1. Late Entries

a. At 052205H a platoon from Company B (BT 069612) received 25 rounds S/A fire from 3 VC (BT 070614). Platoon returned 20 rounds S/A. A squad ambush (BT 073612) fired 10 rounds M-79 and 50 rounds S/A fire in support of the platoon causing the VC to flee. A search was made without contact.

b. At 052310H a squad patrol from Company A at (BT 143609) received approximately 14 rounds S/A fire from village vic (BT 145608). Squad returned fire and moved towards village. One U. S. Marine WIA by booby trap vic (BT 145608). Village was surrounded and at 040140H swept. Five VCS apprehended and forwarded to HOI AN for interrogation.

2. Contact

a. At 040815H a Company B squad patrol (BT 058630) received approximately 20 rounds S/A fire from VC (BT 062628). Squad returned 200 rounds S/A and 5 rounds M-79, flanked and searched area without further contact.

b. At 041500H a platoon from Company D, on clearing mission, found a booby trapped M-26 grenade at (BT 061659). Booby trap destroyed in place.

c. At 041530H a Platoon from D Company, on clearing mission, found a bouncing betty type mine at (BT 065533). Placed in the intersection of two rice paddy dikes. Mine destroyed in place.

d. At 042000H 1st Plt Company D at (BT 059649) received approximately 200 rounds A/W and S/A fire from an unknown number of VC from (BT 057645). Platoon returned fire with 1,200 rounds S/A, 52 rounds M-79, 1 LAAM, 2 rounds 3.5" WP 3 rounds 3.5" HE, 800 rounds 30 cal, 15 rounds 60mm mortar. One VC was seen hit with M-79 burst. 1 VC WIA (prob). VC broke contact. Area was swept with negative contact. 1 USMC WIA (non evao).

3. Miscellaneous

a. At 040008H a squad ambush from Company B at (BT 090570) killed one Vietnamese female identified as HUYNH THI HON, age 39. She was insane and usually kept bound at night to prevent her wandering about. PF unit in area advises no adverse public reaction anticipated.

b. At 041100H a Squad from A Company while checking ambush sight (BT 157601) Ref. Spot rpt DTG 032150H, found a 20 lbs shape charge and Chicom grenade in two tunnels. Blew grenade and tunnels and brought shape charge to A-1PPB.

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c. At 041600H a Platoon from Company D on clearing mission found a small VC cache in a tunnel at (BT 058649). 10 rounds 7.62, 10 rounds .45 cal, one PRC-10 battery, 10 battery cells, and five rolls of trip wire and 50 feet of comm wire was found. Tunnel and equipment was destroyed.

2. Contacts

a. At 040040H Company L ambush (AT 975675) received eight rounds small arms fire and two hand grenades. Ambush returned ten rounds S/A fire and one round M-79; VC fire ceased and ambush searched suspected VC positions via (AT 974657). Nothing was found.

b. At 040805 a sqd patrol from Company K tripped a booby trapped M-26 grenade at (BT 045713) resulting in two Marines WIA (med evac).

c. At 041125H Company K squad patrol (BT 044681) received eighteen rounds S/A fire (thought to be BAR) and four rounds carbine fire from vic (BT 046679). The patrol returned six rounds M-79, 150 rounds S/A fire, and conducted search of suspected enemy positions with negative results.

3. Miscellaneous. In cooperation with Hoa Vang District Headquarters and the 4th Battalion, 51st Regional Force Regiment, Company L 3rd Bn, 1st Marines, conducted a COUNTY FAIR operation in the Hamlet of An TRACH (1), via grid square AT 9666.

