(3) Consolidated Operations Summary

1. ASSIGNMENTS

- A. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st AmTrac Bn. Three LVT's are deadlined to company maintenance. One LVTE 1 and ten LVTP5's are indirect support of 1/4. Two LVTP5's are in direct support of 2/4. One LVTP5 is in direct support of MAG-12 for use as a crash/rescue vehicle.
- B. Co B (-), 3d AT Bn. Company Headquarters continues maintenance and logistical support of the Ontos platoons in direct support of the two infantry battalions. One defensive position in the Headquarters, 4th Marines perimeter was manned from 211630H to 220630H, with no enemy contact. The 1st platoon is in direct support of 1st Battalion, 4th Marines with the light section in the Battalion CP area and the heavy section in the Company A area. The 2d platoon continues in direct support of the 2d Battalion, 4th Marines with the entire platoon located in the Battalion CP area. Deadlined equipment included 2 M-35's, 1 M-49 and 1 M422.

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C. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st Tank Bn. The Company Headquarters continues maintenance and logistical support of the tank platoons. The 2d platoon continues in direct support of the 2d Battalion, 4th Marines with 5 tanks located in the Battalion CP area, Hill 69. The 3d platoon continues in direct support of the 1st Battalion, 4th Marines with tanks located at BT 527089. At night one section moves to defensive positions at BT 528106. No enemy contact in the last 24 hours.

D. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st Engr Bn.

- (1) Provided 4 instructors for Mine Warfare School.
- (2) Building bunker for 2/4, 98% completed.
- (3) Strongbacked 4 CP tents for 2/4, 100% completed.
- (4) Building messhall at Hill 69 for 2/4, 75% completed.
- (3) Building galley for messhall at Hill 69 for 2/4, 25% completed.

2. H&S COMPANY. PROVIDE FOUR MARINES AND ONE RADIO OPERATOR FOR COORDINATED USMC/PF AMBUSH. PROVIDE FOUR MARINES AND ONE RADIO OPERATOR FOR THE WATERBORNE PATROL. REPORT TO SPLASH POINT BY 1930H.
3. COMPANY B.
 - A. KAHUKU (BT 477144) IS A PATROL BASE MANNED 24 HOURS A DAY BY ONE PLATOON (REIN) WITH ONE MACHINE GUN SECTION (.50 CAL.), AND A SECTION OF 81MM MORTARS.
 - B. KAHOO LAWE IS AN OUTPOST (BT 459144) MANNED 24 HOURS A DAY BY A SQUAD (REIN) WITH ONE SQUAD M-60 MACHINE GUN, AND ONE SECTION 3.5 ROCKETS.
 - C. B-1C IS NINE MAN PATROL. A THREE MAN LISTENING POST WILL BE PLACED IN POSITIONS AT PALI, MOLOKAI, WAIKANE. THESE LP's WILL RETURN BY SEPERATE ROUTES.

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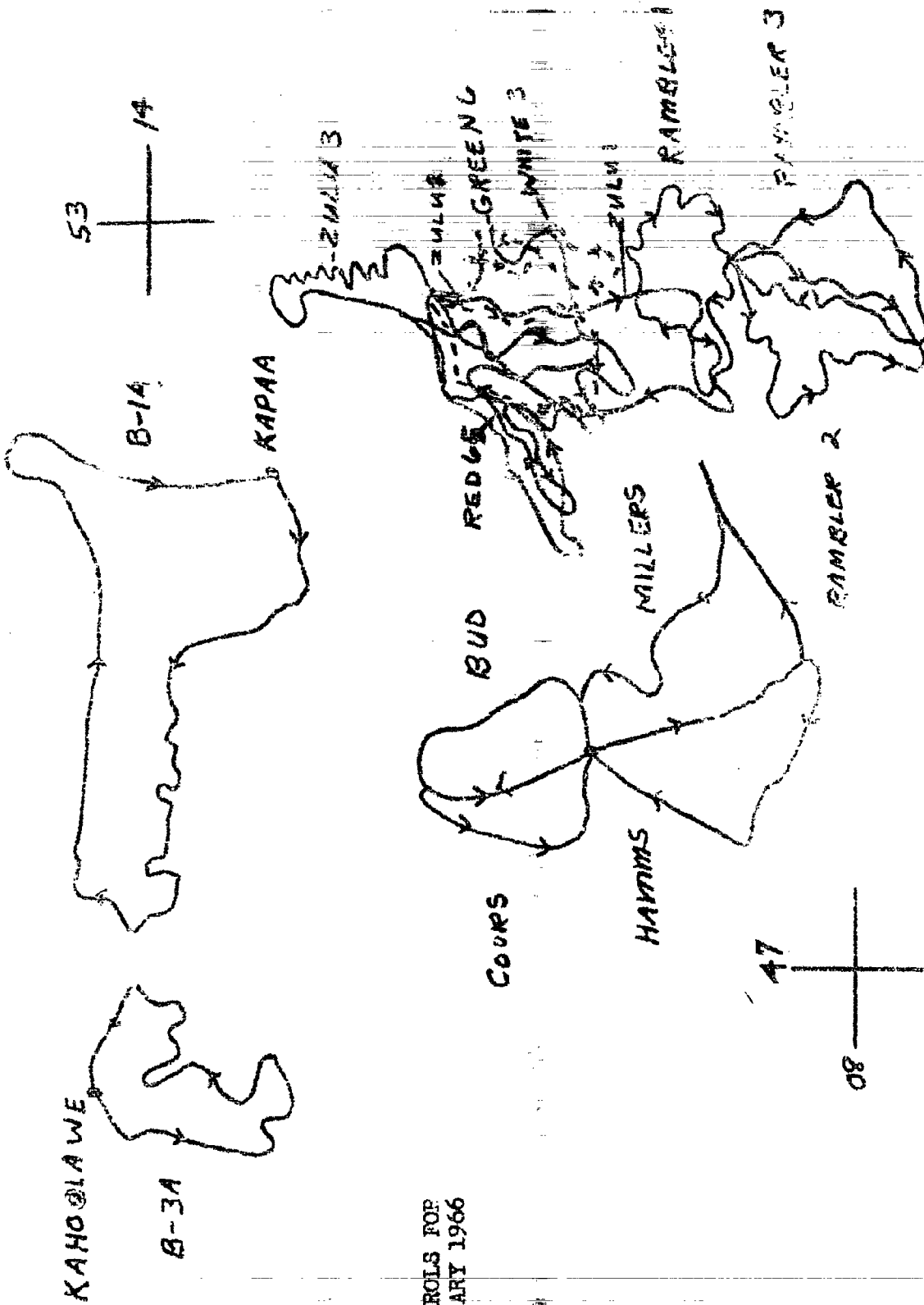

