NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Late Entries

- A. At 012000H an estimated 2 VC at (BT 077604) fired 30 rounds into Company B CP (BT 075606). Company returned 150 rounds S/A and swept the area without contact.

2. Contact

- A. At 020948H a tank from Company C, 1st Tank Bn, enroute to Bn CP detonated a mine of unknown type at (BT 078638). Damaged tank will be repaired, if possible, at Bn CP.
- B. At 021245H a squad patrol from Company A apprehended one male VCS at (BT 148602). A search of the VCS house produced spent M-1 cartridge, documents, medical supplies and what appeared to be the components of a booby trap. The VCS will be forwarded to III MAF ITT.
- C. At 021315H the 1st platoon, Company D while cutting through a hedgerow with machetes at (BT 057645) detonated a "Bouncing Betty" type mine resulting in two Marines WIA. Both were evacuated with multiple shrapnel wounds of the head, chest and legs. A search of the area revealed no other mines in the area.
- D. At 021520H a patrol from Company B received 150 rounds S/A fire from 6 VC at (BT 067618). The patrol returned fire with 12 M-79 rounds, 220 S/A rounds and 2 WP 3.5" rounds. A sweep of the area found ChiCom 7.62 spent rounds. 1 VCS was apprehended with spent 7.62 rounds and 30 cal rounds in pockets. VCS being sent to III MAF ITT.
- E. At 021830H a sqd from Company D reinforced with Ontos at (BT 047657) received 200 rounds A/W and S/A fire from approximately 10 VC at (BT 056650) resulting in one Marine WIA (non evac), fire returned with 300 rounds S/A, 9 106RR roundsfire. VC broke contact. Squad swept area in an effort to regain contact. Contact was not reestablished. Squad and Ontos started moving out when they again came under heavy S/A fire from the hamlet of Tu Can (3) (BT 048656) fire was returned with 50 cal MG and 106RR. Area was swept. 1 VC KIA was found, also two secondary explosions were observed from 106RR fire. Contact was not reestablished. Squad and Ontos returned to CP.
- F. At 021945H a squad ambush from Company A at BT 154598 observed a boat at (BT 154598) heading north. Boat was challenged. 4-5 rounds carbine fire was received. Squad returned fire with 75 rounds S/A. Three VC were observed falling from boat. Bank of river was observed for 30 minutes. No one came out of river. Three VC KIA (prob).

3. Miscellaneous

- A. At 021200H the boundry of the 1st Battalion TAOR changed. Company K was shepped to the Opeon of 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Info Request: None.

2. Contacts: At 020510H, one VCS walked into Company I squad ambush vicinity AT 031724. The VCS was challenged twice in Vietnamese but failed to halt. The ambush shot and wounded the suspect. VCS was subsequently noticed evacuated.

3. Remarks:

a. At 021200H, Company I CDRP OPCON to 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines from 1st Battalion, 1st Marines disclaimed responsibility of that portion of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines extended TMA as directed by Commanding Officer, 1st Marines.

b. At 021200H, report from U. S. Army adviser with Hoa Yang Sub-District Headquarters reported (unrated) one Main Force VC company (-) vicinity AT 976600 to AT 985600 and one Main Force VC platoon vicinity AT 976609. Unit reportedly had two 81mm mortars and several small arms. Company I conducted a combined VCS/ARVN company search and clear operation through this area with no reported contact on the date of this reporting period.

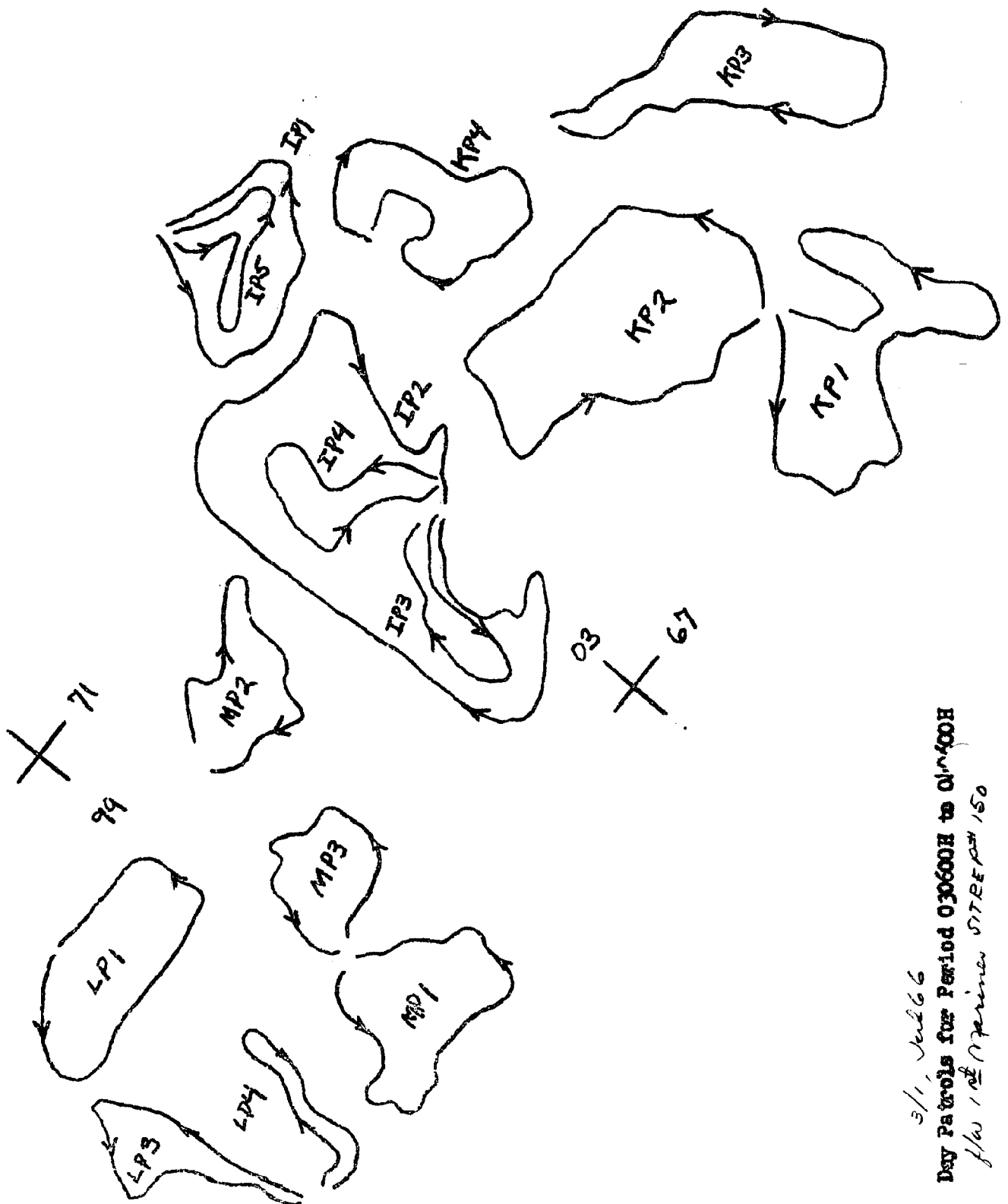
