1. Contest narrative summary.

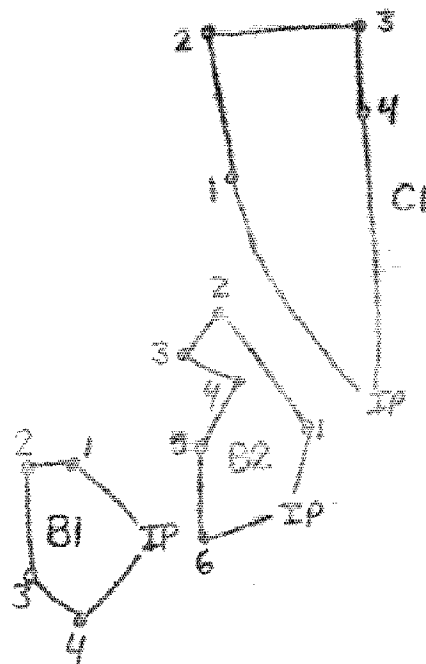
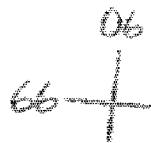
- a. At 150810H Engineer (road sweep) found one mine of about 20 pounds of TNT with electric detonator at (BT 078696). Destroyed mine in place.
1st Sgd CA 7th Expt Bn
- b. At 150910H Ontos hit mine at (BT 128634) resulting in severe damage to vehicle and two USMC KIA. The 106mm rounds were removed and placed under security awaiting arrival of EOD Team. The two KIA's were med evac.
2d Plt + C.C. 2d Bn
- c. At 151155H Company M platoon found booby trap at (BT 085702). Mine was in can abt 6" dia. and filled with frag elements and powder. Mine was blown in place.
- d. At 151255H squad patrol from Company A received 20-30 rounds sniper fire from (BT 048675). Patrol returned 20-30 rounds, searched area and apprehended 3 VCS, which were delivered to Battalion 3-2 for interrogation.
- e. At 151345H patrol from Company M tripped a booby trap resulting in one (1) USMC KIA non evac. Booby trap was a plastic bag filled with shrapnel and an unknown type of explosive. A Chi Com grenade was discovered in the same vic and was destroyed in place patrol continued mission.
- f. At 151515H a squad size patrol from Company A discovered a 60mm Mortar illumination round booby trapped with a M-26 frag grenade booby trap was destroyed in place.

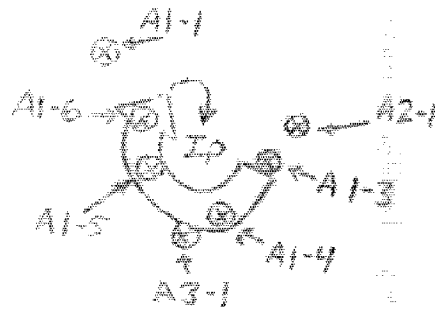

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. Late Entries. None.

B. Contacts. None.

C. Miscellaneous

a. At 141230H, Company I reported approximately twelve rounds 81mm impacting vicinity of Ba Tung (2) (BT 039696) and several rounds impacting west of the Song Vinh Dien River in 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines, TAOR 150 meters from Company I positions. Through liaison with ARVN units in 1st Battalion, 1st Marines, TAOR, it was established that the 1st Battalion, 51st ARVN Regiment, had fired the mission and, in addition, requested 81mm mortar support at coordinates BT 038696 and BT 042692. The mission was cleared through 1st Marines, and two rounds white phosphorous were fired when communications were lost. When communications were reestablished, VC had withdrawn and mission was cancelled.

b. At 151430H, 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines, was alerted by verbal order Commanding Officer, 1st Marines, to provide company (-) security of 155mm howitzer battery convey. Company K (-) commenced immediate preparations and, at 151519H, was staged for deployment.
