NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Late Entries

a. At 221645H a squad clearing patrol from Company B found one booby trapped ChiCom grenade at (BT 081600). The grenade was blown in place and patrol continued its mission.

2. Contact

a. At 230950H a wire team from the Battalion GP detonated one booby trap at (BT 078656) slightly injuring one USMC. Wire team returned to Ba GP where WIA was treated at BAS.

b. At 231400H a squad patrol from Today 2 sighted four armed VC at (BT 094644) wearing khaki uniforms, camouflage scarfs and floppy hats. Patrol and VC sighted each other simultaneously. Patrol fired 40 rounds S/A and pursued VC into headgerows where contact was lost. One Vietnamese in area was interrogated and released.

3. Miscellaneous

a. At 231215H 2nd Platoon, Company C was conducting search and clear patrol via (BT 090616) accompanied by local village chief. One house reported to be VC was found unoccupied and was destroyed by Vietnamese. Small arms explosions were heard during burning of dwelling.

b. At 231450H an interrogation team from Today-2 and ITT questioned civilian in GOM-SA village (BT 095642) which resulted in F-2 rating of this information received concerning 200 VC which passed their village about 221800H.

SITREP FOR PERIOD 222400H TO 232400H

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Late Entries. At 222015H, the platoon from Company L in the Hamlet of An Trach, vicinity coordinates AT 972662, started receiving a heavy volume of small arms fire from approximately twenty positions surrounding the Hamlet. Artillery illumination was fired in support and approximately 500 rounds small arms fire was returned at the VC positions. The firing tapered off but continued sporadically until 222200H. Search of the area at first light showed evidence of the VC positions but no casualties could be determined. One USMC KIA, no confirmed VC casualties.

2. Contacts

a. At 230650H, the combined action squad in Phong Le (1), vicinity coordinates AT 995698, received approximately eight rounds small arms fire from vicinity of Cam Ne (1), vicinity coordinates AT 985695. No friendly or VC casualties.

b. At 231030H, a squad patrol from Company L, vicinity coordinates AT 969698, received four rounds sniper fire from vicinity coordinates AT 967698. Squad returned ten rounds small arms fire and searched area with negative results. No USMC or confirmed VC casualties.

3. Miscellaneous. None.

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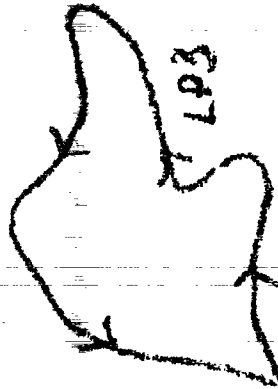
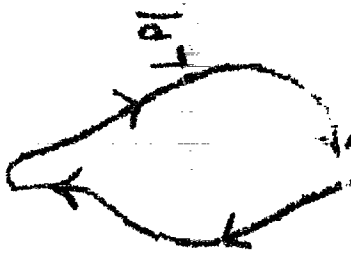
