(2) Consolidated Operations Summary

1. ATTACHMENTS.

A. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st AmTrac Bn. One LVTR1 and ten LVTP5's are in direct support of 1/4. Two LVTP5's are in direct support of 1/4 at the An Tan Bridge. Thirteen LVTP5's, one LVTR1 and one LVT command tractor are in direct support of Task Force Delta. Two LVT's are deadlined to Company maintenance.

B. Co B (-), 3d AT Bn. Company Headquarters continues maintenance and logistical support of the 1st and 2d platoons which are in direct support of 1/4. One defensive position in the Headquarters, 4th Marines perimeter was manned from 091830H to 100630H. The 1st platoon continues in direct support of 1/4, with the light section located in the Battalion CP (Rear). The heavy section is located in the Co "H", 3/7 area formerly occupied by Co "A", 1/4. The heavy section is located at Hill 69. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Deadlined equipment included two M35's, one M37, one M422 and one M50A1.

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C. Co A (-) (Main), 1st Tank Bn. Company Headquarters continues logistical support of the two tank platoons. The 2d platoon is in direct support of 1/4 at Hill 69. The 3d platoon is in direct support of 1/4. A light section moves from normal daytime positions at BT 527069 to positions at 528106. Xenon infrared surveillance was conducted at intervals during hours of darkness. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Headlined equipment included one M3A1 tank and one M54 tank.

D. Co A (-) (Main), 1st Tank Bn.

- (1) Continued construction work at Hill 69
- (2) Put a culvert in at Hill 69
- (3) Headlined equipment included one TD-15 tractor, one TD-15 tractor, two 35 GPM pumps, three M-274's and one water purification unit.

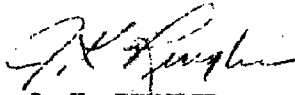

1. Unit Action With Contact.

- + a. At 092255H, waterborne patrol apprehended two curfew violators vicinity, (BT 480113). Violators were turned over to SDC Post #1 and later transferred to the Chu Lai Collection Point.
- + b. At 101310H, squad patrol from Company A received three rounds small arms fire from vicinity (BT 424042). Three armed VC were observed and taken under fire. VC ran towards vicinity (BT 423043), patrol deployed and gave chase, however, VC broke contact and fled the area.

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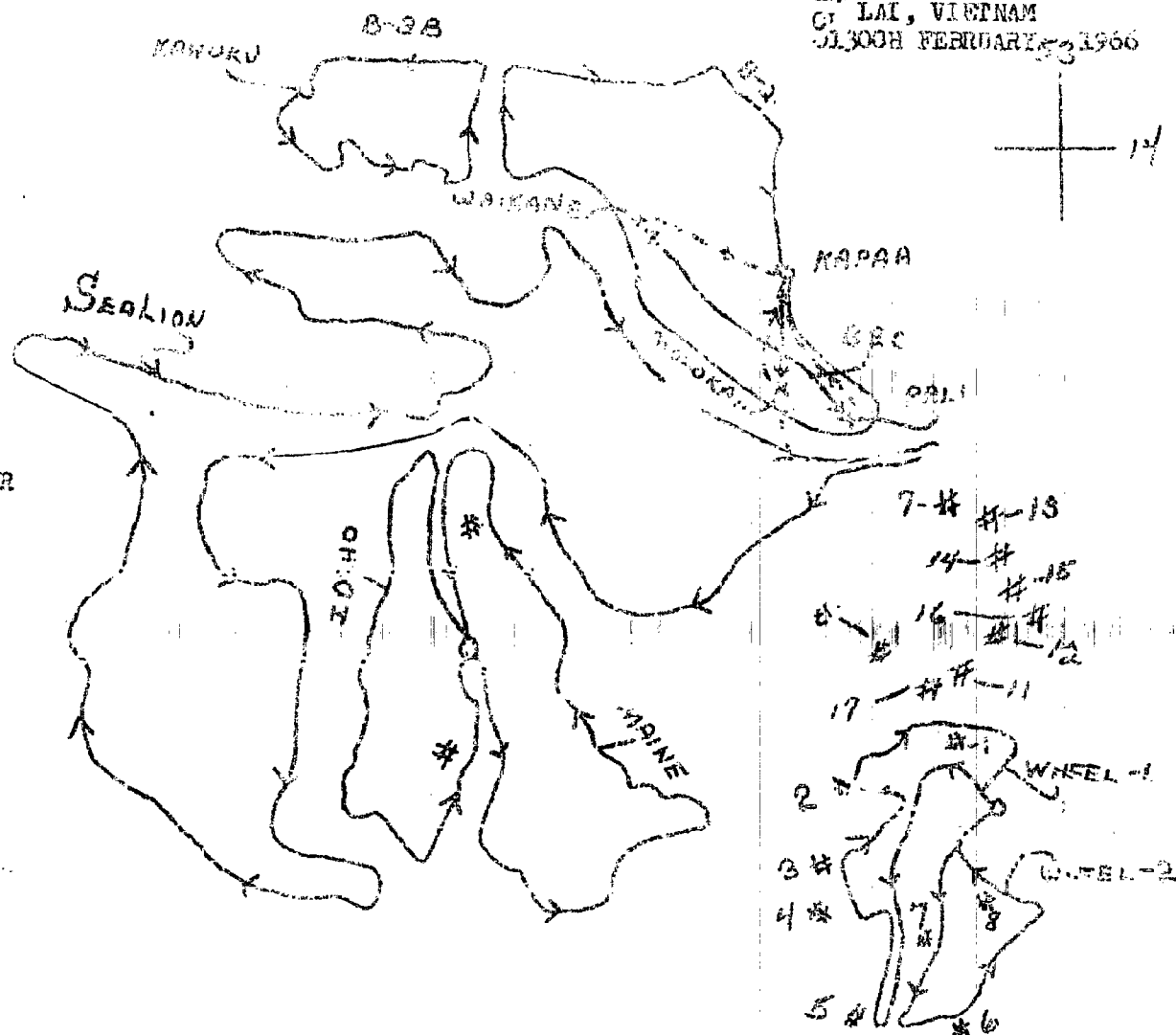

