NARRATIVE SUMMARY
1st Bn, 1st Mar

1. Late Entry

- a. At 302000H the 1st Platoon, Company A at (BT 166603) received 40 rounds small arms fire and 4 rounds M-79 from four directions (BT 166601, 168602, 165602 and 164603) from approximately 5 VC. Platoon returned 50 rounds small arms and 11 rounds M-79. The area was swept without contact.

2. Contact

- a. At 010915H a squad patrol from Company B at (BT 087568) received approximately 20 rounds sub-machinegun fire from (BT 088570). The patrol returned 20 rounds M-14 and 5 rounds machinegun and pursued the enemy. Two VC in black pajamas, one carrying a Thompson Sub-machinegun were seen leaving the area towards the southwest. DIEN BAN District Headquarters was notified. Blood found in area indicated at least one VC was wounded.
- b. At 010940H the point man of a squad patrol from Company C detonated a pressure type AP mine at (BT 092612). One US Marine was WIA with multiple shrapnel wounds of both legs. ~~Plt CP at BT 074699 received approx. 50 rounds S/A from an estimated 4-5 VC at BT 074699. Fire directed at Plt CP and Village Chief's house. Returned fire with 10 rounds S/A. VC broke contact. Area checked, negative results.~~
- c. At 011800H 3d Plt Co B at BT 069615 received fire from an estimated 3 VC at BT 069619 and BT 073618. Returned fire with 6 M-79 and 300 S/A. Area swept VC broke contact.
- d. At 011915H Co D at BT 062604 received fire from VC at BT 057638, BT 057642, BT 065638. Plt returned fire VC broke contact.
- e. At 012005H 3d Plt Co B at BT 069615 received fire from an estimated 3 VC at BT 069619 and BT 073618. Returned fire with 6 M-79 and 300 S/A. Area swept VC broke contact.

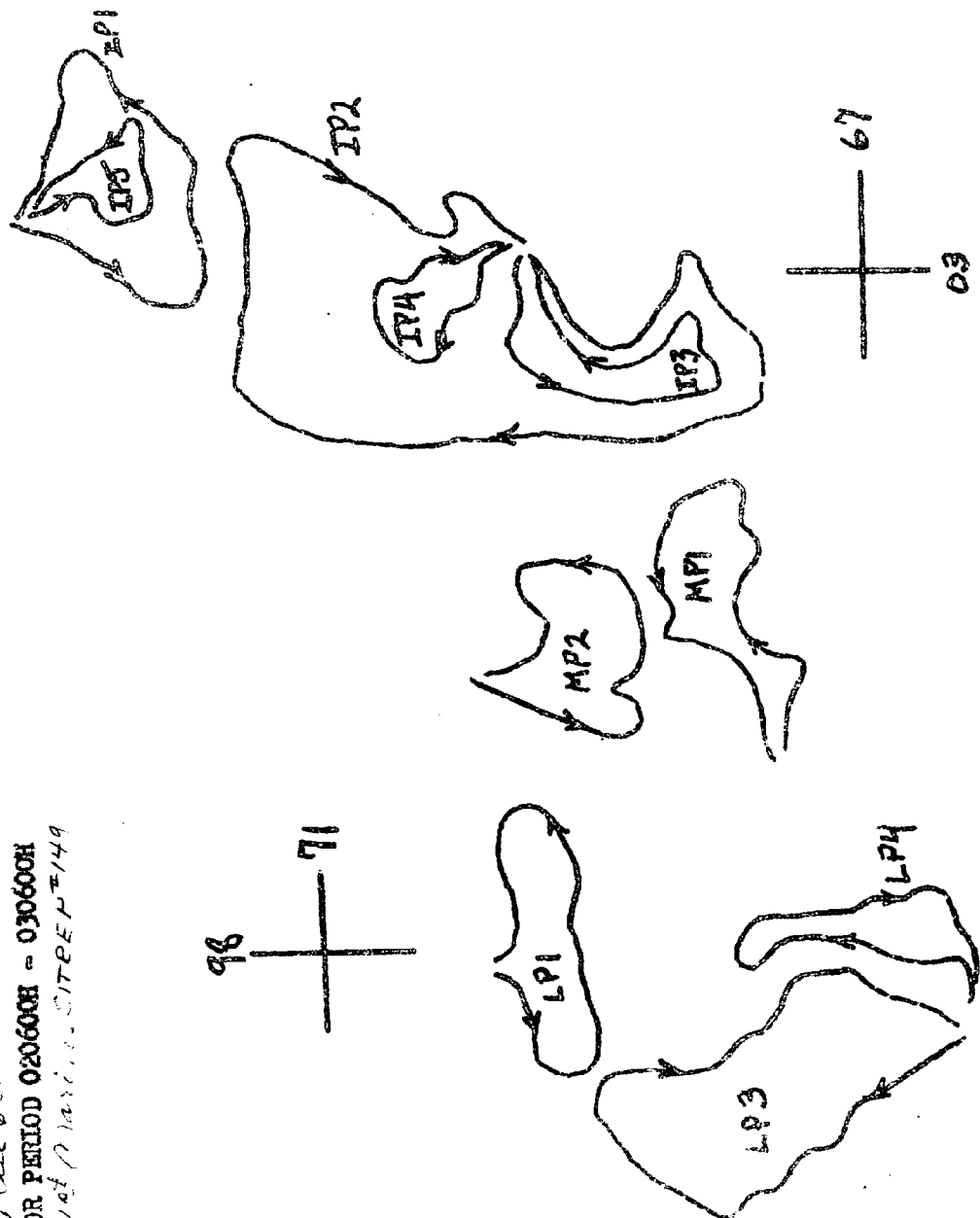
