

PARTIINARRATIVE SUMMARY

Headquarters Battalion (Reinforced) continued its routine and recurring activities in support of the 1st Marine Division. Administrative, communication, and military police support was furnished throughout the Division TAOR. Security positions around the Division Command Post, to include the ridgeline to the south of the command post, were manned, and combat patrols were scheduled and conducted within the Headquarters Battalion TAOR. The TAOR was reduced in size on 10 August 1970, when 1st Battalion 5th Marines assumed responsibility for security of the ridgeline, and the Northern Sector Defense Command was disbanded. Headquarters Battalion continued to man perimeter security positions. Training of the Provisional Rifle Company consisted of several live fire exercises to familiarize individual Marines with the several infantry weapons, including the M-60 and 50 cal. machine guns, the LAAW, M-79 grenade launcher, and individual weapons. The attached Dental Company provided dental support throughout the Division TAOR. The Civic Action Program was continued in accordance with current directives. All units continued to prepare for and participate in redeployment operations of the 1st Marine Division.

1-31Aug70 Headquarters Battalion maintained an average monthly strength of 244 officers, USMC 1703 enlisted, USMC, 11 officers, USN and 25 enlisted, USN.

1-31Aug70 Communications Company continued to supply both command and functional support for the 1st Marine Division.

1-31Aug70 Military Police Company continued its mission in support of the 1st Marine Division.

1-31Aug70 Service Company continued to support the Division Command Post.

The Disbursing Office maintained an average of 20,530 pay records. The Battalion Supply Section, in addition to preparing for redeployment, continued to requisition and issue supplies for the Battalion.

3Aug70 The Division Rear POW Collection Point at III MAF Brig was closed.

10Aug70 Security of the ridgeline south of the Division Command Post was assumed by 1st Battalion 5th Marines. Headquarters Battalion continued to man defensive positions. Northern Sector Defense Command was disbanded.

1-21Aug70 Preparation continued for embarkation and redeployment of the increment of Headquarters Battalion.

22-23Aug70 15,970 cubic feet of bulk cargo, 5,000 cubic feet of mobile leaded cargo, 65 vehicles, and 72 personnel were embarked on the USS Alamo and USS Juneau.

1. M.P. Company continues its routine and recurring duties, task and functions within the Division TAOR. These include: Police and traffic control of roads west of National Route QL1 and QL1B; police control of the Division Rear area including III MAF facilities at Freedom Hill and the III MAF transient facility, R & R Center; and traffic control points in designated areas.
