1. Unit Action with Contact.

- a. At 2135H a platoon from Company C reported movement at the wire to the left flank of their position, at the Class V dump. The area was illuminated and one figure was sighted. The person was challenged and began to run away. Approximately 60 rounds were fired at the person. He fell down. Again the area was illuminated and the platoon received one incoming grenade. At this point the person jumped up and ran into the brush on the other side of the wire.

1. Narrative

a. At 280030H Co F, squad ambush at coord (BT433094) opened fire on an estimated VC squad that was moving SW. Fired approx 40 rds S/A and 4 M-79's, artillery fire mission also called. Three VC were seen to fall. A search of area at first light was made. One carbine magazine full of ammo and 100 rds 7.62 link found in area.

b. At 280045H Co F CP at (BT434105) received 6 rds sniper fire from (BT432099). Six rds 60mm fired. Results unknown. One friendly WIA sustained.

c. At 280715H F-3 patrol sustained 3 WIAs at coord (BT424094) from a grenade thrown by a VC at that location. VC was killed.

d. At 280900H Co F(-) at (BT414098) received an estimated 200-250 rds automatic wps fire from (BT411098). Returned fire with an estimated 200-300 rds rifle, MG, and 4 60mm rds. One friendly WIA resulted from a friendly 60mm short rd. VC broke contact and escaped to West.

e. At 281015H Co F(-) at (BT411107) received sniper fire from an estimated 6 VC at coord (BT408105). Returned fire w/organic wps and arty fire. Results unknown. One friendly WIA sustained.

f. At 281235H H-2 patrol at coord (BT442048) received 5 rds sniper fire from (BT440055). Returned fire with 12 rds 7.62 and 2 M-79's. Results unknown.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. Contacts

1. At 280200H, vicinity coordinates BT 474134 the waterborne security patrol, "Sea Lion" sighted three VCS walking in water. VCS were ordered to halt. Challenge was disregarded, warning shot was fired and VCS continued to disregard warning, three additional warning shots were fired. One VCS was hit by recochet other two escaped. Corpsman treated wounded VCS and turned him over to B-Med. VCS had no identification papers. No friendly casualties. One wounded VCS.

2. At 280215, vicinity coordinates BT 530085 three VC fired ten rounds at Company I positions when challenged. Fire was returned with small arms and automatic weapons. VC withdrew under fire to the north and west while continuing to fire on friendly positions with small arms and possibly one automatic weapon. Six hand grenades were thrown into friendly positions. Forty-one 81mm Mortar illumination rounds were fired in support. No friendly casualties. No enemy casualties confirmed.

3. At 280925H, vicinity coordinates BT 412150, Company I received six rounds of small arms fire. Fire was returned with small arms. Enemy fire ceased. No friendly casualties. No enemy casualties confirmed.

4. At 281005H, vicinity coordinates BT 414159, Company K received five rounds of small arms fire. Fire was returned with small arms and area was searched. No friendly casualties. No enemy casualties confirmed.

5. At 281230H, vicinity coordinates BT 422161, Company K located a cow shed with false floor. Inside were four VCS. They were ordered out but refused to comply. One hand grenade was thrown into cave under flooring. Cave was searched. Three males and one female, believed to be a VC nurse, were found. Three VC were WIA. One VC KIA. WIAs were evacuated to B-Med. No friendly casualties. Captured equipment included one VC medical record book, one greenish khaki uniform, and a medicine cache. Equipment and documents evacuated with enemy casualties.

6. At 281300H, vicinity coordinates BT 426158, Company K apprehended four VCS found in well hidden tunnel complex. Tunnel was blown by engineers upon completion of search. VCS underwent initial tactical interrogation and will be evacuated as transportation becomes available.

7. At 281315H, vicinity coordinates BT 422158, Company K received four rounds of small arms fire from vicinity coordinates BT 422157.

with negative results. No friendly casualties. No enemy casualties confirmed.