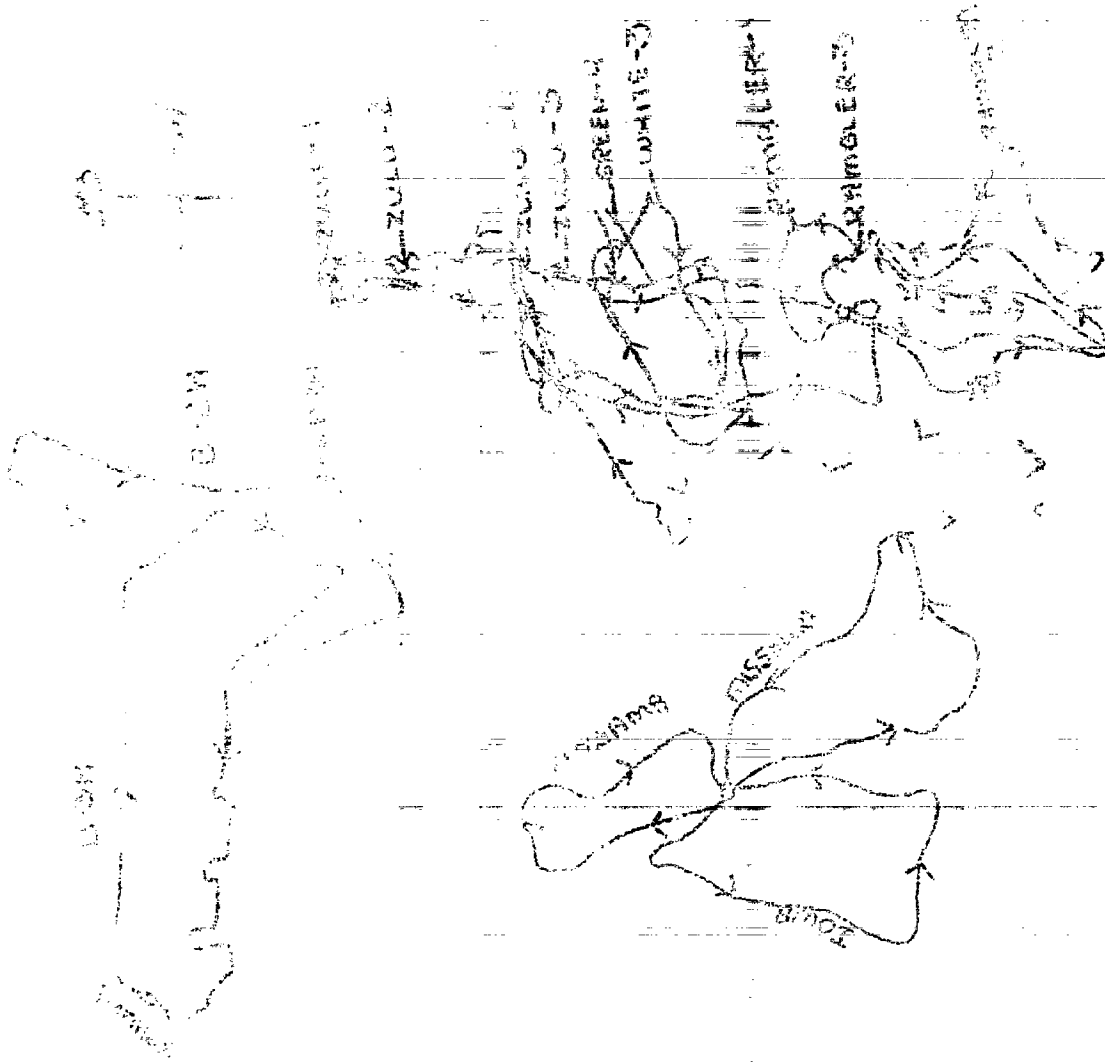
NIGHT PATROLS FOR

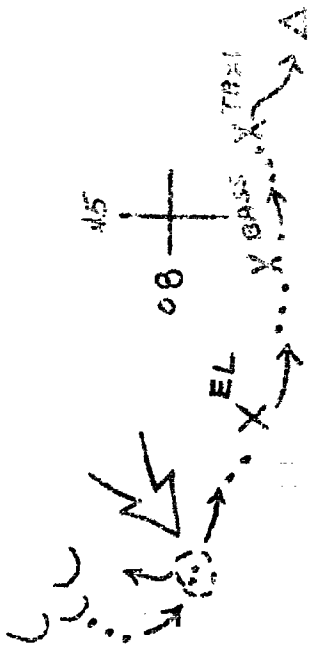

12 FEBRUARY 1966

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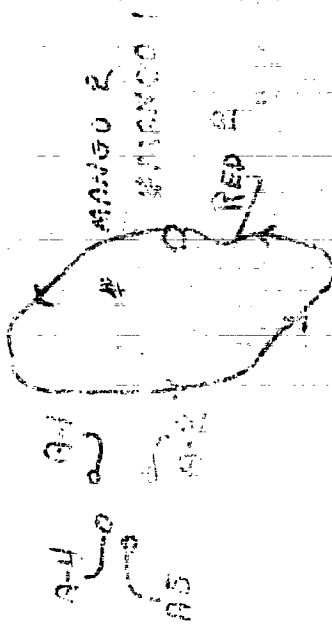


Night Patrols/Forward Position
