PATROLS ON HOA XUAN FOR 16 MAY

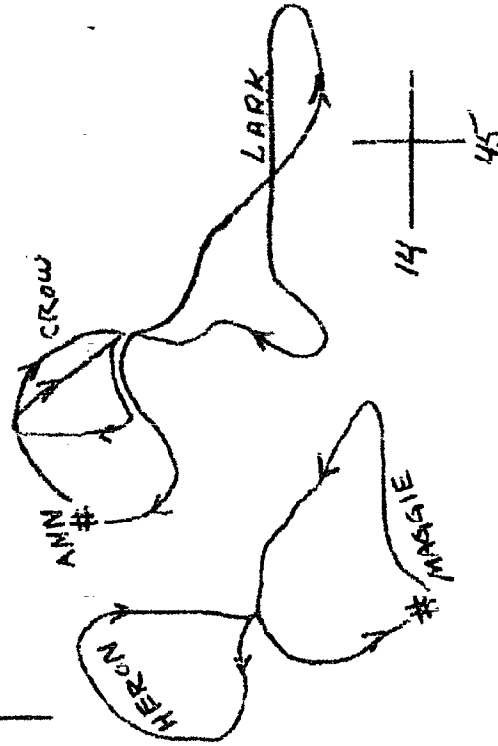
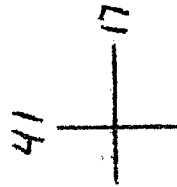

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2ND BATTALION, 5TH MARINES SITREP #31 AS OF 150001H MAY TO 152400H MAY 1966

1. Narrative

a. At 150800H a patrol from Company H on S&D at BT 440045 received 30 rounds S/A from BT 443045. Patrol returned fire with 20 rounds S/A and 16 rounds Arty. Patrol swept area. A USMC tripped an unknown firing device resulting in 1 USMC WIA. WIA halo evac to 1st Med Bn. Patrols searched areas found small amount of S/A in a house. House destroyed with 4 pounds of C-4. One VCS captured in area, evac to IIT.

b. At 150945H a patrol from Company H on S&D at BT 434089 received 3 rounds S/A from BT 426089. Patrol returned fire with 20 rounds S/A. VC broke contact. Patrol continued on mission at BT 434089. Patrol received additional 8 rounds of S/A from BT 426089. Patrol returned fire with 30 rounds S/A and 8 rounds Arty. Patrol searched area and found no evidence of VC. Area was over grown with vegetation.

c. At 151045H a patrol from Company G on S&D at BT 435087, a USMC tripped an unknown firing device. Resulting in one USMC WIA. WIA halo evac to 1st Med Bn.

d. At 151150H a patrol from Company G on S&D at BT 432088 received 35 rounds S/A from BT 424088. Patrol pursued VC, returned 250 rounds S/A. 4 VC were observed fleeing area. Patrol searched area but found no evidence of VC.

e. At 151935H a patrol from Company G on S&D at BT 432072 received 2 rounds S/A from a north easterly direction. The patrols did not return fire, because they could not determine where it was coming from. Continued on with there mission.

f. At 152000H a patrol from Company H at BT 430053 received 2 rounds S/A from BT 430054. Patrol returned fire with 120 rounds S/A and 1 hand grenade VC withdrew in an unknown direction. Patrol continued mission.

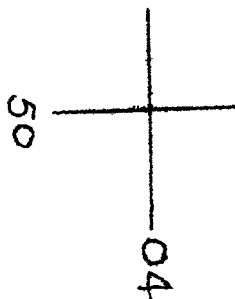
MAP: VIET NAM 1:50,000