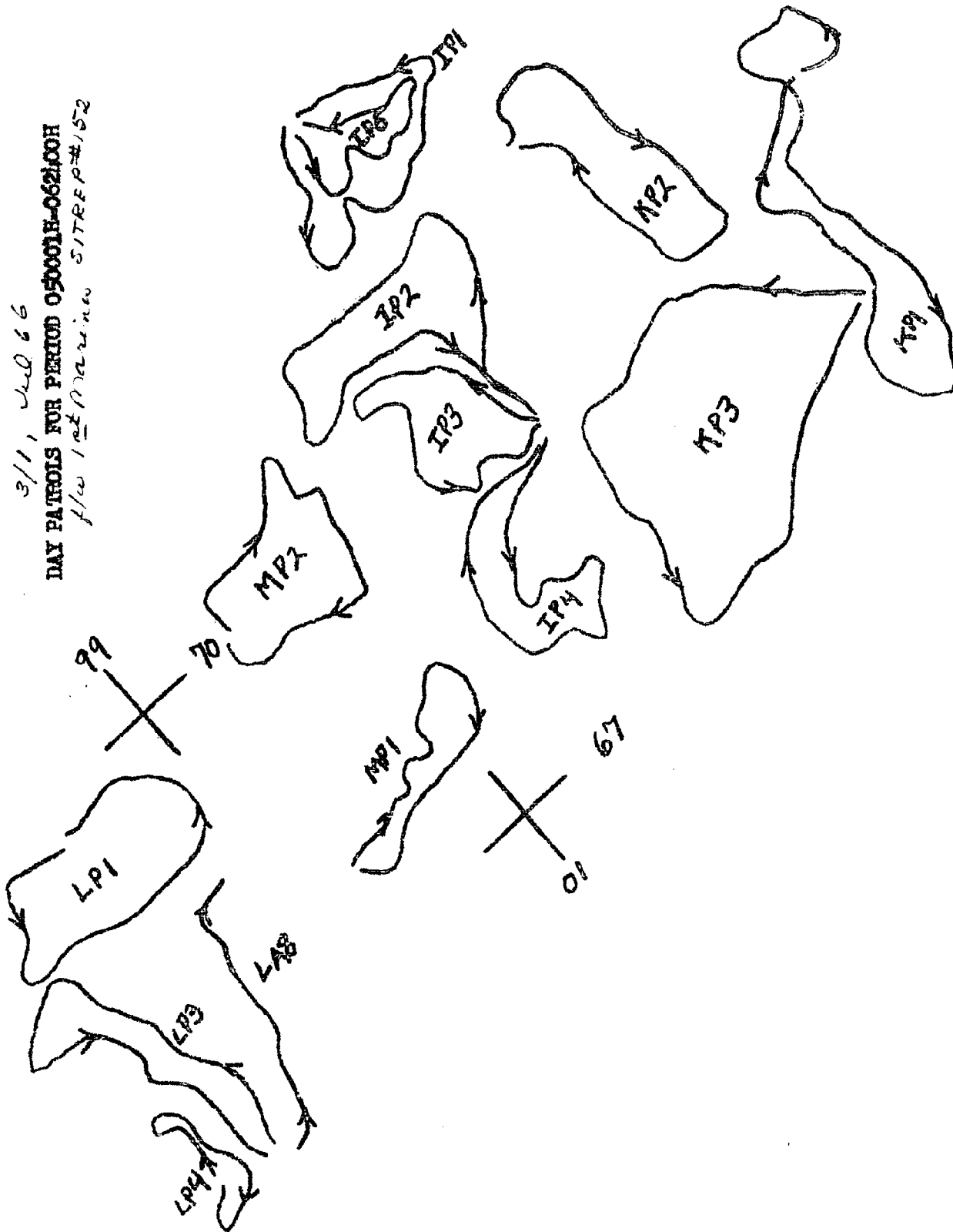

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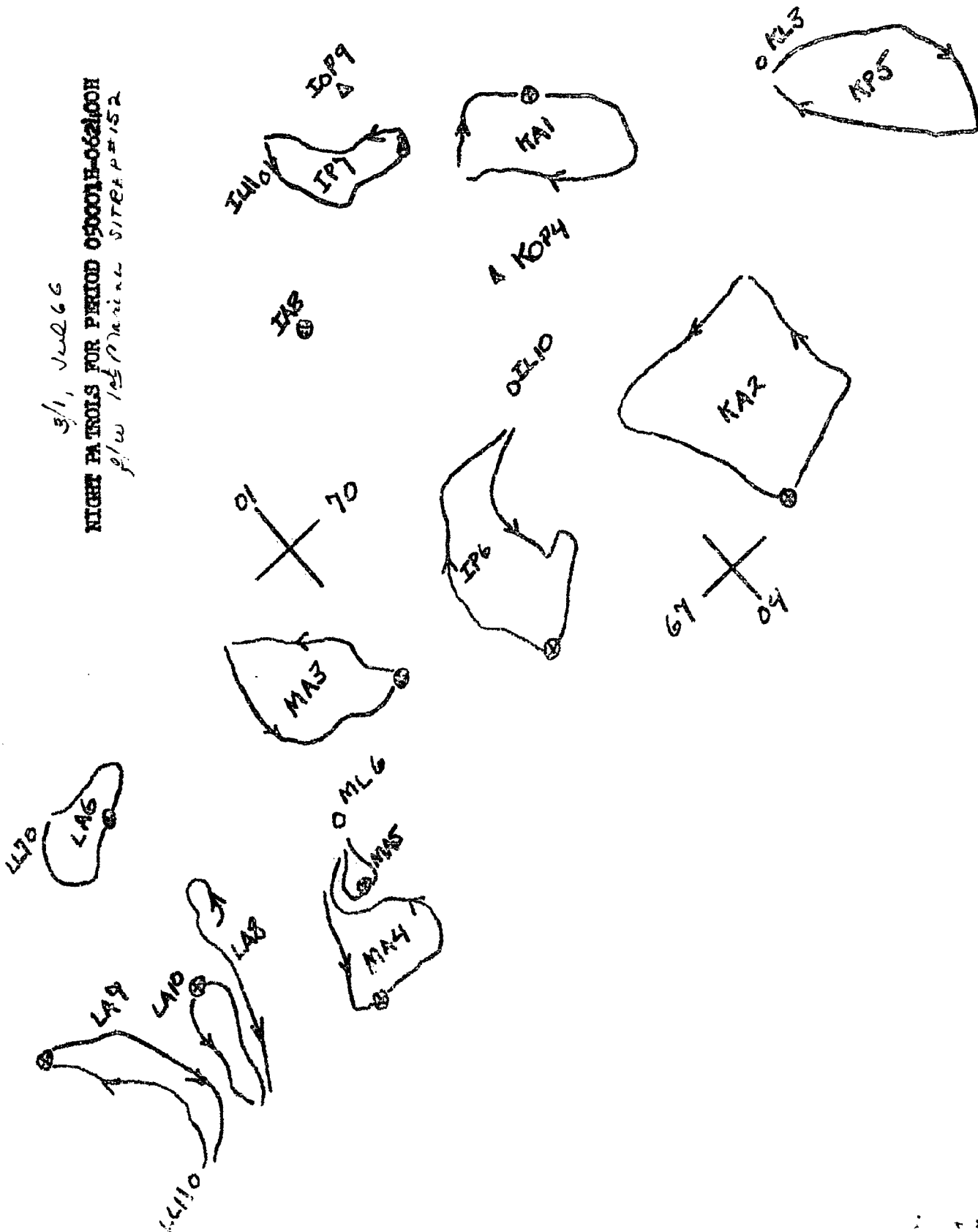
