PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

Headquarters Battalion (Reinforced) continued its routine and recurring activities in support of the 1st Marine Division. Administrative, communication and military police support was furnished throughout the Division TAOR. Security around the Division Command Post and combat patrols were scheduled and conducted within the Headquarters Battalion TAOR. Training of the Provisional Rifle Companies was initiated to increase the proficiency and reaction capabilities for each company. Companies conducted training of individual Marines conducive with the combat commitments of each unit, with emphasis on fire discipline and control of the individual rifleman and automatic rifleman. The attached Dental Company provided dental support throughout the Division TAOR. The Civic Action Program was continued in accordance with current directives. All units prepared for the proposed stand down and withdrawal of the 1st Marine Division from VietNam.

- 18Jul70 An MPCo Combined Station vehicle was destroyed by an unknown explosive device. This was classified as a terrorist activity.



1. MPGo continues to perform its routine and recurring duties, task and functions within the Division TAOR. These include: Police and traffic control of National route QL1 and 1B; police control of the Division Rear area including III MAF facilities at Freedom Hill and the III MAF transient facility, R&R Center; operation of POW compound at III MAF; and traffic control points designated areas.

Ref: (a) BnBul 3000 dtd 9 July 1970

1. Purpose. To publish results of Provisional Rifle Companies inspection and training conducted.
2. Information. In accordance with reference (a), two company formations were held. The 1st Provisional Rifle Company was mustered at 1745 on 9 July. Upon completion of mustering, the company embarked on trucks and proceeded to the Dai La Rifle Range. The 2d Provisional Rifle Company was formed at 1815 on 9 July for inspection. The following results of both companies are herewith listed.

a. 1st Provisional Company

- (1) 1745 company mustered
- (2) 1800 embarked aboard trucks, proceeded to Dai La Pass Rifle Range.
- (3) Concurrent instruction was conducted while each fire team, squad and platoon conducted their fire exercises. Instruction was held on coverage of targets of opportunity, specific targets for riflemen and coverage of entire target area assigned automatic riflemen. Small and automatic fires encompassed targets up to 300 meters. Each Marine was afforded an opportunity to fire his weapon on auto selection utilizing two magazines of 18 rounds each. All weapons functioned properly with no malfunctions. Two bent magazines caused a failure to feed, these were replaced. One M-60 machine gun failed to fire due to a defective barrel. The defective barrel was replaced by the Headquarters Battalion Armory. Upon completion of small arms firing, each Marine was instructed on the safety precautions of the M-26 hand grenade, upon completion of instruction each Marine was allotted 3 grenades to expend. No casualties were reported.

- (4) Total M-16 rounds fired ~~was~~ approximately 10,000.
- (5) Total M-26 grenades expended ~~was~~ 180.
- (6) Total number of troops firing ~~was~~ 101.
- (7) Completed firing at 1945, troops returned to area at approximately 2000 9 July 1970.

(8) Problems encountered

- (a) Bont magazines
- (b) Dirty weapons (approx 10 weapons)
- (c) 1 M-60 machine gun faulty gun barrel

(9) Corrections of problems

- (a) Magazines replaced
- (b) Weapons were cleaned prior to firing
- (c) Machine gun barrel replaced, test firing will be accomplished on 10 July 1970.

b. 2d Provisional Rifle Company

(1) 1815 company was formed.

(2) 1830 inspection of personnel and equipment, conducted by Headquarters Battalion S-3 Operations Officer. Total number present for inspection 4 officer 98 enlisted.

- (a) 1st Platoon CommCo 1 officer 38 enlisted
- (b) 2d Platoon Hq 11thMar 1 officer 29 enlisted
- (c) 3rd Platoon SoryCo 1 officer 30 enlisted

(3) Results of inspection for the 1st Platoon

- (a) Comm Platoon, approximately 10 dirty weapons mostly superficial dust.
- (b) Equipment was in very good shape.
- (c) Platoon was organized and troops were aware of their jobs within the squad.

(d) Average length of time since last firing of individual weapon averaged approximately 3 months.

(4) Headquarters 11th Marines Platoon

(a) Approximately 60% of weapons were dirty. Questionable reliability of weapons functioning.

(b) Approximately 20 troops had either (1) canteen or no canteens.

(c) Approximately 20 had no first aid kits.

(d) Squads were not properly formed into fire teams.

(e) Approximately (6) armored vest unserviceable.

(f) Average length of time since firing individual weapons included, troops who have never fired since arriving in country, up to periods of 9 months since last fired.

(5) Service Company Platoon

(a) Approximately 10 dirty weapons.

(b) Squads were formed however troops were not aware of positions within fire teams.

(c) Some troops were missing first aid packets.

(d) Generally equipment was in serviceable condition.

(e) Average length of time since last firing of individual weapons, approximately 4 months.

3. Action. Several problem areas encountered indicates a lack of interest on part of individuals and a loss of command interest. Company Commanders will inspect these personnel in reaction platoons on a frequent basis to insure prior to next inspection weapons are clean and serviceable, the individual Marine is aware of his responsibilities within the Squad/Platoon and his individual equipment is serviceable. Platoon commanders of respective platoons will hold instructions on his platoon conducive to the individual Marine regular duties during periods that the unit is in a stand-by status as a reaction unit. Suggested subjects of instruction:

a. First aid/buddy aid

b. Fire discipline

c. Fire and maneuver (Fire team/Squad)

d. Fire team/squad tactics

e. Weapons inspection

Company Commanders of Provisional Rifle Companies will submit to Battalion S-3, training accomplished on a weekly basis.



(1) Lack of personnel for the 2d Provisional Company.



A woman, living at Hoa Khuong, was taken to the BAS. and 1st Med. Battalion for her eye treatment on 23, 24, 25 and 28 July 1970. 24 July 1970, the Civic Action team provided a truck to transport the hamlet people to DaNang in order to buy the building materials for their house improvement.

c. Project completed: 2 wells; one at Hoa Khuong and another well at Phuoc Thuan.

d. The Commanding Officer of Headquarters Battalion visited the hamlets of Phuoc Thuan and Hoa Khuong on 28 July 1970.

e. English classes were conducted at Phan Chu Trinh School in DaNang on Tuesday and Friday nights.

f. A total of four MedCaps were conducted at the hamlets of Phuoc Thuan and Hoa Khuong, treating 226 patients respectively.

3. PSYOPS. Hand distribution of "Sanitation" leaflets and "Thong Cam" magazine to the hamlet people at the MedCaps.