B. Miscellaneous

1. At 230915H, Company K commenced search and destroy operations on the island of Hoa Kuan. Throughout the day, aggressive and thorough search and destroy operations were carried out. Enemy contacts and results are as cited in paragraph A. above. At 231630H, Company K established Command Post for the night at vicinity coordinates BT 435160. Front lines were established from BT 434160 to 436160 to 435161 to 435159. Company K intends to conduct extensive and comprehensive patrol actions within their assigned TAOR.

2. At 231700H, Company K had two personnel step in a punji stake pit at vicinity coordinates BT 434161. One man evacuated. One man not evacuated.

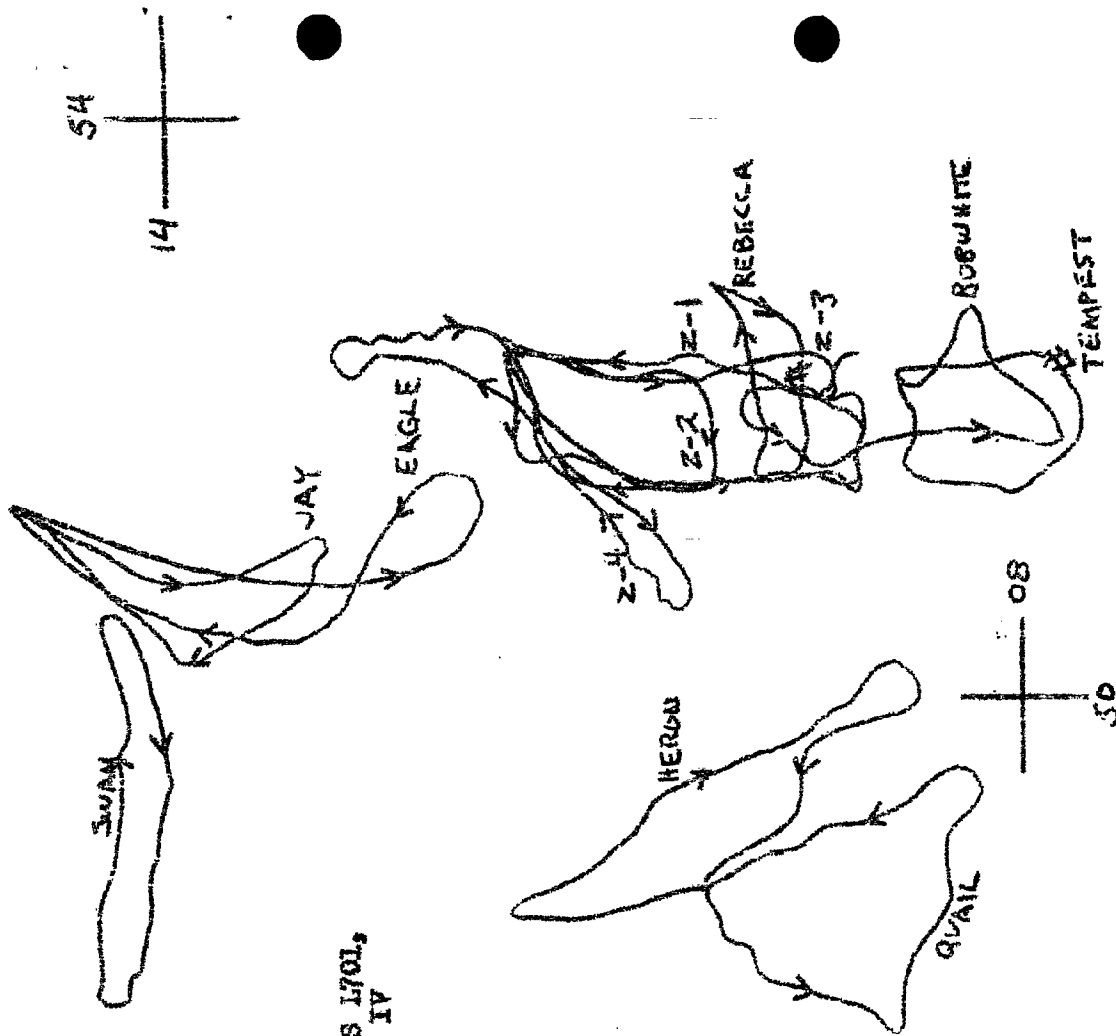

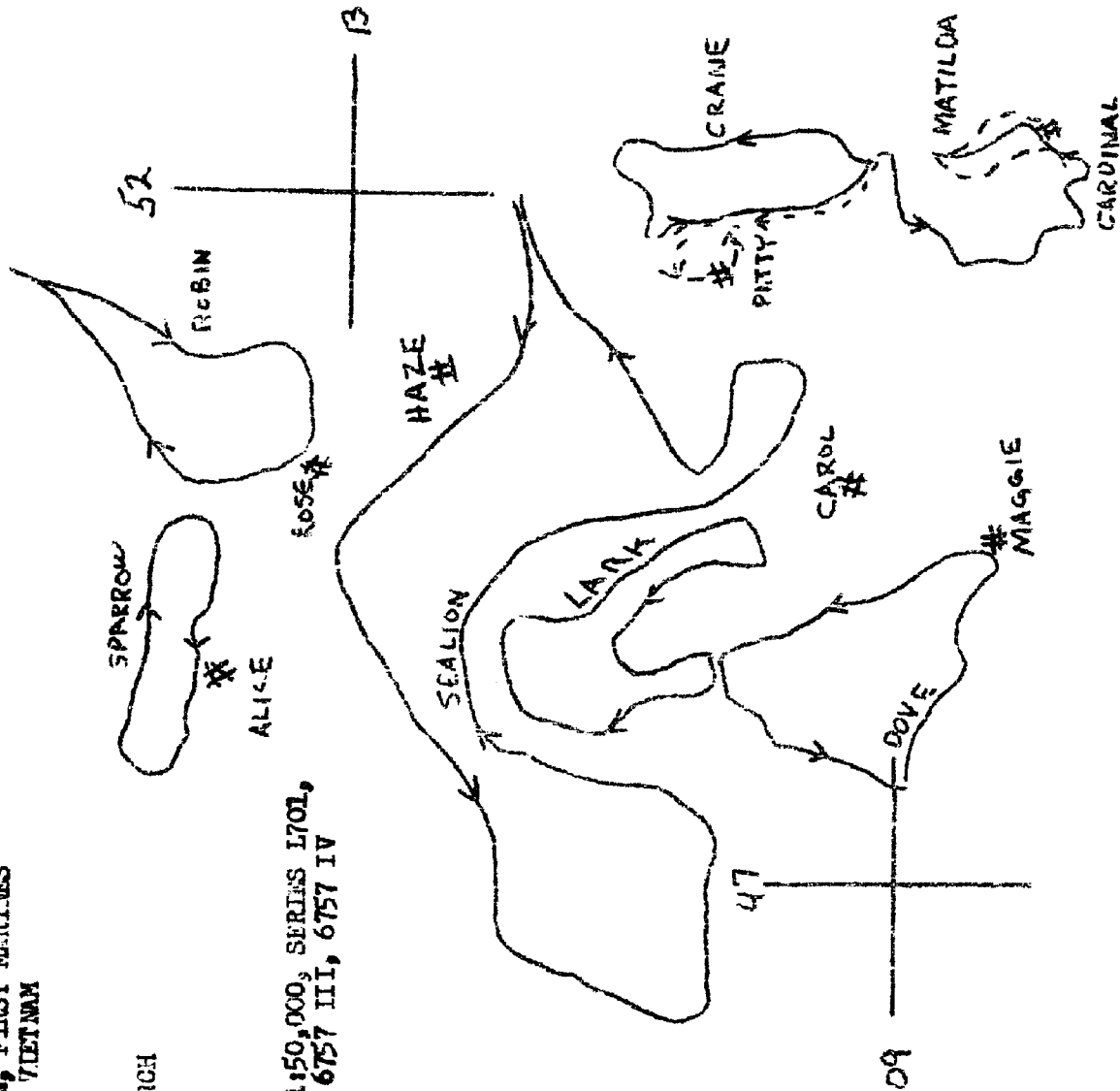
