1. In accordance with reference (a), Enclosures (1), (2) and (3) are submitted herewith.

2. Miscellaneous

a. At 182025H, A post on 1st Marines Defensive Perimeter at BT 060713 received 3 rounds of sniper fire. Post returned fire with 5 rounds of small arms fire and two hand illumination grenades. Observed a figure running. Area was checked at first light, nothing was found.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY
1st Battalion, 1st Marines

1. Late Entries

a. At 182005H, a squad patrol from HAC Company received approximately 10 rounds of sniper fire from (BT 080661). The patrol returned 30 rounds of small arms and checked the area.

b. At 182130H, Company B CP received one rifle grenade and approximately 15 rounds of small arms fire from (BT 076615). Company B returned fire with 90mm and small arms fire. The VC withdrew under fire.

2. Contacts

a. At 190900H, Company A, squad patrol captured one male VC about 22 years old at (BT 080673). The VC had three (3) M-26 grenades, one (1) CHICOM grenade, one (1) bayonet, eighteen (18) rounds 30 caliber M1 rifle ammo and about 2 pounds of C-4. The VC was taken to Battalion 3-2 for interrogation. After initial interrogation it was believed that VCC was from a NVA unit. VCC stated that he would show Marines where four (4) VC were located. Platoon sent to check the area, nothing was found. VCC also stated he would show Marines where his weapon was hidden. Checked area and found a cave. No weapon was found. Cave was not destroyed due to the lack of demolitions. Cave will be destroyed tomorrow.

b. At 190900H, a Platoon from Company C received approximately 15 rounds of sniper fire from (BT 075624) from 3 - 5 VC in green uniforms. Platoon returned one round 3.5 rocket fire, 50 rounds small arms fire and (1) 81mm mortar round. VC broke contact. Area was swept and found one civilian female, wounded and was held evaced.

c. At 191130H, A platoon on a search and clear patrol from Company D received heavy small arms fire from an estimated 20 VC at (BT 129619) resulting in one Marine KIA. One squad became pinned down and the remaining two squads deployed to flank the enemy position. Reinforcements consisting of two tanks and two rifle squads were sent to the area. An artillery fire mission was called and the VC broke contact. The platoon received a burst of automatic fire from a village at (BT 132622). Another artillery mission was called and a search of the village was made. Seven VCS, one of who was wounded, were taken into custody and returned to the Battalion CP for interrogation.

d. At 191805H, Company D at (BT 116627) received six rounds of S/A fire from one (1) VC. Returned fire with (5) rounds 90mm, 7 rounds 60mm mortars and (50) rounds of S/A fire. Area was checked, found 1 VC woman with shrapnel wounds. Wounds not serious and will be evacuated tomorrow by vehicle.

e. At 191810H, A platoon patrol from Company A at (BT 079674) received 40 rounds A/W fire from an estimated 4 VC at (BT 084674). Returned fire with (5) rounds M-79 and 15-20 rounds of 82 fire. VC broke contact. Swept area, contact was not reestablished because patrol was unable to cross river.

5. Miscellaneous

a. At 191800H, two civilian children were wounded by a VC booby trap at (BT 067615). Both were evacuated. Civilians in the area reported that the VC have commenced mining and booby trapping of rice paddies and dikes in the vicinity of the above coordinates and apparently have not notified them of the location of booby traps. Area was checked, nothing was found.

INTELLIGENCE SUMMARY

1. Late Entries

- a. At 182000H, squad request, vicinity coordinates 963660, received ten rounds small arms fire from vicinity 962657. Outpost returned five rounds small arms fire and enemy ceased firing.
- b. At 182300H, H-H Company security post, located vicinity coordinates 970070, fired two rounds small arms fire at suspected enemy movement 100 meters west of his position. Subsequent search revealed no evidence of enemy casualties.

2. Contacts. None.

3. Miscellaneous. At 181700H, in accordance with O-1, 1st Marine Division message 102352Z, the 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines rear at the 1st Combat Base completed its move to the Da Nang Combat Base at 181712Z.



Flight Patterns for Period 200600H to 210600H



