NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Headquarters Battalion (Reinforced) continued to provide administrative communication, service and military police support to the 1st Marine Division. Security for the division command post was provided and civic action programs were conducted. The attached Dental Company provided dental support throughout the division TAOR and participated in unit civic action programs.

PART III

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

- 1-31 May Headquarters Company maintained an average monthly strength of 224 officers, 897 enlisted USMC, 13 officers and 28 Navy enlisted. The Battalion Aid Station treated 563 Marines and 278 Vietnamese personnel.
- 1-31 May Communications Company continued to provide both command and functional support for the 1st Marine Division.
- 1-31 May Military Police Company continued to perform both routine and recurring duties in the 1st Marine Division TAOR.
- 1-31 May Service Company continued to maintain the Division Command Post. The Disbursing Section maintained an average of 25,000 pay records. The total mileage for the Battalion vehicles was 97,215 miles. The Battalion Supply Section made 2,636 requisitions and 985 issues.
- 1-31 May The Civic Action Officer conducted four (4) MedCaps at the hamlets of Phuoc Thuan and Hoa Khong treating 228 persons.
- 1-31 May 1st Dental Company treated 6,424 military personnel and 327 Vietnamese patients.
- 13 May Combined Action Group located at (AF 959768) Da Son apprehended three (3) Vietnamese with one (1) weapon. Vietnamese turned over to ITT for disposition.
- 15 May Civic Action Officer presented ten (10) General WALT Scholarships to children of Phuoc Thuan and Hoa Khong hamlets.
- 16 May Military Police Company established, in conjunction with the 504th Military Police Battalion, U.S. Army, a control station for the Joint Combined Patrol of J1 at the Combined Station in Dog Patch.

1. MFCo continues to perform its routine and recurring duties, task and functions within the Division TAOR. These includes: Police and traffic control of National route QL1 and 1B; police control of the Division Rear area including III MAF facilities at Freedom Hill and the III MAF transient facility, R&R Center; operation of POW compounds (Straggler collection points) at the 5th and 7th Marines Regimental CP's; and traffic control points designated areas.

2. During May, the CID section opened 83 cases, the accident investigation unit completed 54 vehicle investigations and 320 police reports were issued and 709 traffic violations tickets were written.

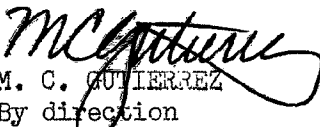

1. In accordance with reference (a), the following information is submitted.

2. Civic Action

a. All the civic action efforts were held in the hamlets of Phuoc Thuan and Hoa Khuong.

b. On 2 May 1970, the Civic Action team provided a truck to transport the children of Phuoc Thuan hamlet to China Beach and back to the hamlet. On 8 May 1970, the Civic Action team delivered 10 bags of cement to Hoa Khuong hamlet for the reconstruction of a well, and 20 sheets of roof tin were delivered to Phuoc Thuan hamlet for the repair of the hamlet meeting place. The Civic Action team delivered one truck loads of dunnage to Phuoc Thuan on 13 May 1970. On 15 May 1970, the Civic Action officer presented ten General Walt Scholarships to the ten school children of Phuoc Thuan and Hoa Khuong hamlets.

c. The Commanding Officer of Headquarters Battalion visited the hamlets of Phuoc Thuan and Hoa Khuong on 8, 12, 30 May 1970, and the Executive Officer visited hamlets on 19 May 1970.

d. English classes were conducted at the hamlet of Hoa My on Sundays and at Phan Chu Trinh School in DaNang on Tuesday and Friday nights.

e. A total of four MedCaps were conducted at the hamlets of Phuoc Thuan and Hoa Khuong, treating 228 persons respectively.

3. PSYOPS. Consisted of hand distribution of "Sanitation" leaflets and "Thong Cam" magazine to the hamlet people.
