Building materials were distributed to the hamlet of Hoa Khuong for the construction of wells and to repair a section of road. Distribution of dried milk was made to the hamlet children and four MedCaps were conducted at Hoa Khuong and Phuoc Thuan. The construction of wells at Hoa Khuong hamlet is continuing. Repair a section of road at Hoa Khuong was complete on 20 Mar 71.
