NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Late Entry

NONE

2. CONTACT

A. At 260600H a squad ambush from K company at (BT 067633) received 20 rounds sniper fire from two weapons via. (BT 060632). Squad returned 20-30 rounds S/A and swept the area without contact. One PRO-10 rifle damaged by enemy S/A fire.

B. At 262010H Company K received five (5) rounds sniper fire at (BT 083641) from an unknown number of VC at (BT-082639). One (1) Marine KIA (non evs) also-patched fire team to check area. Searched area -- nothing found.

3. MISCELLANEOUS

A. At 260713H Company A found one dud 105mm round via (BT 123603). The dud appeared to be an old one and was partly buried in the sand. One tunnel was found in the same via. The tunnel and the 105mm dud were destroyed and Company A continued its advance.

B. At 260800H one 105mm dud found by Company A via (BT 143512). The dud was partly buried in the sand. The engineers attached to the company destroyed the dud in place.

C. At 260934H one Vietnamese boy was brought to Company K CP via (BT 083641) by his parents. The boy was suffering from stomach wounds. Company A was unable to determine how the boy was wounded. Or where he was at the time of the injury. The boy and his parents approached the company CP from a Southwesterly direction. The boy and his parents were evacuated to the ARVN Hospital in Da Nang by Helicopter.

D. At approximately 261000H, a squad from Company D was dispatched to the via of (BT 076692) to find a rocket pod which had been dropped by a helicopter. The squad found the rocket pod and remained in the area until personnel arrived to recover it. The squad observed two male Vietnamese watching the recovery operation. When the Marines approached them they acted suspicious. They were apprehended and returned to Da Nang for interrogation. They were later forwarded to III MAF ITR.

NA NATIVE SUMMARY

1. LATE ENTRIES.

A. At 252542H Company L, 1st platoon outpost, located vic (BT 972663), received five rounds S/A fire from vic (BT 972662). Outpost returned 10 rounds S/A fire and observed one VC fleeing area. Subsequent search of area revealed no evidence of VC casualties. No friendly casualties.

2. CONTACTS.

A. At 262015H a plt OP from Company L located at (BT 977697) received 50 rounds A/W fire from unknown number of VC. Returned fire with S/A fire and four (4) rounds 60mm mortars, 3 rounds 3.5 WP. Listening Post heard one VC scream when 60mm mortars impacted. Observed one VC run through a 3.5 round burst. Area will be checked at first light. Est (1) VC-KIA, (1) VC -WIA. (Both Probable).

B. At 262135H a squad patrol from Company M at BT 028713 observed (3) VC approximately 150 meters to their south. Patrol fired 50 rounds S/A and pursued VC physically but lost contact. RF unit in area of VC's withdrawal was notified. Patrol continued mission.

3. MISCELLANEOUS.

A. At 260600H Company L 1st plt. established blocking position from coordinates (BT957692) to (BT 969698) in support of search and clear operation conducted by Company E, 3d Bn 3d Marines. Operation secured at 261150H.

B. At 261300H elements of 3d Bn, 1st Marines, forward, commenced lifting out of landing zone located vic (BT 135364) enroute to CP, Da Nang combat Base. Lift completed 261550H. All 3d Bn, 1st Marines units participating in operation KANSAS, with exception of second plt Company M, returned in this lift. Second Plt Company M (Rein), provided convoy security for motor march to Chu Lai Combat Base, and for further sealift to Da Nang Combat Base.

C. At 261535H 3d Bn, 1st Marines chops OPCON from 5th Marines to 1st Marines.
