2. The primary mission of the 3d Battalion, 1st Marines and 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines remain the same. A change in the disposition of forces in the 1st Marines TAOR occurred in the last twenty four hours when Company E, 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines moved to Hill 69 at 031500H after completing a company size Search and Destroy operation.

BRIEF FOR PERIOD 022400H TO 032200H

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. Contacts

1. At 022305H, vicinity coordinates BT 487138, an ambush from Company L heard movement and the sound of a bolt closing in tree line to its immediate right flank. One Marine and one Popular Force troop opened fire with small arms. The area was immediately searched with negative results. No friendly casualties. No enemy casualties.

2. At 030020H, vicinity coordinates BT 477143, the 1st Platoon, Company L located on Hill 12 received six to eight rounds of small arms fire over their position. It could not be determined which direction the fire came from. No fire was returned. No friendly casualties. No enemy casualties.

3. At 030400H, vicinity coordinates BT 439157, Company K uncovered a booby trap consisting of three 60mm mortar rounds in series with a nail attached for point detonations. The booby trap had been implaced in the track impression left by a LVT. The booby trap was blown in place. No friendly casualties. No enemy casualties.

4. At 030910H, vicinity coordinates BT 425156, Company K observed nine VC with weapons. Company K opened fire with small arms and automatic weapons. 81mm mortar fire was brought to bear obtaining good target coverage. The VC began moving northwest and northeast in groups of two. 1st and 2nd Platoons, Company K aggressively pursued throughout the morning conducting a detailed search as they progressed. In the area where the mortar rounds impacted, blood trails were found. Pursuit continued. Two VC KIA were found at BT 423158, one VC KIA at BT 421158, and one VC KIA at BT 426159. Two additional blood trails were found and followed with negative results. 1st Platoon, Company K apprehended three VCS at vicinity coordinates BT 430169. 3rd Platoon, Company K apprehended two VCS at vicinity coordinates at BT 418159. The VCS are established as such due to presence in general area of operations with no apparent reason for presence. The VCS will be forwarded on first available transportation. Final results included four VC KIA confirmed, two VC MIA.

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possible as indicated by the blood trails which were separate and distinct from others leading to the KIAs, five VCS apprehended, one CAMCOM sub-machinegun magazine with twenty-two rounds of ammunition, one home-made hand grenade and one anti-personnel mine captured. One friendly WIA was sustained as set forth in sub-paragraph 5 below.

5. At 031030h, vicinity coordinates BT 425160, one Marine from Company K, while in pursuit of VC reported in sub-paragraph 4 above, detonated one anti-personnel mine. An emergency medical evacuation was requested and completed immediately. One friendly WIA. No enemy casualties.

B. Miscellaneous

1. At 022245h, vicinity coordinates BT 490143, a squad security patrol from Company L was halted upon hearing small arms fire at extreme distance. While halted, the patrol observed one man running down the trail from the direction of the firing. The individual, upon closing with the patrol, stopped and fired one round at the patrol and attempted to flee to the north. The patrol immediately returned fire with six M-14 rounds, killing the individual. Upon search of the body, a Vietnamese Government identification card, one 1st battalion, 4th Marines identification card, identifying the man as a member of the Popular Forces and granting permission to carry a weapon, were found. The man was dressed in black pajamas and sandals. He was carrying one carbine. The District Chief was contacted and all details concerning the incident were clarified and solved. One Popular Force KIA. No enemy casualties.

2. Company K continued search and destroy operations on the island of Hoa Xuan (BT 4315) with enemy contacts as set forth in paragraph A. above. Company K positions remain the same for the night with their Command Post located at vicinity BT 438161 and front lines from vicinity coordinates BT 437162 to BT 435162 to BT 436160 to BT 438160. Company K will conduct aggressive and thorough patrol and ambush operations throughout the night to include four squad patrols, three fire team ambushes, one observation post, and two listening posts. Company K's intentions are to continue aggressive search and destroy operations at first light.