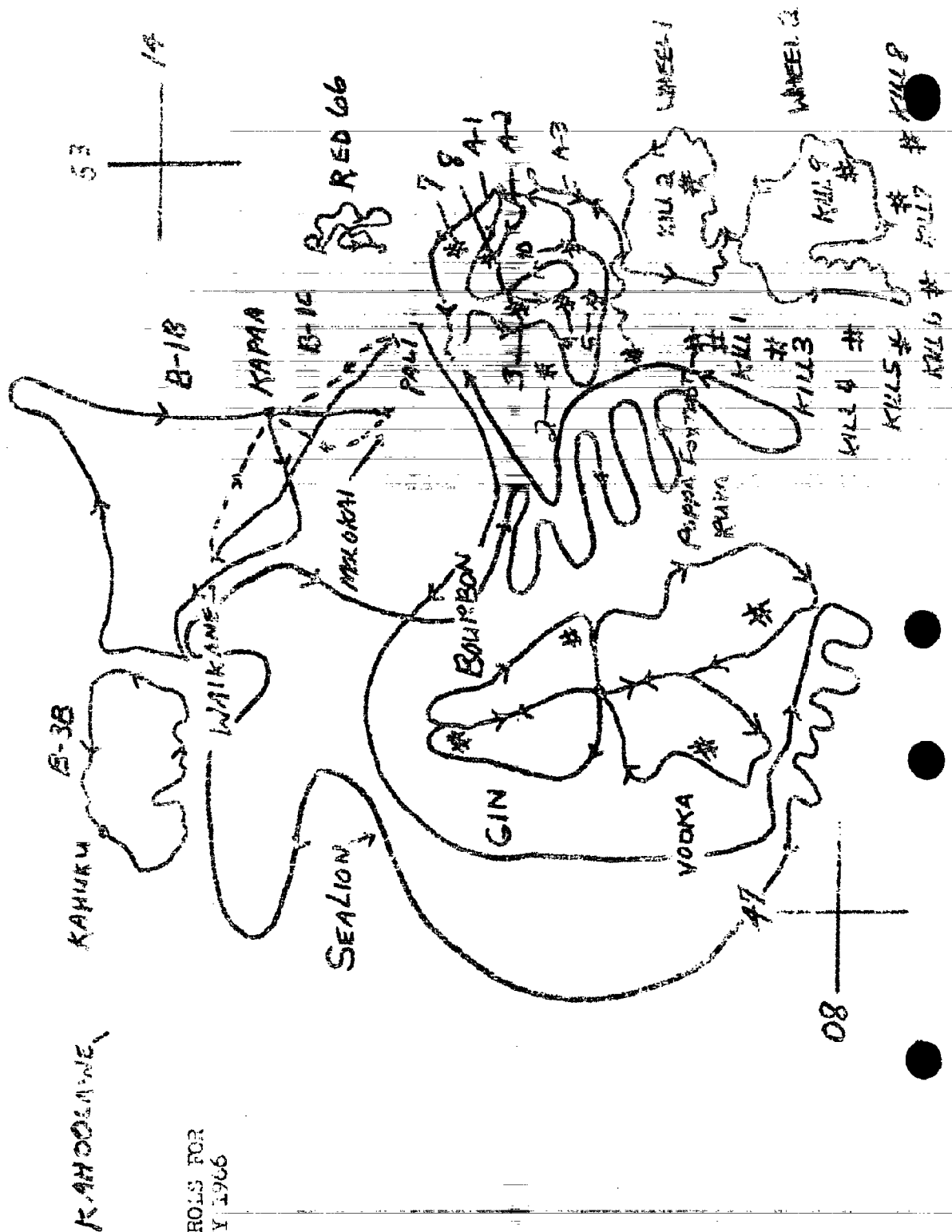
