1ST BATTALION, 5TH MARINES IN TREP #16 AS OF 300000H MAY 30 302400H MAY 1966

## 1. Narrative

a. At 300700H, 3d Plt Company A at BT 384092 observed five VC, two of them carrying weapons. The two VC carrying weapons disappeared. The three without weapons were apprehended, screened and sent to ITT.

b. At 300820H Company C at BT 419103 stopped and questioned 16 suspects all were released except for one who attempted to run while being interrogated. VC was screened and sent to ITT.

c. At 300840H Sqd patrol Iron from Company C at BT 384148 received ten rounds sniper fire from BT 382148. Patrol returned 30 rounds S/A fire and requested 60mm mortar mission which fixed 12 rounds. Patrol Iron sustained one USMC WIA and requested emergency halo evac. A extraction sqd was dispatched and to assist in a thorough search of the area. One VU was apprehended, screened and sent to ITT.

d. At 300910H Company B at BT 392121, apprehended one female VC who was identified by the hamlet chief of Iaen Coco Hamlet as being a member of the guerrilla forces. She was screened and sent to ITT.

e. At 300930H Objective one, two, three, and five having been secured, Company B moved towards objective four. At BT 393117 Company B received 15 rounds S/A fire from BT 393115. Company B returned 40 rounds S/A fire, approximately 30 rounds machine gun fire and four rounds R-79. VU broke contact. A thorough search of the areas was made which disclosed one tunnel five feet wide by six feet deep by six feet. The tunnel was destroyed with demolitions. Nothing was found.

f. At 301020H Company B at BT 392112 located a tunnel ten feet long by three feet wide by two feet high. The tunnel was destroyed with demolitions.

g. At 301228H patrol Chrysler from Company B at BT 38152, located a tunnel three feet by three feet by 30 feet. The tunnel was destroyed with demolitions.

h. At 301114H Company B at BT 399114 located a tunnel 20 feet long by 11 feet wide by five feet. The tunnel was destroyed by demolitions.

i. At 301230H all units received word to return to 1/5 Bn CP Operation Edison secured.

j. At 301240H Company B at BT 399111 located a tunnel six feet by four feet by 15 feet. The tunnel was destroyed with demolitions.

k. At 301315H Company B at BT 375111 apprehended two VC who were identified as guerrillas by the hamlet chief of Xuan Ngoc Hamlet. The VC were screened and sent to ITC.

l. At 301430H Company B at BT 407134 received two rounds sniper fire from BT 405134. 15 rounds of 3/A fire was returned. Area was checked and nothing found.

m. At 301640H Company B 3d Amtrac Bn (Rein) with one Bngr Sqd from 1st Bngr Bn operating with one sqd from Company D for security at BT413158 while clearing a supply route from 1/3 Bn GP to Company B's employment a smoke demolition charge when the rocket prematurely detonated. Company B 3d Amtrac Bn sustained one USMC KIA and one WIA. The Bngr sustained three USMC WIA's. The KIA and WIA's were emergency evacuated to B Med, Chu Lai.

n. At 301610H Company D received information from PF's of the location of a tunnel. A sqd was dispatched to the tunnel at BT 418148. The tunnel was three feet by three feet by 90 feet. The tunnel was destroyed by demolitions.

## 2ND BATTALION, 5TH MARINES SITREP #46 AS OF 300001H MAY TO 302400H MAY 1966

## 1. Narrative

a. (Late Entry) At 292145H Company G at (BT 439111) received 10 rounds S/A from BT 441103. 81's fired 10 rounds and a patrol from Company G at first light searched area without reestablishing contact.

b. At 301400 the 2nd Plt of Company G on a search and destroy patrol on Hill 270 (BT 423046). Discovered a cave approximately 10 feet by 10 feet in size at BT 423047. Upon searching the cave, the patrol found 14 rounds M-79, 250 rounds linked M-60, 2 hand grenades, 1 bowl rice, 1 mosquito net, 5 sets chop sticks, 1 demolition kit complete with 15 lbs C-4, several blasting caps, 1 rocket casing and filler for huey type rocket, several documents and 1 notebook. The patrol left the cave and continued on their route after searching the area and finding nothing further. Approximately 15 minutes later, the commander of a tank from 4th Plt Company A, 1st Tank Bn, operating in giving the Company G patrol direct fire support from onto<sup>1400</sup> at BT 438058. Observed activity at the cave site through a mounted BC scope. He saw 2 VC dressed in khaki uniforms and grass covered helmets emerge from the underbrush. The tank fired 1 round of HE and 1 round of WP, and direct hit on VC was observed. Result 2 VC KIA confirmed. The cave was then destroyed by 90mm direct fire. All captured material will be delivered to First Marines.



1. SITUATION

a. ENEMY FORCES

(1) See Current INTSUMS.

(2) An undetermined number of Viet Cong have been known to be operating in the vicinity of Hill 22 (BT432091). This has been reported that the VC have constructed numerous trench and tunnel networks in this area.

(3) Recently the VC have been reported to have been firing from Hill 22 and from the Hamlets of Khuong Nhon (1) and Khuong Nhon (2) into friendly areas. Khuong Nhon (1) and Khuong Nhon (2) have also been used as a refuge by an undetermined number of VC.

b. FRIENDLY FORCES

(1) Regional Force Company 744 will conduct operations in the vicinity of Khuong Nhon (1) and Khuong Nhon (2).

(2) 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines will provide artillery and HOWTAR support on call.

(3) "Sparrow Hawk" available on call from 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines.

(4) Elements of Co A, 1st Tank Bn provide direct support to operation.

(5) AT platoon, Co A, 1st AT Bn provide direct support to operation.

2. MISSION. 2nd Bn, 5th Marines commence operation to burn concealment underbrush, and to destroy entrenchments and mines on Hill 22. Additionally, to provide Regional Force units blocking support in their sweeping mission through suspect hamlets of Khuong Nhon (1) and (2).

3. EXECUTION.

a. CONCEPT OF OPERATION: With fire support from Tanks, Ontos, Artillery and Mortars, a blocking line will be manned to the West of Khuong Nhon (1) and (2), in a line from the Song Trau to the Southeast. A company from 1st Battalion, 5th Marines will block, on the North side of the Song Trau, attempts of the enemy to escape across the river to the North. Another element of 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines will form a blocking force to the East of, and parallel to, RVN Highway Route #1, thus completing a "U" trapping maneuver. RVN Regional Force Company 744 will move into the open end of the figure to execute its searching mission.

b. Co "C", 1st Battalion, 5th Marines. Occupy positions by not later than 010530 near the North bank of the Song Trau from Route #1 to approximate coordinates BT420093 to interdict the river route of enemy escape from the South side of the river.

c. Co "G" (Rein)(-)

(1) Provide security as required for tank movement.

(2) With two platoons (Rein), form blocking positions from the Song Trau at coordinates BT417089 to a point at BT 432087; to be in that position by 010530.

(3) Upon completion of the burnoff of Hill 22, advance blocking line to Hill 22 and clear the hill with Mine Clearance Team.

d. Co "E" (Rein)(-)

(1) With two platoons (Rein), move by foot North on Route #1 to the Ong Bo Bridge, and move West off the road to assume positions in blocking position from the Song Trau to approximate coordinates BT442094; to be in position by 010530.


