(2) Consolidated Operations Summary

1. ATTACHMENTS.

A. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st A-Free Bn. One LVTE1 and ten LVTP5's are in direct support of 1/4. Two LVTP5's are in direct support of 2/4. Four LVT's are dead-lined to company maintenance. Thirteen LVTP5's, one LVTE1 and one LVT command tractor are in direct support of Task Force Delta.

B. Co B (-) (Rein), 1st AT Bn. Company Headquarters continues maintenance and logistical support of the 1st and 2d platoons which are in direct support of the 1st Battalion, 4th Marines. One defensive position in the Headquarters, 4th Marines perimeter was manned from 271830H to 280630H with no enemy contact. The 1st platoon continues in direct support of the 1st Battalion, 4th Marines with the light section located at the Battalion CP (Rear). The heavy section is located in the Co M, 3/7 area which was formerly occupied by Co A, 1/4. The 2d platoon is located at Hill 69 complex. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Deadlined equipment included two M35's, one M49 and one M422.

C. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st Tank Bn. Company Headquarters continues logistical support of the two tank platoons. The 2d platoon is in direct support of 1/4 at Hill 69. The 3d platoon is in direct support of 1/4. A light section moves from normal daytime positions at NF 527009 to night time positions at NF 528106. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Deadlined equipment included one M38A1.

D. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st Eng Bn.

- (1) Continued work on 1st Marine messhall
- (2) Deadlined equipment included one M-274, one chain saw, one TD-18 tractor, one TD-15 tractor, one 55 GPM pump and one M-37 truck.

1ST BN, 4TH MARINES SITREP NUMBER 267 AS OF 281600H JANUARY 1966

1. Unit Action With Contact.

- a. At 272100H, a Company B platoon outpost located at (BT 476143) fired an 81mm mortar H and I mission at suspected enemy movement at (BT 472147). The area was observed at dawn and there were no enemy casualties observed.
- b. At 272130H, a Battery A, 1st LAAM Battalion fire team patrol apprehended two VN male curfew violators who were fishing at (BT 510163). Both curfew violators were turned over to the Village Chief of KY HOA Island (BT 4914) the following morning.
- c. At 280005H, MAG-36 defensive lines observed three VN in the vicinity of the defensive wire at (BT 525114). The area was illuminated by hand held flare. As soon as the flare went off three incoming S/A rounds were received from the vicinity of the VN at the wire. MAG-36 defensive lines in that area returned 42 M-14 and M-60 MG rounds. The VN fled the area and no enemy casualties were observed.
- d. At 280935H, a Company D (-) combat patrol located at (BT 452109) received two sniper rounds from the vicinity of (BT 440110). The distance to the origin of firing was too great to return fire and the sniper was unobserved. The patrol continued on its patrol route toward the sniper but there was no enemy located in that area.
- e. At 281015H, the Company D (-) combat patrol located at (BT 439098), received S/A's and automatic weapons fire from approximately 15 VC located in the vicinity of (BT 428094). S/A's fire, one M-79 and two 3.5 inch rocket launcher rounds were immediately returned. Two of the VC were seen falling down but when the area was investigated by the patrol there were no wounded or dead VC in the area. 2 8115
- f. At 281050H, the Company D (-) combat patrol apprehended one VCS in the vicinity of (BT 425090). The VCS was a 14 year old male who was seen in the area from which the patrol had received sniper fire at 281015H. The boy was turned over to LY TIN District Headquarters.
