PART II

Headquarters Battalion continued its routine and recurring activities in support of the 1st Marine Division, with increased emphasis on cantonment security in preparation for T.T. Additional bunkers were built and manned, while others were improved or rebuilt, and additional lights for illumination were installed. The Provisional Rifle Company was streamlined, reorganized and drilled repetitively. The Medical Civic Action Program was held five times during the month, and was highlighted by the helicopter medical evacuation of a seriously injured Vietnamese, who was subsequently treated and returned to his home to recover. Administrative, Military Police, Communications, and Maintenance support continued as usual.

- 1-31 Jan 71 Headquarters Battalion maintained an average monthly strength of 186 USMC officers, 994 USMC enlisted, 8 USM officers and 26 USM enlisted.

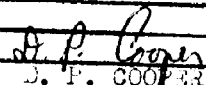

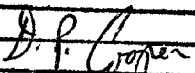
