the Sacred Heart Orphanage.
