NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Late Entries

a. At 211340H, Company B squad patrol vicinity (BT 071612) apprehended a 33 year old male VCS. VCS delivered to ITT.

b. At 212120H, Company D positions vicinity (BT 124630) and (BT 106626) received approximately 50 rounds small arms and 8 rounds 60MM mortar fire. VC mortar positions believed to be located vicinity (BT 127627). Small arms fire received from vicinity (BT 103629). Fire returned with 80 rounds small arms, 1 round 90MM, 8 rounds M79 and 33 rounds 60MM mortar. Artillery mission called. Squads were sent to search each of the VC positions, but were unable to conduct a thorough search due to darkness. The areas were rechecked at first light. No evidence of VC activity or casualties was found.

2. Contact

a. At 220925H, Company B conducting a clearing operation vicinity (BT 063596) apprehended 1 VCS, destroyed one small tunnel and captured various documents of unknown type. VCS and documents forwarded to ITT.

b. At 221330, a patrol member with Company A squad patrol vicinity (BT 075677) stepped into a camouflaged hole which was booby trapped with a ChiCom anti-personnel grenade. The grenade failed to detonate and was destroyed in place.

3. Miscellaneous

a. At 221200H, approximately 100 civilians came to the entrance to the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines CP (BT 075675) with 3 Vietnamese dead. The Vietnam se from HOA AHI village (BT 084687) claimed that the three people had been killed by artillery fire. Incident being investigated.

b. At 221515H line crew (8-men) vicinity (BT 987623) trouble shooting wireline to Company C observed approximately 15 Vietnamese men who moved away as Marines approached. No weapons were observed. Company C sent Squad to scene, but Vietnamese had moved out of the area before they arrived.

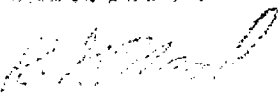

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Late Entries. At 212045H, a patrol from Company L, vicinity coordinates AT 969697, apprehended one VCS out after curfew near a house. House was searched revealing one thirty caliber round hidden in the kitchen. A second house fifty meters from the first was searched and found to be deserted. VCS held overnight, then forwarded to 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines Command Post for further forwarding to ITT. No friendly or VC casualties.

2. Contacts

a. At 220330H, the Command Post security from 2nd Platoon, Company L had an explosion of unknown origin, vicinity coordinates AT 977698, resulting in two USMC KIA. Search of the area at first light did not reveal anything further as to the origin of the explosion. Two USMC KIA, no VC casualties.

b. At 221030H, a patrol from Company L on a wire recovery detail exploded a grenade booby trapped to the wire, vicinity coordinates AT 970699. One USMC was wounded and immediately evacuated. Search of the area disclosed fragments which appeared to be from an M-2 grenade. One USMC WIA, no VC casualties.

3. Miscellaneous. At 221205H, Commanding Officer, 1st Marines directed Commanding Officer, 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines to change the six hour alert for Company M, 3rd Battalion, 3rd Marines to twelve hours.

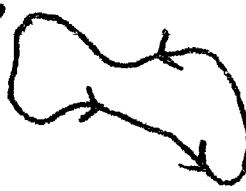

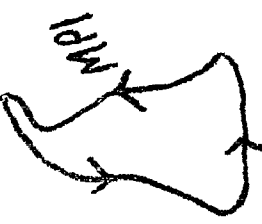
