NARRATIVE SUMMARY
1st Mar, 1st Mar1. Losses.

- a. At 292150H estimated two snipers at (BT 142616) fired approximately 7 rounds M-14 and one round carbine at Company A CP (BT 141618). An artillery mission was called on VC probable route of withdrawal. One squad from Company A swept the area without contact.
- (1) b. At 292300H a squad from Company B while moving into its ambush at (BT 081508) captured two VC, and one CHICOM grenade. While establishing a new ambush sight one VC managed to free himself and escape. The remaining VC was rebound and kept with the ambush site. Company is attempting to use VC to locate other enemy in area. He will be forwarded to III MAF ITT.

2. Casualties.

- (3) a. At 300730H the 3d Plt, Company A captured one VCS approximately 30 years old at (BT 152602). VCS was wearing green shirt under a white one and admitted to being an ARVN deserter. VCS is to be returned to District Headquarters at HOI AN.
- (6) b. At 300810H a squad patrol from Company D at (BT 073664) received approximately 3 rounds carbine fire from estimated one VC at (BT 074644). Squad returned 20 rounds S/A and swept area without contact.
- (7) c. At 301020H a tank from Company C, 1st Tank Battalion hit a mine estimated to be 50 pounds of TNT at (BT 120627). Damage to the tank was extensive. The tank will be returned to Company C CP 1st Tank Battalion for repairs. There were no casualties.
- (9) d. At 301145H a squad patrol from Company K at (BT 054668) received approximately 80 rounds S/A from two houses via (BT 054669). Squad returned 150 rounds S/A, 6 round M-79 and 15 rounds machinegun fire. Enemy withdrew and contact was broken.
- (11) e. At 301600H a medevac hele while picking up a heat casualty from Company B at (BT 085509) received S/A fire from VC in black clothing at (BT 087509). The escort UH-1E gunship made two strafing and rocket runs at tunnels along south bank of a creek at (BT 087509). He was unable to make a damage estimate due to smoke in target area. The 3d Plt, Company B swept the area, but could not locate the VC or the reported tunnels.

f. At 301620H a squad patrol from Company D apprehended a VN male about 40 years old at (BT 066634) with no ID card, a POW tag was found in his pocket. Written on the tag was Bravo Company 181430H and 3d Plt I C. 270830H. A VN woman in same vicinity was questioned. She stated that there were 6 VC in the area. Patrol checked area with negative contact. VCS was sent to Bound CP.

(13) g. At 301700H a squad patrol from Company D received 50 rounds S/A fire at (BT 058634) from an estimated 4-6 VC located approximately at (BT 059630). Also a booby-trapped gun was tripped, damaging one PRC-6. Area was checked with negative contact.

(15) h. At 301745H a vehicle from Company K OPCON 1st Bn moving on road at (BT 071695) received 8 rounds sniper fire from 1 VC located about 50 meters east of vehicle. VC was wearing purple trousers. Marines returned 6 rounds S/A. Two squads were sent to check area. They found a man in a hat out of breath and wearing purple trousers. VCS will be sent to Bound CP at first light.

i. Miscellaneous.

a. At 302400H the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines closed on Phase Line ~~alpha~~.

NARRATIVE SAW ANY1. Late Entries

a. At 221920H, 1st platoon CP, Company L, vicinity coordinates AT 977686, received approximately twenty rounds small arms fire from VC position approximately 400-500 meters away, vicinity coordinates AT 973694. The platoon returned sixty rounds small arms fire and one round M-79; VC fire ceased. Search at first light revealed no trace of VC. No friendly or confirmed VC casualties.

b. At 221950H, 3rd platoon CP, Company L, vicinity coordinates AT 9776683, received fifteen to twenty rounds small arms fire from approximately 500 meters north, vicinity coordinates AT 975688. The platoon returned twenty rounds small arms fire and one round M-79. Search at first light revealed no trace of VC. No friendly or confirmed VC casualties.

2. Contacts. None.

3. Miscellaneous. At 301330H, 3rd Battalion, 3rd Marines reported elements of VC platoon to be in vicinity coordinates AT 963614 and AT 960614. 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines dispatched one combined AF/USMC platoon to investigate. No trace of VC was found.


