NARRATIVE SUMMARY
1st Bn, 1st Mar

1. Late Entries

- a. At 272125H Company B CP at (BT 075605) received approximately 25 rounds sniper fire from an estimated 4 VC at (BT 076607). Company B returned 500 rounds S/A and 12 rounds 90mm fire. One Marine WIA but did not require evacuation. Company sent a squad to sweep the area and drive the VC into one of its ambushes.
- b. At 272200H a Company B ambush at (BT 081598) killed one VC and probably wounded another who escaped through a rice paddy.

2. Contact

- a. At 2809050H a squad patrol from Company B while sweeping vic (BT 069614) apprehended 2 males who were identified by Cadre team as VCS. The two were sent to Bn CP for further questioning and forwarded to III MAF ITT.
- b. At 281130H a patrol from Company A detained one VCS, age 37, VCS had no ID card and acted suspicious. VCS was sent to Bn CP for further questioning and forwarded to III MAF ITT.
- c. At 281315H the 3d Plt, Company D at (BT 088667) received 50-60 rounds S/A fire from an estimated four VC (BT 088667). The Plt returned 150 rounds S/A, 10 rounds M-79, 14 rounds 60mm mortar and two LAAW's. A squad was sent into the enemy position without contact.
- d. At 281425H an FO from 1st Bn, 11th Mar at (BT 081709) spotted 7 VC with rifle and machine guns. ARTY mission fired. Plt sent to check area at (BT 084905). One body was found. Identified as a security guard for Special Forces Camp. It is believed that another member of security guard was captured by VC. Nothing else was found. Body was picked up by American advisor from Special Forces Camp.

SITREP FOR PERIOD 272400H TO 282400H

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Late Entries

a. At 272200H, a sentry on Command Post security vicinity AT 989679 heard movement approximately 300 meters in front of his position vicinity AT 989682. One 81mm mortar illumination was fired over area but no movement could be detected. No friendly or VC casualties.

b. At 272200H, the platoon from Company L at An Trach (AT 972662) received approximately 100 rounds small arms fire from two VC positions 250 meters from their lines (AT 970665 to AT 972664). The platoon had both artillery and 81mm mortar illumination fired in support over the area in an attempt to positively fix the VC while returning 130 rounds small arms fire. The VC broke contact before the platoon could send elements to close with them. Search of the area at first light uncovered a large blood spot indicating at least one VC KIA. No friendly casualties; one VC KIA.

2. Contacts. At 280745H, the road clearing detail discovered a booby trap vicinity AT 988662. The device resembled a COKE can and had a larger metal plate as a pressure plate on top of it. It was estimated to have one to two pounds of explosives. Device was destroyed in place. No casualties.

3. Miscellaneous. At 281315H, the last elements of 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines, participating in Operation KANSAS returned to the Command Post after having acted as convoy security for Battery K, 4th Battalion, 12th Marines, from the operation area to Chu Lai Combat Base.

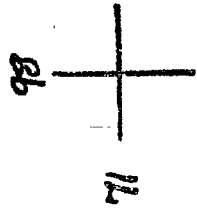
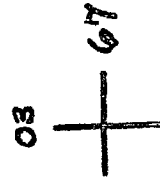
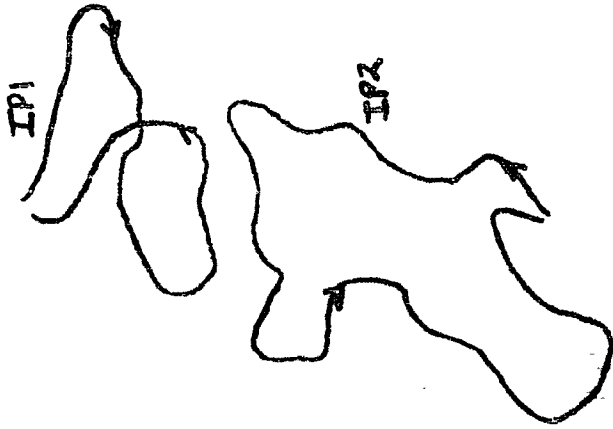
