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NARRATIVE SUMMARY
1st Bn, 1st Mar

1. Lost Entries. None

2. Contact

- ② a. At 030800H a squad patrol from Company A at (BT 169602) sighted two VC at (BT 169598). VC fired 75 rounds automatic fire and Marines returned 190 rounds 3/A and three M-79 grenades. Squad assaulted position but contact was lost. Two tanks and one squad provided a block while the squad made a detailed search of the area. At 030930H a Marine detonated what was believed to be an M-26 grenade type mine. Marine received shrapnel wounds in lower legs and was evacuated. No further contact was made.
- ③ b. At 031115H a squad patrol from Company A at (BT 131594) encountered a VCS at (BT 131594) who jumped up in front of point man and ran. The patrol called for him to halt, then fired a warning shot. VCS continued to run. Fire from the squad wounded the VCS. A picture found on the VCS shows him in ARVN uniform. A medical evacuation was called to evacuate VCS to Ho An Hospital. VCS may be ARVN deserter or VC.
- ④ c. At 031245H a squad patrol from Company A at (BT 136594) found a VCS hiding in straw pile at (BT 136594). The VCS was taken to Battalion forward CP and then delivered to HIEU NHON District Headquarters.
- ⑤ d. At 031335H an LVT from Company A, 1st AMTRAC Bn detonated a mine at (BT 136603). There was damage to the roadwheel assembly and track. The LVT is being repaired in place and will return to Company A CP.
- ⑥ e. At 031430H a patrol from Co B at BT 081598 spotted one VC moving south about 100 meters from patrol position. Patrol fired 15 3/A rounds. Swept area and apprehended (1) VCS, taken to Dien Bon District Hq. at 1835 Dien Bon District reported to Bound that VCS was confirmed VC.

3. Miscellaneous

- ⑪ f. At 031800H 1st Plt from D Co reported that L/Cpl R.H. GAGE from A Co 1st AT Bn left PPB location at BT 057646 to wash his clothes about 150 meters from at 031600H. At 031800H Marine was discovered missing. Two Sqs were sent to check area. Search is continuing.
