NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1st Bn, 1st Mar

1. Late Entry

- a. At 282040H a sqd from Company B was moving into its ambush position at (BT 079602) when the point man heard noise in bushes and immediately the sqd received approximately 30 rounds S/A fire from a distance of 20-30 meters from the point man. The sqd returned 100 rounds S/A and the VC withdrew. Another sqd joined the first sqd and together the area of contact was swept. No further contact was made. All houses and bomb shelters were searched, but even the civilians had departed the area.

2. Contact

- a. At 290730H a Plt from Company C on clearing mission apprehended 2 males VCS an old man and a young boy at BT 083616 old man was identified as a VC by village chief. Young boy offered information on VC but an interpreter was not available. Both were sent to BN CP.
- b. At 290750H the 3d Plt, Company A while sweeping vicinity (BT 134615) received approximately 15 rounds sniper fire from an estimated one VC vicinity (BT 133614). One USMC was wounded and evacuated. The platoon returned approximately 25 rounds small arms and continued the sweep.
- c. At 290900H Company A swept village vicinity (BT 133614) and apprehended seven male VCS who were sent to Battalion for further questioning and forwarding to III MAF IPT.
- d. At 291610H a plt from Company B at (BT 065644) received approximately 8 rounds sniper fire from vicinity (BT 065646). Marines returned 3 rounds M-79 and 20 rounds small arms and searched area without contact.
- e. At 292120H a Plt patrol base from D Company located at BT 057639 received two incoming grenades from a estimated two VC at BT 057640 returned fire with 20 rounds S/A area checked nothing found.

3. Miscellaneous

- a. At 290700H a plt from Company B while sweeping vicinity (BT 081594) found one wounded 40 year old male. Vietnamese Cadre team interrogated the man and said he was not VC, he was released and sent to District Headquarters for medical treatment.
- b. At 291115H the 2d Plt, Company B while sweeping vicinity (BT 081596) found the following equipment in hay stacks or buried; one grenade (type unk), one pack, one spool trip wire, four rifle slings, one shelter half, one utility uniform, one plastic bag of rice. Items will be forwarded to Battalion S-2.

- c. At 291130H Company A reported a smoke grenade was set off inside a Company A, 1st AMTRAC Battalion LVT at (BT 148606) which started a small fire that activated a M-26 frag grenade slightly injuring one crewman. The LVT was not damaged. The smoke grenade was set off either by engine heat or the vibration caused the safety pin to work loose. The LVT returned to the Battalion CP where the wounded man was treated.

SITREP FOR PERIOD 282100H TO 292100H

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Late Entries

a. At 282000H, Company L Command Post vicinity AT 973686 received fifteen rounds small arms fire from an undetermined VC position approximately 400 meters North of their position. Twenty-five rounds small arms fire were returned in direction of firing; the VC firing ceased. The suspected area was checked by a patrol and thoroughly searched at first light by another; neither was able to find evidence of VC position. No friendly or confirmed VC casualties.

b. At 282000H to 282030H, the platoon from Company L at Hamlet of An Trach (AT 972663) received forty rounds small arms fire simultaneously their outpost vicinity AT 962660 received twenty rounds small arms fire from seven to nine VC approximately 300 - 400 meters from their lines (AT 972666 and AT 963663). Under artillery illumination support, the platoon and outpost returned fifty rounds small arms fire and one 106mm recoilless rifle round. At 282015H, the VC started speaking to the inhabitants of the village over a loudspeaker warning the women and children to stay down and take cover. All firing and speakers were suppressed by fire. Search of the area at first light disclosed no evidence of VC casualties. No friendly or confirmed VC casualties.

c. At 282255H, a security post on the Command Post perimeter vicinity AT 990678 received four rounds small arms fire from extreme range and undetermined position. No muzzle flashes were observed and no movement could be detected. No friendly or VC casualties.

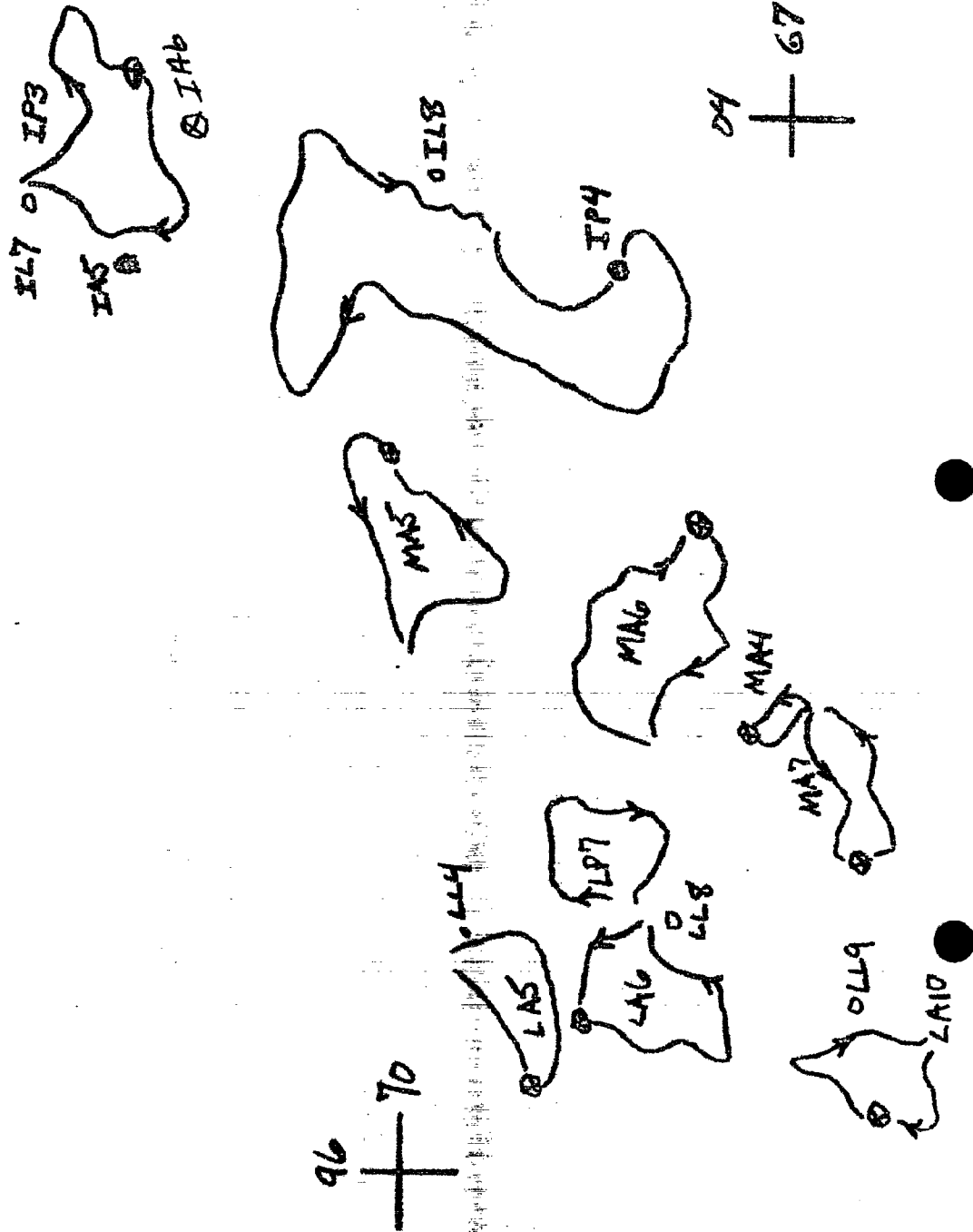
