Narrative Summary 1st Bn, 1st Marines

At 171630H approximately 15 VC opened fire on Company C and B from (BT 081605) and (BT 083603). Company B received approximately 400 rounds of enemy small arms fire and 8 rifle grenades. Company C received approximately 200 rounds of small arms fire. The VC were located on the boundary between Company B and C. As a result of the initial VC fire, Company B sustained one Marine WIA.

Bravo Company moved troops into the area, from which the fire came from, supported by tanks and antos. The Marines and tanks fired as they advanced toward the VC position. The VC fire stopped and Bravo 6 called for mortar fire to cut off the withdrawal of the VC. One VC tried to run out of the area and in doing so moved into Company C zone. He was killed by small arms fire from Company C.

The sweep element from Company B moved into and through the VC position. There was no further VC contact. Five VCS were picked up. Three were casualties and later med evacuated. The VC had withdrawn carrying any casualties sustained with them.

Total casualties as a result of the action:

- 1 Marine WIA
- 1 VC KIA
- 2 VCS captured - interrogated by ITF and released.
- 3 Vietnamese WIA and evacs.

At 180900H a squad from 7th Engineers sweeping the MSR found one booby trapped M-26 grenade at (BT 080603). The grenade was inside a "C" ration can with a trip wire attached. The grenade was blown in place.

At 181148H a villager reported to Company C that there were 6 to 10 VC at (BT 103629) in a pagoda. The 2nd Platoon, Company D checked the pagoda with negative results.

At 181435H a squad patrol from Company B received six rounds of enemy fire from (BT 073648). The squad returned 10 rounds of small arms fire and 2 rounds M-79, checked the area with negative results and continued its mission.

SUBJECT FOR PERIOD 172400H TO 182400H

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Late Entries

a. At 172100H, Line-2, located vicinity coordinates 976697, received four rounds small arms fire from vicinity coordinates 976969. Fire not returned because not able to locate exact position of enemy.

b. At 172130H, combined action patrol in Phong Le, vicinity coordinates 996496, fired at an individual who failed to halt when challenged. Search of area revealed no evidence of wounding individual.

c. At 172215H, bridge security guard, at coordinates 777702, received three rounds small arms fire from Phong Le (2), vicinity coordinates 002702. Fire not returned.

2. Contacts. At 180040H, bridge security squad, vicinity coordinates 999497, received thirty rounds small arms fire from Phong Le (2). Twenty rounds small arms fire returned. An ARVN squad searched the hamlet and received two rounds small arms fire. ARVN continued search with negative results.

3. Miscellaneous. None.

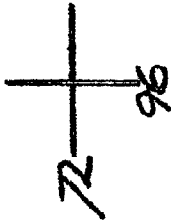
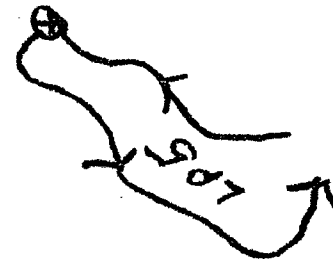
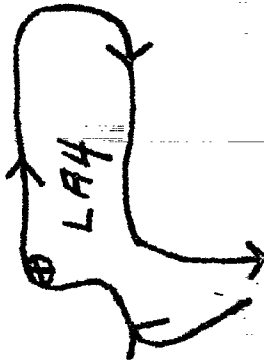
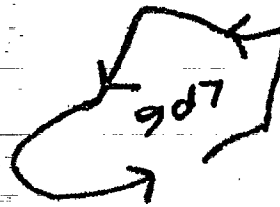
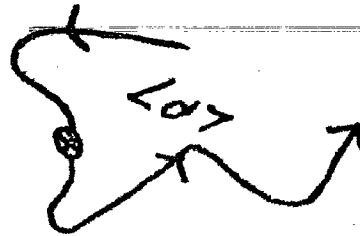
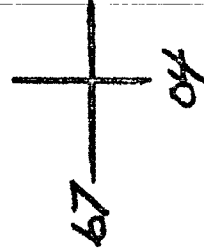
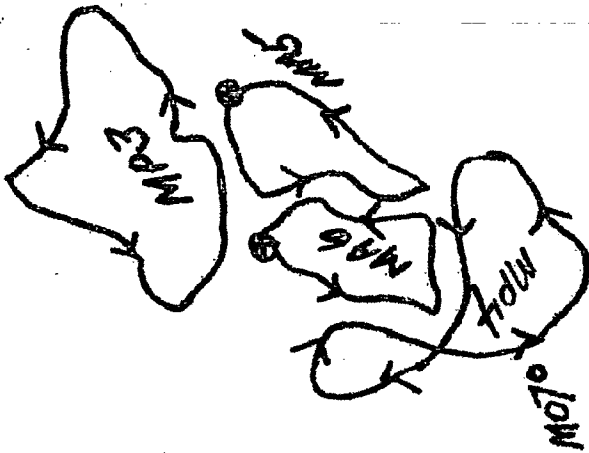
Day Patrols for Period 190600H to 200600H
