Subj: Care and Cleaning of Camp Heads; instructions concerning

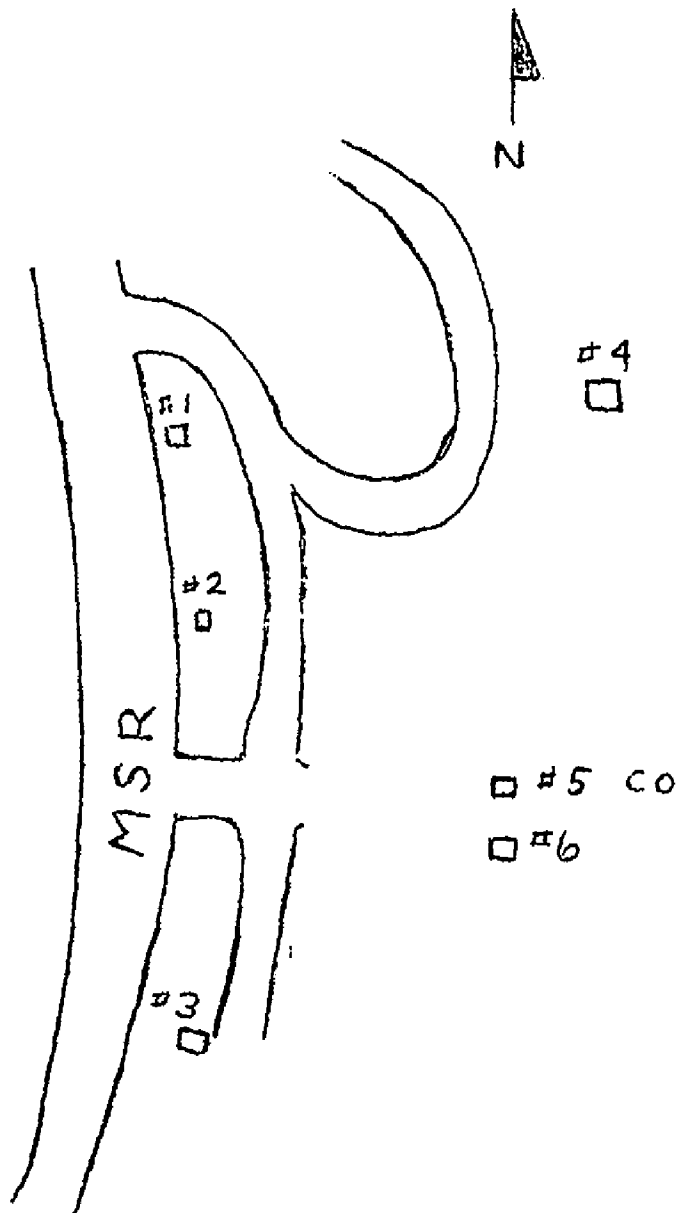
1. Purpose. To publish instructions regarding the daily work required by the various sections/attachments on the heads in their areas.
2. Background. Because the heads in the 1st Marine Base Camp are of an outdoor construction type it is essential that a concerted effort be made each day in the proper cleaning and maintenance of them. The results of this effort will be realized in a sanitary condition existing in both the heads and the camp.
3. Requirements. In order to keep the heads in the proper sanitary condition they must first be painted. This will facilitate easy cleaning. Second, there will be a daily requirement for them to be cleaned and the contents of the half barrels contained therein to be burned.
4. Responsibility. Enclosure (1) indicates the location of the various heads within the 1st Marines CP. In addition it also designates those sections/attachments which will have the responsibility of caring for them as set forth in paragraph 3 above.
5. Action. Sections/attachments will, upon receipt of this directive, designate working parties to comply with the instructions set forth.
