PART 2NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of February significant improvement was made to road trafficability in the MP Valley area of Headquarters Company by improving drainage in the area and spreading crushed rock in heavily traveled low areas. Headquarters Company continued to provide administrative support for all the sections of the company and attempted to improve the input to the MMS by having extra training, both formal and OJT for administration personnel. Also the company continued to man defensive positions on the battalion perimeter and during the month rebuilt all of the bunkers and fighting holes on the company's portion of the perimeter.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Headquarters Battalion continued its routine and recurring activities involving the functioning and security of the Division Command Post. This entire month was also spent in Alert Condition Gray, due to the increased enemy threat after Tet. Administrative, Communication, Military Police, and service support were furnished throughout the Division TAOR. Organic units manned defensive positions around the Cantonment perimeter, and Headquarters Battalion continued to coordinate the defense of Sector "B" of the 2nd Battalion 1st Marines TAOR. A Reserve/Reaction Company was maintained. A weekly MEDCAP was held in the hamlets of Hoa Khuong and Phuoc Thuan. Preparations for stand down and redeployment continued and intensified. Some units were moved back to CONUS, thus putting additional security requirements on this headquarters.


