1. ATTACHMENTS

A. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st Amph Bn. One LVT(M) and ten LVTP5's are in direct support of 1/4. Two LVTP5's are in direct support of 1/4 at the An Tan Bridge. One LVT command tractor and five LVTP5's are deadlined to company maintenance.

B. Co B (-), 3d AT Bn. Company Headquarters continues maintenance and logistical support of the 1st and 2d platoons which are in direct support of 1/4. One defensive position in the Headquarters, 4th Marines perimeter was manned from 211830H to 220630H. The 1st platoon's light section is located in the Battalion CP (Rear), and the heavy section is located in the Co I, 3/7 area. The 2d platoon is located at Hill 69. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Deadlined equipment included one M60A1, one M65 and one M43.

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C. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st Tank Bn. Company Headquarters continues logistical support of the Tank platoons. The 2d platoon is in direct support of 1/4 at Hill 69. The 3d Platoon is in direct support of 1/4 at Hill 69. Xenon infrared surveillance was conducted during hours of darkness. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Deadlined equipment included one M48A3 and M38A1.

D. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st Eng Bn

- (1) Continued construction work at 1st Marines CP.
- (2) Deadlined equipment included one TD-15 tractor, one TD-16 tractor, one M-51 dump truck, one water purification unit, two 55 GPM pumps, three M-274's and two M-37 trucks.

1. Unit Action With Contact.

~~a. At 212250H, a platoon sized patrol from Company B vicinity, (BT 503125) received three incoming S/A rounds fired from (BT 502121). Patrol returned fire with eight rounds S/A at point of origin of incoming fire. Area was searched and a wounded VN boy age 12 was discovered with the village corpsmen, PF's and Villagers. Boy had a minor wound in his hand. The boy was wounded from an accidental discharge by an SDC weapon. The rounds from this accidental discharge had been taken by the patrol to be incoming hostile fire.~~

~~b. At 212330H, a perimeter station at Company B observed an individual with an undetermined weapon vicinity, (BT 507130), which was 20 meters in front of their position. Marines threw illumination grenades and fired one round S/A. Patrol sent to search the area with negative results.~~

~~c. At 220830H, a platoon from Company D vicinity, (BT 432105) received five to seven rounds S/A fire from (BT 430103). Marines returned fire with four rounds 60mm Mortar fire. Patrol searched area with negative results. No friendly casualties.~~

~~d. At 220925H, a platoon sized patrol from Company A vicinity (BT 446057) received seventy rounds S/A automatic weapons fire from (BT 446052). Patrol also reported explosive type firing into their position. Marines returned 220 rounds S/A fire. VC broke contact and fled area. Patrol sent to search the area with negative results. No friendly casualties.~~

~~e. At 221000H, a platoon from Company D vicinity (Bt 432105) received four rounds S/A fire from three VC vicinity, (BT 433099). Marines and PF's returned fire with one round 60mm Mortar fire and six rounds S/A fire. Area searched with negative results. No friendly casualties.~~





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
