1. MPCo continues to perform its routine and recurring duties, task and functions within the Division TAOR. These include: Police and traffic control of National route QL1 and 1B; police control of the Division Rear area including III MAF facilities at Freedom Hill and the III MAF transient facility, R&R Center; operation of POW compound at III MAF; and traffic control points designated areas.

1. In accordance with reference (a), the following information is submitted.

2. Civic Action

a. All the civic action efforts were held in the hamlets of Phuoc Thuan and Hoa Khuong.

b. On 3 June 1970, a little girl 12 years old, living at Phuoc Thuan hamlet, was taken to the Children Hospital in order to treat a big boil on her head.

On 4 June 1970, the Civic Action team delivered 20 bags of cement, 8 sheets of roof tin, 4 sheets of plywood and 6 pieces of lumber 2x4 to the hamlets of Hoa Khuong and Phuoc Thuan for the construction of an additional MedCap room, one pig-stye and a well.

On 13 June 1970, a milk program was set up and has been distributed to the school children of Hoa Khuong and Phuoc Thuan hamlets.

On 22 June 1970, a hamlet chief election was held at Hoa Khuong hamlet. Mr. Chuc, a PF, was elected new Hamlet Chief.

On 25 June 1970, the Civic Action team distributed fruits and vegetables to the hamlet people of Hoa Khuong and Phuoc Thuan.

c. The Commanding Officer of Headquarters Battalion visited the hamlets of Hoa Khuong and Phuoc Thuan on 2, 16, 23 June, 1970.

On 30 June, The Commanding Officer of Headquarters Battalion visited the hamlets, and an ice cream and cold drinking party was served for about 400 people of Phuoc Thuan and Hoa Khuong hamlets.

d. English classes were conducted at Phan Chu Trinh school in DaNang on Friday and Tuesday nights.

e. A total of five MedCaps and one DentCap were conducted at the hamlets of Phuoc Thuan and Hoa Khuong, treating 267 and 7 persons respectively.

3. PSYOPS. Hand distribution of "Sanitation" leaflets, and leaflets announcing rewards for turn in of enemy ordnance to the hamlet people at the MedCaps.
