NARRATIVE SUMMARY  
1st Bn, 1st Marines

## 1. Contact narrative summary.

- a. At 160815H a member of the 3rd Plt Company A at BT 076678 stepped in a punji trap, booby trapped with what was believed to be an M-26 frag grenade resulting in one USMC WIA, shrapnel wounds in left arm and both legs. WIA Med evac to C Med Bn. Condition serious.
- b. At 160740H a patrol from M Company apprehended one (1) male VCS at BT 082605. Suspect was screened by GIT and identified by police chief as a VC. During interrogation VCC was uncooperative. VCC was sent to IFT.
- c. At 160755H the 1st Plt from Company B found a 105 Arty round hidden in bushes at BT 075605, it is believed to have been placed there to be used later as a booby trap by the VC. Round was destroyed in place.
- d. At 161000H a Plt patrol from Company C at BT 069629 received ten (10) rds A/W fire from BT 070638 from unknown number of VC fire was returned with one (1) round of 81mm Mortar fire. Area was searched nothing was found. Contact could not be reestablished.
- e. At 161100H a Plt patrol from Company B found a booby trapped Chi Com grenade at BT 071618 with mono filliment. Trip wire was across trail, grenade was destroyed in place.
- f. At 161245H a Sqd patrol from M Company providing security for a survey team at BT 082706 received 4-5 rds of S/A fire from BT 080704 from a unknown number of VC. Patrol returned fire resulting in one (1) VN woman being wounded in the stomach by a ricochet. Patrol swept area in an effort to regain contact. Contact was not reestablished. Woman was Med evac by halo.

## 2. Miscellaneous

- a. At 161330 the 1st Company of the 1st ARVN Bn while on a sweeping operation reported that they had made contact with three VC in a cave. VC had thrown two grenades resulting in three ARVN WIA (Non Evac). The cave was assaulted resulting in three VC KIA by grenade. Nine VCS were apprehended in the vicinity and turned over to the ARVN Bn for screening. A search of the cave was made, cave was destroyed. Captured two (2) K-44 C.I Com rifles, (One Chi Com claymore mine, (2) two rifle grenades, (1) one home made shape charge (8 lb) and six Chi Com grenades and assorted documents.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. Late Entries. None.

B. Contacts. At 160750H, Company L patrol traveling south along trail toward bridge (AT 980687) encountered two mines. The first was detonated thirty feet in front of the patrol, wounding point; the second was detonated two seconds later in middle of column, wounding one Marine. (It was not determined what explosive was used). Further investigation revealed eight feet of communication wire vicinity of first mine and forty yards of communication wire with copper ending vicinity of second mine. Forty yard wire led to evacuated VC position and indicated mine was electrically detonated. First mine apparently pull type. Search of immediate area revealed no further trace of VC.

C. Miscellaneous

a. At 160545H, combined action squad patrol apprehended one female VCS, vicinity Com Nc (1) (985692), running from patrol as they approached. Initially, woman had no identification, however, later produced ID, but remained extremely evasive to all questions. VCS sent to ITF for further interrogation.

b. At 161005H, Company L reported two artillery rounds impacting in vicinity Company L CP, rounds impacting five minutes apart. Both rounds impacted in same vicinity and 100 yards from friendly troops. There were no casualties or destruction to civilian property. 1st Marines FMP was informed and shell report submitted.

301-44 c. At 152400H, received Division Order 403-66 and Regimental Order 333-44 which placed 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines on six hour alert for support of operation KANSAS. At 1400H, verbal order from Commanding Officer, 1st Marines, 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines was placed on immediate alert.

d. At 160400H, Company L departed Battalion CP in execution of ROUGH RIDER mission assigned by verbal order, Commanding Officer, 1st Marines.




Day Patrulla for period 170000H to 180000H
