Subj: Combat Boots; repair of

Ref: (a) FLSG Newsletter Number #11 dated 22 Feb 66

1. Purpose. To promulgate information and instruction for the repair of leather for the 1st Marines and all units attached.
2. Background. The Force Logistic Support Group in their published Newsletter, reference (a), provides commands with helpful information as to the many services they provide. In the Chu Lai enclave FLSU-1 provides shoe repair at Maintenance Company on a scheduled basis. FLSU has the capability of repairing leather combat boots with full soles and heels. The only repairs that may be made to the jungle boot is to mend the cloth and upper leather portion of the boot. Soles and heels can not be repaired on jungle boots. There is no charge for this service.
3. Action. The 1st Marines is scheduled for repairs on each Wednesday and the following must be done when boots are delivered:
 - a. Boots must be tagged. (tags may be drawn from FLSU Shoe Repair Shop)
 - b. 1 man must accompany each 15 pair of boots.
 - c. Boots are to be clean and dry with laces unlaced to the last two eyelets and tied with 24" between shoes.
 - d. Liaison must be established 24 hours prior to day of delivery with estimated number of boots to be repaired.
4. Self-cancellation: 1 June 1966
