1. ATTACHMENT.

A. Co A (-) (Main), 1st AT Bn. One LVTB and ten LVTB's are in direct support of 1/4. Two LVTB's are in direct support of 1/4 at the An Tan Bridge. Thirteen LVTB's, one LVTB and one LVT command tractor are in direct support of Task Force Delta. Two LVTB's are detailed to company maintenance.

B. Co B (-), 1st AT Bn. Company Headquarters continues maintenance and logistical support of the 1st and 2nd platoons which are in direct support of 1/4. One defensive position in the Headquarters, 4th Marines perimeter was moved from 001830N to 000630N. The 1st platoon continues in direct support of 1/4, with the light section located in the Battalion CP (Rear). The heavy section located in the Co "K", 3/7 area formerly occupied by Co "A", 1/4. The 2nd platoon is located at Hill 69 complex. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Detailed equipment included two M55's, one M57, one M49 and one M422.

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C. Co A (-)(Rein), 1st Tank Bn. Company Headquarters continues logistical support of the two tank platoons. The 2d platoon is in direct support of 1/4 at Hill 69. The 3d platoon is in direct support of 1/4. A light section moves from normal daytime positions at NF 327009 to positions at NF 328106. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Reassigned equipment included one M48 A1 Tank.

D. Co A (-)(Rein), 1st Bn. Bn.

1. Unit Action With Cont

- a. At 030115H, a fire team listening post from Company B vicinity (BT 500130) apprehended 13 curfew violators. At 030205H four curfew violators and at 030250H two more curfew violators were apprehended. All curfew violators were turned over to the Village Chief for disposition.
- b. At 030203H, Company A in their defensive positions received two incoming hand grenades, vicinity (BT 514063). Area was illuminated, however, nothing was observed. Area was searched with negative results.
- c. At 030330H, a fire team from Company C activated a booby trap consisting of two M-26 hand grenades placed on each side of the trail with a trip wire connecting the two. When the wire was tripped only one of the grenades was activated which was a dud. The wire broke and the pin from the second grenade was not pulled. FCB team was dispatched and destroyed the grenades the next morning.
- d. At 031117H, a platoon from Company D vicinity (BT 444055) received S/A fire from vicinity (BT 435053). Fire was returned and VC broke contact and fled the area before the platoon could close and destroy.

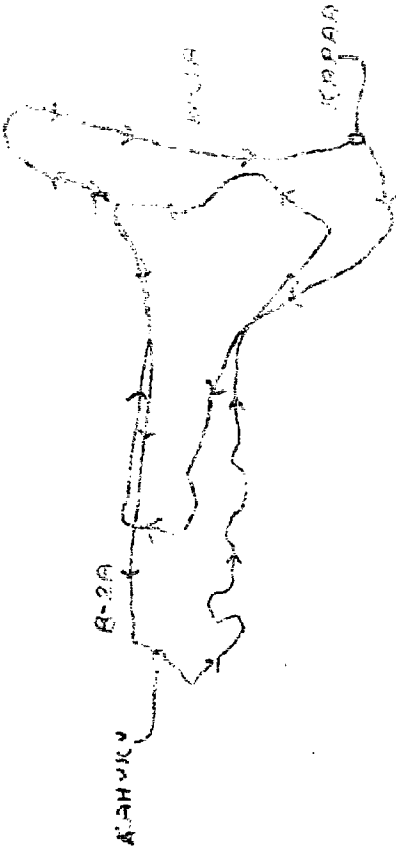

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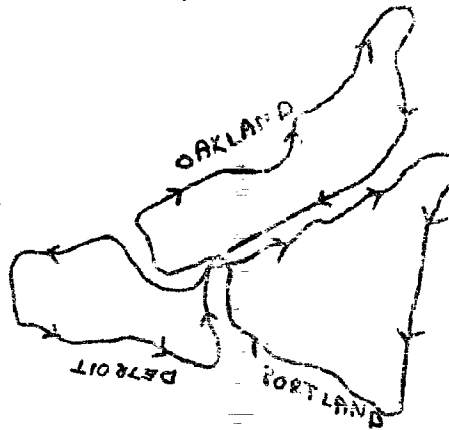

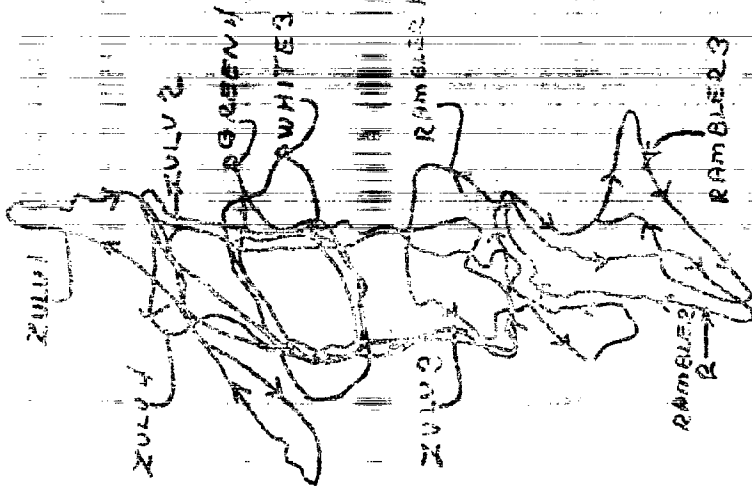
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DAK PATROLS FOR