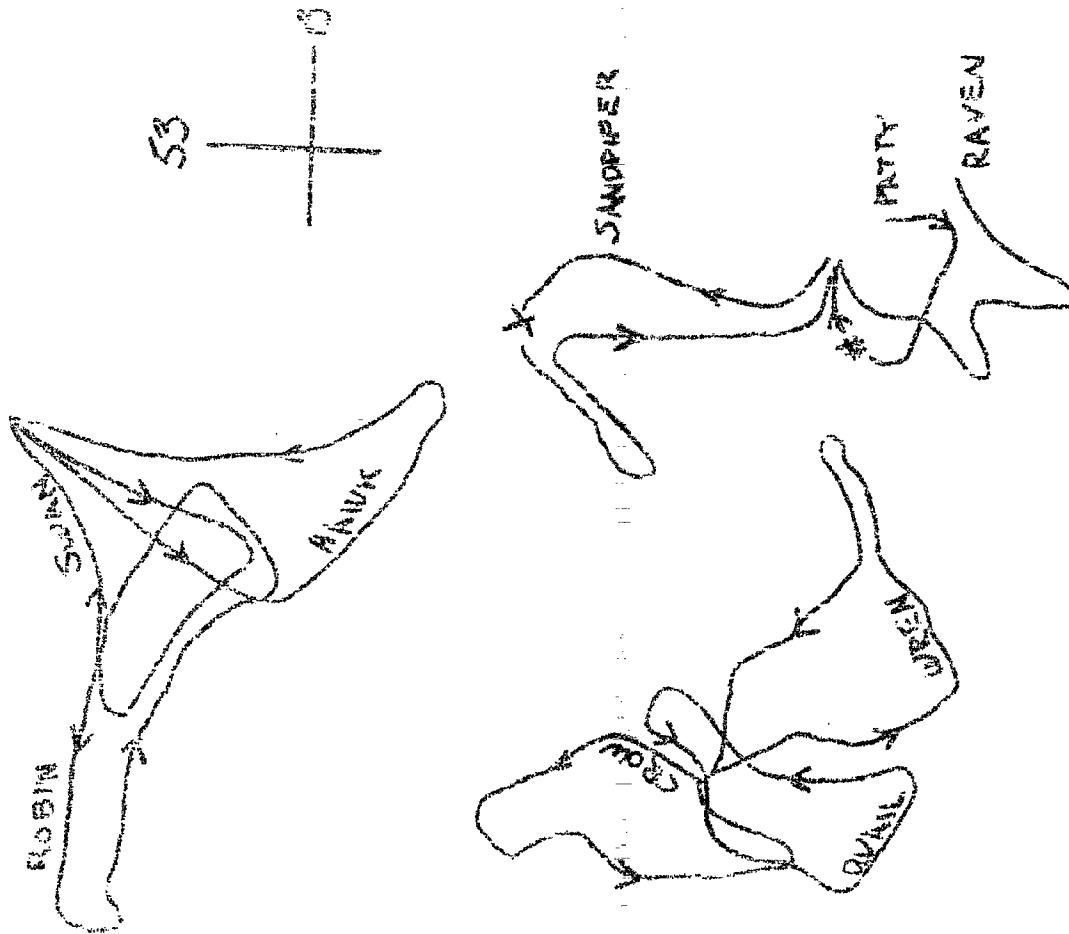

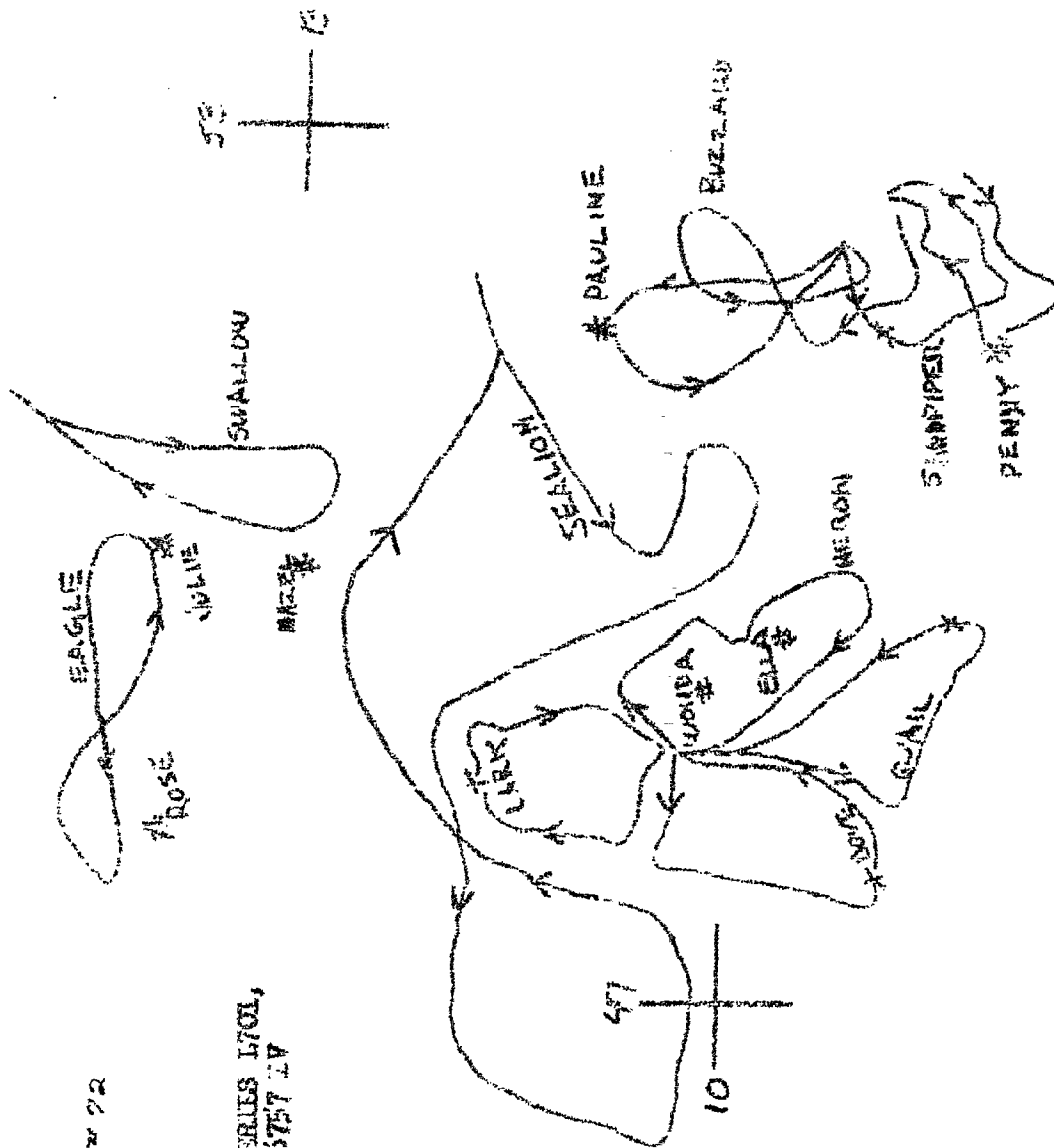
