(2) Consolidated Operations Summary

1. ATTACHMENTS.

A. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st AmTrac Bn. One LVTP1 and ten LVTP5's are in direct support of 1/4. Two LVTP5's are in direct support of 1/4 at the An Tan Bridge. Two LVT's are deadlined to company maintenance.

B. Co B (-), 3d AF Bn. Company Headquarters continues maintenance and logistical support of the 1st and 2d platoons which are in direct support of 1/4. One defensive position in the Headquarters, 4th Marines perimeter was manned from 181630H to 190630H. The 1st platoon departed at approximately 1500 for Hill 54 to assist in a search and destroy operation. The 2d platoon dispatched a light section at 180630H as escort for an engineer road repair team. The heavy section remained at Hill 69 complex. Deadlined equipment included one M37 and two M35's.

C. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st Tank Bn. Company Headquarters continues logistical support of the tank platoons. The 2d platoon is in direct support of 1/4 at Hill 69. The 3d platoon is in direct support of 1/4 at Hill 69. Xenon infrared surveillance was conducted during hours of darkness. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Deadlined equipment included one M38A1.

D. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st Engr Bn.

(1) Continued construction work at 1st Marines CP.

(2) Deadlined equipment included one TD-16 tractor, one TD-15 tractor, two 55 GPM pump, one water purification unit, one M-274, one M422 and two M-37 trucks.

1. Unit Action With Contact

- a. At 190720H, the Battalion OP group vicinity (BT 396145) called in observed fire mission on detected enemy movement vicinity (BT 384130) eight rounds were fired landing on target. No VC casualties observed.
- b. At 190830H, a patrol from Company M vicinity (BT 415110) received S/A fire from vicinity (BT 408098). Fire was returned but due to existing mission of Company M physical pursuit was impossible. No VC casualties observed, no friendly casualties.
- c. At 190913H, Company M on a Search and Destroy mission vicinity (BT 411103) received one round S/A fire from vicinity (BT 421100). No VC observed. No friendly casualties.
- d. At 190915H a patrol from Company D on a Search and Destroy mission vicinity, (BT 390124) observed four VC vicinity (BT 383124). Four Cal. 50 rounds and four 106mm RR rounds were fired at the VC. The VC were observed fleeing North and South. The area was swept by the patrol. No VC casualties observed, no friendly casualties.
- e. At 190915H, Company M on a Search and Destroy mission vicinity (BT 415110) received S/A fire from vicinity (BT 414105). Marines returned fire and searched area. No VC observed. No friendly casualties.
- f. At 190930H, Company M vicinity (BT 423102) received ten rounds 60mm Mortar from unknown locations. No friendly casualties.
