(2) Consolidated Operations Summary

1. ATTACHMENTS.

A. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st AmTrac Bn. One LVTM and ten LVTP5's are in direct support of 1/4. Two LVTP5's are in direct support of 1/4 at the An Tan Bridge. Nine LVTP5's, one LVTM and one LVT command tractor are in direct support of Task Force Delta. Two LVTP5's are deadlined to company maintenance.

B. Co B (-), 3d AT Bn. Company Headquarters continues maintenance and logistical support of the 1st and 2d platoons which are in direct support of 1/4. One defensive position in the Headquarters, 4th Marines perimeter was manned from 141830H to 150630H. The 1st platoon continues in direct support of 1/4, with the light section located in the Battalion CP (Rear). The 2d platoon continues in direct support of 1/4 at Hill 69. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Deadlined equipment included one M35, two M37's and two M422's.

C. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st Tank Bn. Company Headquarters continues logistical support of the two tank platoons. The 2d platoon is in direct support of 1/4 at Hill 69. The 3d platoon is in direct support of 1/4. A light section moves from normal platoon daytime positions at BT 527089 to nighttime positions at BT 529106. Xenon infrared surveillance was conducted at intervals during hours of darkness. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. At BT 497067, a 60 ton raft was utilized to rotate two M48A3 tanks for maintenance services. At 171015H the raft developed engine difficulties making further rotation of vehicles impossible. Deadlined equipment included one M38A1 tank and one M54 tank.

D. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st Eng Bn.

(1) Screening Officers and Staff NCO Mess at 1st Marines Command Post.

(2) Deadlined equipment included one TD-18 tractor, one TD-15 tractor, two 55 GPM pumps, four M-274's, one M51 dump truck, one M-37 truck, one water purification unit and one M422.

1. Unit Action With Contact.

- a. From 162345H to 170310H, waterborne patrol apprehended twelve curfew violators with Identification Cards. All violators were apprehended vicinity, (BT 513527) and taken to SDC Post #1, and turned over to the Village Chief for disposition.
- b. At 170718H, a platoon from Company D engaged 10 VC vicinity (BT 477076). VC escaped broke contact and fled into hills. One Marine KIA from unknown explosion vicinity (BT 434086) was evacuated. One (1) Springfield Rifle captured vicinity, (BT 447076), and one cave 20 feet long vicinity (BT 447077) destroyed.
