1. ATTACHMENTS.

A. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st AsTrac Bn. One LVT-1 and ten LVT-5's in direct support of 1/4. Two LVT-5's are in direct support of 1/4 at the An Tan Bridge. Thirteen LVT-5's, one LVT-1 and one LVT command tractor are in direct support of Task Force Delta. Two LVT-5's are detailed to company maintenance.

B. Co B (-), 3d AT Bn. Company Headquarters continues maintenance and logistical support of the 1st and 2d platoons which are in direct support of 1/4. One defensive position in the Headquarters, 4th Marines perimeter was manned from 071030H to 080630H. The 1st platoon continues in direct support of 1/4, with the light section located in the Battalion CP (Near). The heavy section is located in the Co H, 3/7 area formerly occupied by Co A, 1/4. The heavy section is located at Hill 69 complex. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Detailed equipment included two M55's, one M37 and one M42.

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C. Go A (-) (Rain), 1st Tank Bn. Company Headquarters continues logistical support of the two tank platoons. 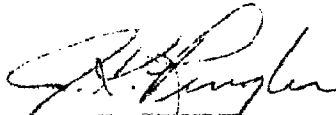

The squad leader stated the VC (identified by the PF's) were running away from them when observed. There were ~~in~~ rice paddies with civilians between the USMC/PF patrol and the VC. The presence of civilians and the distance from the USMC/PF patrol to the VC, precluded taking the VC under fire or physical pursuit.

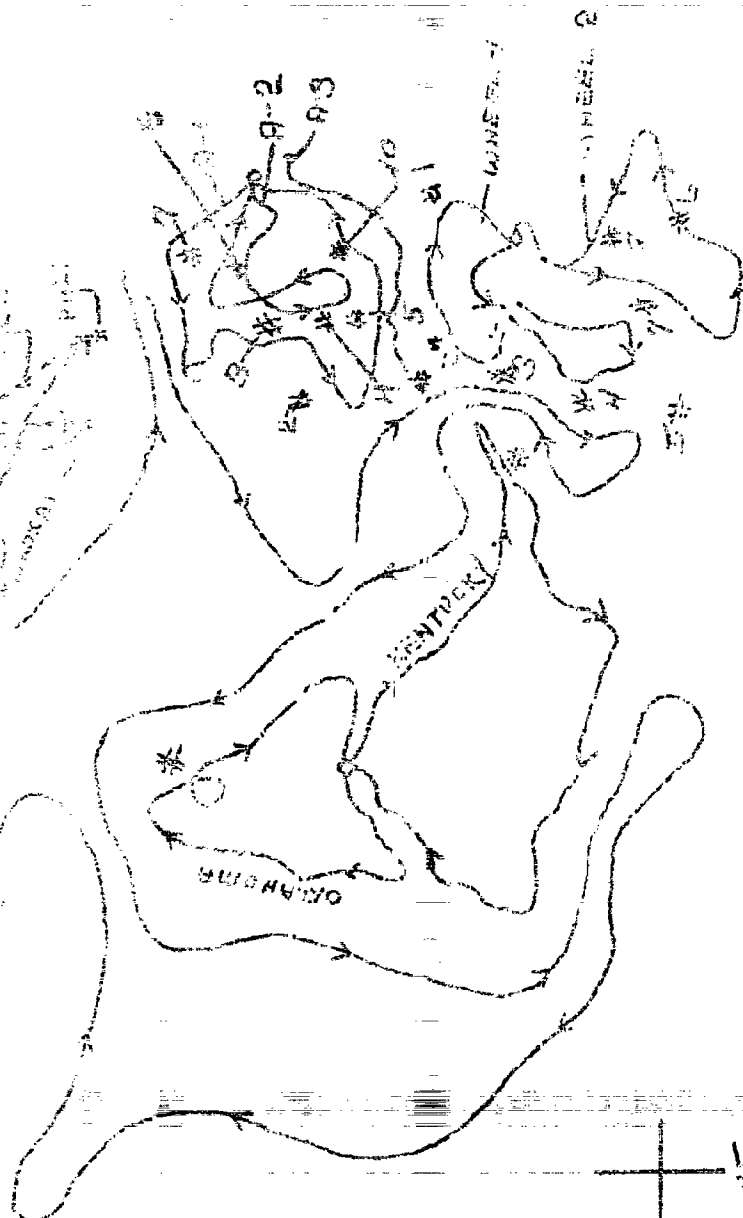

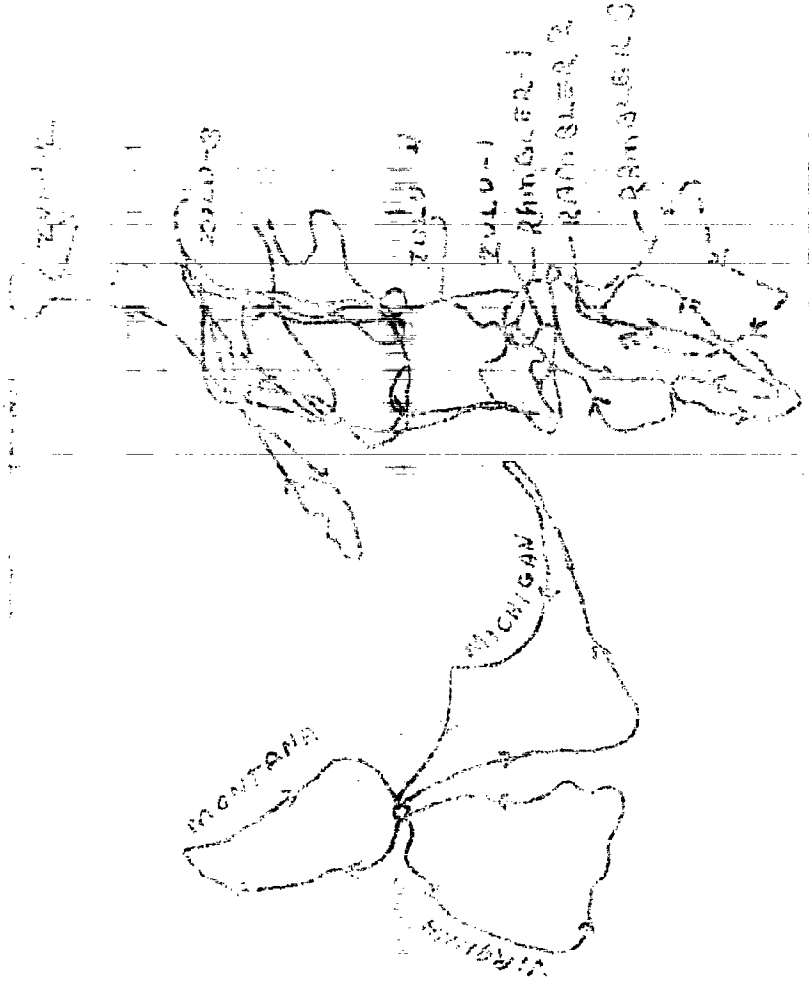


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W/STAIRS FOR
