1. In accordance with reference (a), Enclosures (1), (2) and (3) are submitted herewith.

## 2. Miscellaneous

a. Late Entry. At 202230H, Post #3 located at BT 072711 on the 1st Marines CP Defensive Perimeter observed two VC running south at BT 072709. Marines fired (10) rounds S/A fire. VC returned with 4-5 rounds of S/A and broke contact. Checked area at first light, marks in the sand indicated that one VC had been dragged about 10 yards, picked up and carried off. One (1) VC WIA (Probable).

## INTELLIGENCE SUMMARY

## 1. Late Entries

- a. At 201130H, a platoon from Company D while sweeping a village (vic BT 104622) sighted approximately 15 people fleeing across a rice paddy. One squad took them under fire and pursued. Seven (7) VCS were captured and blood trails were found indicating others had escaped. While sweeping the village, one (1) tunnel at (BT 100623) and two (2) at (BT 107627) were destroyed and one VC (confirmed by local cadre team) was killed at (BT 108628). The seven (7) VCS were sent to Battalion 3-2, who sent them on to IFT.
- b. At 201130H, a squad patrol from Company C apprehended three (3) VCS at (BT 093609) none of the three (3) had ID Cards, they were sent to Battalion 3-2, questioned and released.
- c. At 201230H, a platoon patrol from Company C apprehended three (3) VCS at (BT 106595). They were sent to Battalion 3-2, where they were questioned and released.
- d. At 201850H, a squad patrol from Company A at (BT 045714) received three (3) rounds sniper fire from (BT 050715). The squad returned three M-79 rounds, swept the area and continued its mission.

## 2. Contact

- a. At 210735H, the 2nd Platoon, Company D apprehended one (1) VCS near its position (BT 106626). IFT classified him as a VCS; local cadre team identified him as a VC. Sent to Battalion 3-2, then sent to IFT.
- b. 210925H, five VC at (BT 098640) fired approximately eight (8) rounds of S/A fire at Company D Platoon on Amtrack at (BT 100636). Marines returned approximately 200 rounds of S/A and five (5) rounds M-79. Two VC were seen falling off edge of rice paddy. The area was searched and blood was found.
- c. At 211600H, a platoon patrol from Company C apprehended five (5) VCS of military age at (BT 101614). VCS were screened. Four (4) were released and one (1) was sent to III MAF IFT. He stated he had information on VC activities.
- d. At 211700H, A Huey taking off from LZ at 1st Battalion, 1st Marines CP received 6-7 rounds of sniper fire from (BT 067656) from an estimated one (1) VC. Three (3) rounds were returned and enemy fire ceased.

## 3. Miscellaneous

- a. At 201930H, one Vietnamese girl was injured at (BT 084615) while Company C was registering 60 mortars. Med Evac was called. Backlash report to be forwarded.

INTELLIGENCE REPORT

1. Intel Entries

- a. At 201900H, Company K, 3rd Battalion, 3rd Marines Command Post, vicinity coordinates 035699, received two rounds 82mm mortar within thirty meters of their front positions. One USMC received slight wound in left hand, was treated and returned to duty. Report of incident made to 1st Marines Regiment plus shall Rep. One USMC WIA, no VC casualties.
- b. At 202200H, 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines Command Post security, vicinity coordinates 972676, had one hand grenade thrown at their position. Five rounds 82mm mortar illumination fired in support; ten rounds small arms fire were fired at suspected area. No friendly or confirmed VC casualties.
- c. At 202245H, a patrol from Company L, vicinity coordinates 972691, discovered a twenty millimeter round body trap rigged with pull type trip wire. Device was destroyed in place. No friendly or VC casualties.


