1. IPCo continues to perform its routine and recurring duties, tasks and functions within the Division TACB. These include: Police and traffic control of National route 1L 1A & 1B; police control of the Division Rear area including IEP facilities at Freedom Hill and the IEP 147 transient facility RTR Center; operation of IEP compounds (straggler collection points) at the 5th and 7th Marine Regimental CP's; and traffic control points at designated areas.

2. During April, the CTR section closed 110 cases, the accident investigation unit completed 62 vehicle investigations and 356 police reports were issued and 102 traffic violations tickets were written.
