1. ATTACHMENTS.

A. Co A (-) (Rein), 1st AmTrac Bn. Ten LVTP5's are in direct support of 1/4. Two LVTP5's are in direct support of 1/4 at the An Tan Bridge. One LVT command tractor and five LVTP5's are deadlined to company maintenance.

B. Co B (-). 3d AT Bn. Company Headquarters continues maintenance and logistical support of the 1st and 2d platoons which are in direct support of 1/4. One defensive position in the Headquarters, 4th Marines perimeter was manned from 241830H to 250630H. The 1st platoon's light section is located in the Battalion CP (Rear) and the heavy section is located in the Co I, 3rd area. The 2d platoon is located at Hill 69. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Deadlined equipment included one M50A1, one M35, one M343 and one M422.

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C. Co A (-) (Rein). 1st Tank Bn. Company Headquarters continues logistical support of the Tank platoons. The 2d platoon is in direct support of 1/4. The 3d platoon is in direct support of 1/4 at Hill 69. Xenon infrared surveillance was conducted at intervals during hours of darkness. No enemy contact during the last twenty four hours. Deadlined equipment included one M48A3, one M38A1 and one M54.

D. Co A (-) (Rein). 1st Engr Bn.

- (1) Constructing a CP Bunker for 1/11, 20% completed
- (2) Continued construction work at 1st Marines CP
- (3) Put a culvert in at Hill 69
- (4) Deadlined equipment included one TD-15 tractor, one TD-18 tractor, one M-51 dump truck, one M-37 truck, two 55 GPH pumps, one water purification unit and two M-274 mules.

1. Unit Action With Contact.

- a. At 210100H, Company CP 1 from Company D traveling north in a vehicle along Rt #1 vicinity (BT 441098), received S/A fire and one incoming hand grenade from vicinity (BT 441099). Fire was returned by Marines and VC broke contact. No friendly casualties and vehicle proceeded north to platoon security position at Ong Bo Bridge (BT 441099) with no further incidents.
- b. At 2338H, a platoon from Company D in security positions vicinity Ong Bo Bridge (BT 435105), received 2 incoming 81mm Mortar rounds north and west of their positions from an unknown location. No Marine casualties. One PF: WIA was Med Evaced.
- c. At 250300H, a squad sized patrol from Company B apprehended three male curfew violators ages 14, 16, 20, vicinity, (BT 485115). The youngest VC male was without ID card. Violators were held until morning and turned over to Village Chief for disposition.
- d. At 250735H, an RF from G btry 3/11 attached to 1st Battalion, 4th Marines, standing on a bunker vicinity (BT 466068) received one round S/A fire into his position. No friendly casualties. A Vietnamese male was walking along a trail vicinity, (BT 469064). He jumped behind a bush and fired the shot at the FO. No fire was returned because of civilians in the area. Area was searched with negative results.
- e. At 250815H, the Artillery F team attached to Company D vicinity (BT 429109) received 2 rounds S/A fire from an undetermined location west of their position. Fire was returned but area was searched with negative results. No friendly casualties.
- f. At 251122H, a platoon sized patrol from Company D vicinity (BT 433099) received 4 rounds S/A fire from Hill 22 vicinity (BT 425091) 8 rounds S/A fire returned. One VC possible WIA. Artillery mission was requested with 12 rounds 105mm fired foreffect. Patrol moved to search area and received A/W fire from vicinity (BT 433096). Marines returned 25 rounds S/A fire, continued with mission.
- g. At 01245H, a platoon sized patrol from Company A vicinity (BT 433047) received A/W fire from 8-10 VC vicinity, (BT 433048). Fire was returned by Marines. VC broke contact. No friendly casualties.

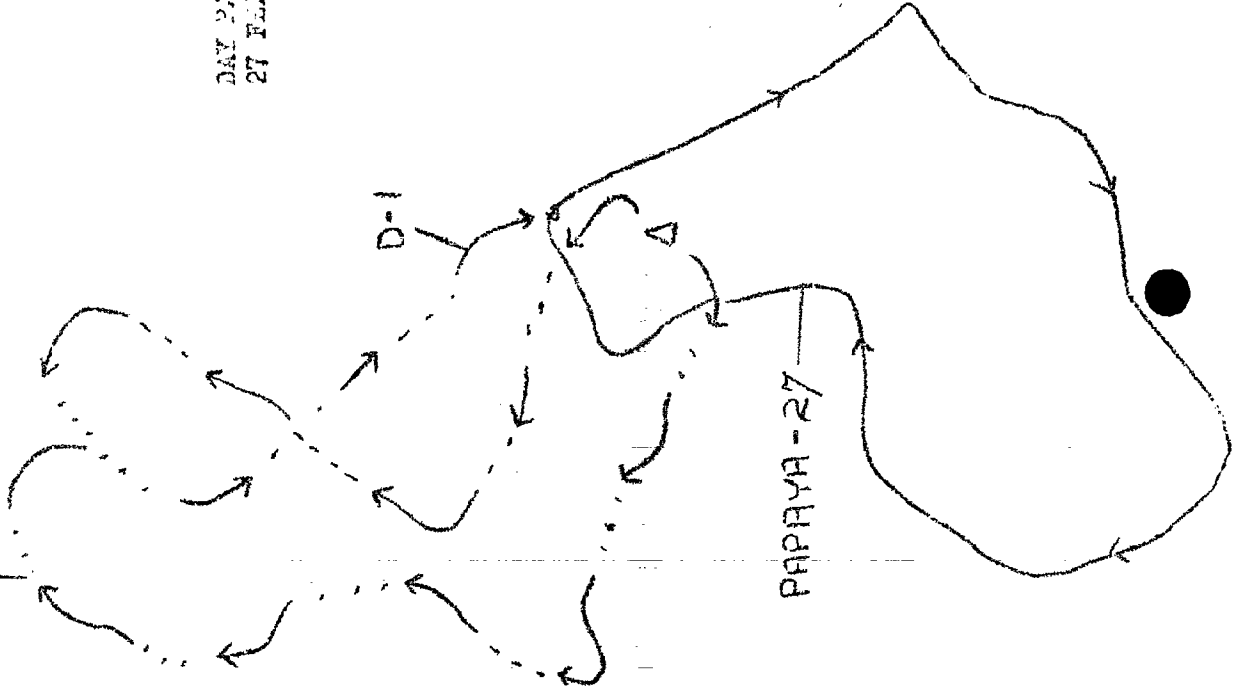
