PART 2NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of February significant improvement was made to road trafficability in the MP Valley area of Headquarters Company by improving drainage in the area and spreading crushed rock in heavily traveled low areas. Headquarters Company continued to provide administrative support for all the sections of the company and attempted to improve the input to the MMS by having extra training, both formal and OJT for administration personnel. Also the company continued to man defensive positions on the battalion perimeter and during the month rebuilt all of the bunkers and fighting holes on the company's portion of the perimeter.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY
