(2) Consolidated Operations Summary

1. ATTACHMENTS

A. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st AirTrac Bn. One LVTH1 and ten LVTP5's are in direct support of 1/4. Two LVTP5's are in direct support of 1/4 at the An Tan Bridge. Thirteen LVTP5's, one LVTH1 and one LVT command tractor are in direct support of Task Force Delta. Two LVTP5's are deadlined to company maintenance.

B. Co B (-), 3d AT Bn. Company Headquarters continues maintenance and logistical support of the 1st and 2d platoons which are in direct support of 1/4. One defensive position in the Headquarters, 4th Marines perimeter was manned from 051830H to 060630H. The 1st platoon continues in direct support of 1/4, with the light section located in the Battalion CP (Rear). The heavy section is located in the Co "M", 3/7 area formerly occupied by Co "A", 1/4. The 2d platoon is located at Hill 69 complex. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Deadlined equipment included two M35's, one M37 and one M422.

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C. Co A (-) (Main), 1st Tank Bn. Company Headquarters continues logistical support of the two tank platoons. The 2d platoon is in direct support of 1/4 at Hill 69. The 3d platoon is in direct support of 1/4. A light section moves from normal daytime positions at BT 527089 to positions at BT 528106. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Xenon infrared surveillance was conducted at intervals during hours of darkness. Deadlined equipment included one M48A3 tank and two M54 tanks.

D. Co A (-) (Main), 1st Bn. Bn.

- (1) Continued work on messhall.
- (2) Hauled sand and lumber, for the units in the Chu Lai Enclave.
- (3) Deadlined equipment included one TD-15 tractor, one TD-15 tractor, two 35 GPM pumps, one M-274 and one M-51 truck.

1. Unit Action With Contact.

- T a. At 052055H, the waterborne patrol, apprehended one male ~~our~~ few violator vicinity (BT 512112). ~~fff~~
- b. A joint Company A/PF platoon sized patrol moved from the Company A area at 060730H. PF's were dropped off in an ambush site vicinity (BT 433042). PF's took VC under fire at 061135H killing one and wounding two. One U.S. carbine captured. PF's were taken under fire by A/W from vicinity (BT 424040), called for artillery fire and withdrew while it was being fired. No friendly casualties, no surveillance.

2. Psychological Warfare.

- a. During a battalion (-) operation on 5 February 1966, 400 leaflets of 4-65 and 400 leaflets of 5-65 series were distributed to the villagers located on the KY CHUONG Peninsula vicinity (BT 4411).

3. Miscellaneous.

- a. Training. Training continues to be primarily on-the-job with emphasis placed on the area applicable to the assigned mission of the Battalion according to MOS. In addition the following number of Marines attended the below listed classes:
